I am getting this report in early so I won't have to give it to Bill over the phone, that way I can collect my wits (or at least try). Not a whole lot of Domestic DX, although three Idaho stations were logged and reported, due to my Illinois-acquired weakness for such stations. Oregon, too. They are: 1/27 KID-590 RS at S9+ level 1917-1921, and KFXD-580 also RS, not quite so strong, 1900-1910. 1/28 KBV-510 good over CBK using the loop, had s/off at 1915 (said s/on 1000 late). This reception was first noted 1/25 when I fixed my loop and seems to be consistent. Instead of adding more wire to my loop, which was ill-equipped to do, I found a larger capacitor from an old radio (it must be about 450mmf) and it covers the BCB nicely. If you are hard up, you might try experimenting with various capacitors. KNOE-540 reception after dark u/CBK also seems somewhat irregular, but never KFI-B. Foreign reception during the week includes XEHB-770 and TIV-775, both reported as our publisher has verified both of them. He informs me that KMOR-1510 Littleton, Colo. will be changing to KDKO shortly, with a c/w format (yucch). Believe it or not! The IRCA has a charter member in Trona. It has been so long since my name has appeared in the DX Monitor that everybody will think I'm a new member. First, to all my friends who sent me Christmas greetings, Thank you. I am sorry I didn't send any cards out this year but there were just too many things happening at once here. Second, I sure have enjoyed reading all the members comments in the bulletin, so much so that I finally got around to putting my aerial back up. One of our big winds blew it down last year, so while it was down I got a tape measure and an unwilling son to help me measure it, before I put it back up. The receivers here are a Hammarlund HQ-120-X and a BC-314-G tied to a 1610 foot north-south aerial and a 250 foot east-west aerial. DX wise a look at the log shows that I came home from the 1961 NRC Amarillo Convention all fired up and logged 27 new stations before the fires were banked in Jan. '62. In 1963 the grand total of one new station was added to my log. The next entry was May of '64 with 5 new stations and a new country added. Then on Dec. 20, '64 Dakar was logged and since then 11 new stations have been added. My recent DX includes Dakar-764, PRG2-1040 for 2 new countries. Veries CBR, CHUB, KLYQ, WTUF with v/l's. Best report has come from Kermit Geary, and it has been the talk of the station since it arrived. Interesting to note, the power on the DX was on ly 800 watts. (due to frequency change). DX has been singularly bad, due mostly to inactivity. Nothin much since the Radio Hoyer DX. I did have the receiver set up on the night of the HCRITL DX, and noticed a number of USA stations...best being KFRU-1400. WQAI-560 and WKBN-570 were also noted. - 850 Pyongyang, NORTH KOREA. Looks like the new 848 kcs. outlet has moved up to 850 kcs.. Definitely here although maybe slightly off. Heard on 1/24 at 0542 // 655 kcs., and on 1/25 up to HJKC's s/on. (RJS)
- ???? Several stations were heard on 1/25 in Spanish at 0508. One on top mentioning "Cuba" several times, then had a radio drama. CMKC? Or the usual HJKC? (KGS)
- 854 OAX 4 A Lima, PERU, "Radio Nacional" was tentatively logged on 1/25 at their 0600 s/on. Heard and taped. XERB came on at 0603 and messed up both 855 kcs. and 1325 kcs. (235 kcs. + their own) (RJS) (Randy, a tape of the Peruvian NA will be on its way to you. I can't tell from your tape if that's what I heard. - ed)
- 855 ???? A TT was heard here on 1/26 from 0405-0440. Maybe a heterodyne. Not the North Korean as he was on 850 kcs.. Wonder who? (RJS)
- 860 XENL Monterrey, MEXICO was logged on 1/19 and 1/26 very strong after XEMO's 0300 s/off. They ID as "N-L, Radio Recuerdo". (DJ) Was IDed on 1/26 at 0402. Taped the IDs and calls. Seems to be "La Voz de ??". All alone. (R)
- XEMO Tijuana, MEXICO was logged over and under KONO on 1/16 at 0300 for a report. (DR)
- CM.. (...?), CUBA. At 0345 on 1/19 I heard what I think was a Cuban fading in over XENL with a Spanish announcement. Seemed to give its QTH as Pinar del Rio. (DJ)
- 870 LRA Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio Nacional" uses 50 kws. from 0600-2300. The staff says that the station is never AN, and never stays on later than 2300. (LBG)
- 880 JOPK Shizuoka, JAPAN was listenable at 0420 on 1/25. (RJS)
- TGJ Guatemala City, GUATEMALA, "Radio Nuevo Mundo" was S 9 and no QRM on 1/25 at 0030. Best reception ever! (KGS)
- ???? A station was logged here on MM 1/25, best after 0419, with a woman talking, but I couldn't tell the language. With the Japanese coming in so well, who could it have been WCers? (DJ) (JOPK? - ed)
- ???? An LA mystery. A very weak Spanish station was noted here with music and commercials at 0330. Too late for TGJ; who? (BW)
- ???? An Un-ID LA was noted at 0530 on 1/24 at S 5. TGJ is not on then, are they? (RJS) (Sounds too early. YVKU? - ed)
- 885 Pyongyang, NORTH KOREA. Looks like the one that started out around 878 kcs. has moved up to here. First heard on 1/24 at 0446. Argument in process (Good sign for the US!) and better on 1/25 from 0415-0630. Was // 635 kcs. until 0500; then // 655 kcs. and all of the others after 0500. (RJS)
- 890 YVLW Valencia, VENEZUELA was noted to sign on at 0437 on 1/25 with a lengthy vocal version of their NA. Nice signal despite the QRM. (ELK)
- 900 ???? An LA mystery. It was heard at 0505 on 1/25 with slow Spanish and organ music. Strange accent; not Mexican or Cuban. Under CHML. (BW)
- 910 LR 4 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA runs from 0400-2300 with 50 kws.. (LBG)

- 935 Lvov, UKRAINIAN SSR was heard at 2010 on 1/17 relaying Moscow in English. Strong; it had to be - I have a local on 930 kcs. ! (CMS)
- 950 LR 3 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio Belgrano" broadcasts from 0345-2315. They use 90 kws.. The CE, Maximo J. Kolble speaks English, and verifies about half of the reports depending on their quality and friendliness. They will DX for the IRCA on MM 2/22 from 0400-0500. (LBG)
- 990 LR 5 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio Excelsior" is here now with 15 kws.. They operate from 0500-2200. (LBG)
- 998 Kichinev, MOLDAVIAN SSR was logged poorly on 1/17 from 1905-1935 relaying Moscow in English and Russian. Probably // 935 kcs.. (CMS)
- 1000 PRB 9 Sao Paulo, BRAZIL, "Radio Record" came bounding through KOMO's TT at 0320 with recognizable Portuguese. At 0330 both KOMO and KTOK stopped testing long enough to get a clear ID and announcement ... and a taped report ! (DJ)
- 1010 XEFM Veracruz, MEXICO was tentatively logged here. It doesn't seem possible. Only 500 watts. Heard on 1/26 at 0102-0115. Heard XE and then either F or S -M ID. XEFM is listed here in the NARBA lists. I hope XEDX (The correct call in Ensenada) doesn't relay XESM ! (RJS) (Randy, SACCA also lists this one here, but with only 250 watts ! See DXWW for 3 November, page 5. - ed)
- LT 4 Posadas, ARGENTINA, "Radio Misiones" is now 25 kws. according to LS 5. (L)
- 1020 ZCO Nuku'Alofa, TONGA verified by Station Engineer for my 11/10 report. You'd be surprised how many people asked me where Tonga is ! (KGS) (Showing it off, huh, Gray ? I can't blame you ! - ed)
- 1030 LS 10 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio Libertad" is AN, 7 days with 20 kws.. Note that the 1964 WRTVH does not indicate that this station is located here although the address is otherwise correct. (LBG) (It's OK in the 1965 edition. - ed)
- 1035 4 VEF Cap Haitien, HAITI was noted with a beautiful signal on 1/24 at 0528 s/on. Gave all their frequencies in English. (RJS)
- 1040 KHVH Honolulu, HAWAII. A verie was received on Friday after the report had been mailed on Sunday ! QSL card signer is unreadable. Verie # 4 from here. (PB) Was a solid signal on 1/24 from 0200-0230 tune-out. No trace of "Radio Tupi". Lost cause ? Heck no ! (RJS)
- Peking, CHINA is heard every Sunday AM from 0400 on with a powerhouse signal. Best of all the Chinese stations. (BW) Was heard at their 0500 s/on on 1/24 at S 7 on a stingy meter ! Why can't you get them, Ed ? (RJS) (Maybe cause Cleveland' not on the WC, hi ! - ed)
- PRG 2 Sao Paulo, BRAZIL, "Radio Tupi" was, I believe, the station heard under WHO at 0326 on 1/23. Gone after about 10 minutes. "Radio Peking" was noted with their IS weakly at 0400. (KGS)
- ???? Who is the station signing off at 0556 ? Peking ? And who is the station signing on at 0602 ? VOA-Florida ? They were logged on 1/23. (DE) (Randy noted an 0556 s/off for Peking in September, Don. - ed)
- ???? An UnID Spanish station was noted under Peking at 0410 on 1/24. Most Spanish stations are off by then. Which one isn't ? (BW) (Any chance that it was the Portuguese "Radio Tupi", Bill ? - ed)
- 1050 XED Mexicali, MEXICO often IDs in Spanish as Calexico for some reason. It's hard to believe that this station reduces to 1 kilowatt at night as no reduction in their signal level is noted. Probably uses 10 kws. fulltime. XEG doesn't have a chance when they're on. (BW)
- 1070 LR 1 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio El Mundo" operates with 110 kws. from 0400-2300. The WRTVH address is correct. They verified my reception from Boulder of 2/10/64 for my 5th. from Argentina. V/s is Ruben Alberto Gazzola, Supervision Interior. (LBG)
- 1090 CX 28 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Imparcial" was heard weakly behind the CBC ANer on 1/25 from 0235-0240. Unneeded however. (ELK)
- 1097 Bratislava, CZECHOSLOVAKIA verified my report with a pretty card along with three for the Prague station on 638 kcs.. The v/s appears to be Martha Trojanova, or maybe "Frojamora" as per Schatz. (ELK)

- 1106 Vilnius, LITHUANIAN SSR was logged on 1/5 at 2200. I believe their s/on is at this hour as only an OC was noted before. (CMS)
(WRTVH-1965 claims 2100, Stan. - ed)
- 1110 LR 2 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio Argentina" broadcasts from 0500-0000 with 20 kws.. (LBG)
- 1120 TGRR Guatemala City, GUATEMALA. At 0000 on 1/25 a station using the slogan "Radio Reloj" started pushing KMOX hard. I knew it wasn't Cuba because they gave CST time signals. At 0100 KMOX cut to 10 kws., and the Spanish station broke through them nicely. At their 0104 s/off they used the "King of Kings" theme. Definitely Guatemala, and if they are 500 watts as per LASL, they are my best CA log. Taped report off. (DJ)
- LU 7 Bahia Blanca, ARGENTINA, "Radio General San Martin" is probably on this frequency although one of the members of the staff says it is on 1110 kcs.. Their schedule is 0500-2230 (But 2300 on Sunday and Monday AMs). Their power is 10 kws.. (LBG)
- ???? An UnID LA station was heard here after 0500. Any ideas ? (RJS) (YVMF maybe, or note LU 7's s/on time above ! - ed)
- 1145 YST San Salvador, EL SALVADOR, "Radio Mundo" was logged with a good signal for a change on 1/24 from 2135-2155 and a report, via tape, was sent. They ID about every 10 minutes by a woman after several chords on a harp with call and slogan. Plays light instrumental music. (DJ)
- 1150 JOKP Kitami, JAPAN was noted on 1/25 at 0445 with an S 3 signal. (RJS)
- 1180 PRE 3 Rio de Janeiro, BRAZIL, "Radio Globo" was heard to sign on with interval chimes and the anthem at 0300 on 1/24. (BN) Was again a powerhouse at their 0300 s/on on SM 1/24. (DJ)
- 1200 -SLBS- Freetown, SIERRA LEONE verified via a QSL card. This one lists both frequencies, hi ! This was Country # 99. (CMS)
- LU 3 Bahia Blanca, ARGENTINA, "Radio del Sur" is now on this frequency, ex-1240 kcs. as of September. They use 10 kws., and their schedule is 0430-0100. This is probably the station I heard on July 6 from Boulder, not LU 10 in Azul. (LBG)
- 1210 HJFF Pereira, COLOMBIA, "La Voz Amiga". I took a wonderful 3 hour log from 0015 on 1/25. KZOO was about equal but they could be partially nulled. Tape sent. (KGS)
- 1220 XEB Mexico City, MEXICO. Is everyone sure this is AN ? Since they are strong in the evening, and after midnight only a weak LA, probably Cuba, is heard I would seriously doubt it. (DR)
- 1240 LU 10 Azul, ARGENTINA, "Radio Azul" is now here, ex-1200 kcs. as of July 1. They use 10 kws., but will be 25 kws. in a year. Their schedule is 0500-2200. The v/s is José Borrero Rivera, Director. He is sure that the station I heard on 7/6/64 was LU 3 although that station says it was still on 1240 kcs. at that time. The address listed in WRTVH is correct. (LBG)
- ???? "Radio Moscow". A Russian or Chinese station was heard here on 1/25 at 0549 with an S 9 signal. They didn't seem // 1250 kcs., but I can't speak Russian ! Wonder if PAL or WRTVH has anything listed ? (DS) (Not that I could find, Dan. - ed)
- 1250 Khabarovsk, ASIATIC SFSR, "Radio Moscow" relay was heard well with the Russian National Anthem at 0300. Possibly their s/on. (KGS)
(WRTVH-1965 says it's at 0330, Gray. Can't win, hi ! - ed)
- LR 9 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio Antartida" is here, ex-1190 kcs., as of December. Their schedule is 0500-2200 and they use 10 kws.. (LBG)
- 1260 CMCI Havana, CUBA, "Reloj Nacional" is AN // 1270 kcs., and is heard with good strength. Heard every MM. (BW)
- 1270 CMJC Camaguey, CUBA is only slightly weaker than CMCI on 1260 kcs., but the interference is worse here. Heard every MM. (BW)
- 1320 LU 6 Mar del Plata, ARGENTINA, "Radio Atlantida" operates from 0430-0100. They use 5-10 kws. Days, and 1 kw. Nights. (LBG)
- XEAI Mexico City, MEXICO, "Radio AI" was heard very well through heavy QRM on 1/25 at around 0245. (ELK)

- 1350 LS 6 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio del Pueblo" operates from 0500-0100. They use 5 kws.. (LBG)
- 1370 JOKD Kitami, JAPAN was apparently the NHK outlet heard here strong on MM 1/25 from 0315-0415. However, it was not // JOBB on 830 kcs. this AM as has been reported. I reported to NHK HQ along with my report on JOBB, as they didn't verify my report of last season. (DJ)
- 1440 XELZ Mexico City, MEXICO, "Radio LZ" was in with a very nice signal on 1/25 from 0210 on. A clear channel here then. (ELK)
- 1520 "Radio Caroline", INTERNATIONAL WATERS. A QSL card was received on 1/16 for my 12/7 report. The report was sent to the address listed in the November 1964 ELECTRONICS ILLUSTRATED (Ronan O'Rahilly, 54-62 Regent Street., London, W. 1). The verie was mailed from London. (F)
- TGDX Guatemala City, GUATEMALA is probably the LA station that occasionally tops KOMA, although never at ID time, hi ! Since there are no Mexican stations of sufficient power listed here, it must be them. What's the power of this one ? (DR) (Apparently only 500 watts ! - ed)
- 1562 "Radio Veronica", INTERNATIONAL WATERS was in well from 0150-0205. They were only about S 2 on the loop but easily readable. They were sent a report. (PB)

VENEZUELA According to an ASWLC member this country is now using Atlantic Standard Time. (CMS) (Stan, I noted this on YVLW-890 kcs.. When I started typing up my report while monitoring the tape I wondred if I had copied the time down incorrectly ! I wonder if its country-wide or only over a limited region ? I'd guess it would be country-wide. - ed)
