Voice of America in South Vietnam is listed in the new official VOA frequency schedule effective 3/5/67 again. However, it was not off the air during the last year (it hadn't been listed) according to NASWA's Feb. "FRENDX". In fact, according to this reliable source, it wasn't even silenced by a Viet Cong mortar attack in the summer of 1966. Its absence from the list probably indicates that during this period it was not airing any VOA programs at all, with the entire schedule devoted to programs produced by another (non-American) agency, presumably the South Vietnamese government, A similar practice is applied to the Philippine frequencies of 920 and 6170 kc. When they are used entirely for P.B.S. XMSNs, as now, they are deleted from the VOA's list even though the XMTRs are actually still on the air. It is also interesting to note that until the VOA sked effective 5/4/65 the 860 kc station's power (50 kw) was listed but not its location. After that date, and now, the power is not listed but the general location (Vietnam) is shown. It seems reasonable to wonder whether around that time the facility was not drastically altered. However the power itself was apparently not changed. (continued on page 3, the result of poor planning-RJS)

### RECEPTION REPORTS

To this day there are many members who still will not send return postage with their reports; in fact, some are of the idea that they are doing a great service to the station by keeping personnel employed in answering reception reports! This constant compaign to stress the use of return postage by us has not hit home apparantly so perhaps the views of a broadcaster speaking his mind on this might be interesting:

"...I was at one time a very ardent DXer myself....I feel that it is merely a matter of personal satisfaction -- this business of logging distant stations -- and as such, pleasure is derived only in the knowledge that you actually accomplished the desired objective. It seems to me that false reporting of DX is more or less like cheating at solitare. If one gets a kick out of slipping a card or so, let him. I personally get a grudge against the 'so-called ardent DXer' who isn't interested enough in his hobby to cooperate with the station by furnishing postage. To a small local station, the DX mail doesn't really mean much and it runs into a tidy sum each month to handle all of the verifications. I feel it is a duty to furnish a verification for a true report -- if postage is furnished. But at the same time those 'please send me' cards are a source of irritation -- no end. In my humble opinion, ... what you want in the line of veries, you pay for by your cooperation with the station by helping on the matter of stamps."

This was written by Mr. Irvin Faulkner, Cheif Operator of KCRJ, Jerome, Arizona, and any other small local broadcaster today will be in total agreement with him. Times may have changed some aspects of DXing, but the return postage principle has not, and that is why this rule is just as valid today as it was in 1938 when he wrote this.
