President's Report

The following proposals will go before the Board of Directors for vote soon. A period of one month is allowed for comments in the DX Forum.

Bylaws amendment to Article V, Section 2, Part 3, f: When the Chairman of the Board resigns, the new Chairman would be decided by a vote among the remaining Directors. At present, the new Chairman is the remaining Director who has been a member of the IRCA for the greatest length of time. There are currently two Directors who joined the club before its first bulletin.

Bylaws amendment to Article V, Section 2, part 1, j: To read, "The President must submit all suggestions and proposals in their original presented form to a vote of the Board of Directors. If any changes are necessary, they shall be submitted in additional new suggestions and proposals."

Bylaws amendment to Article V, Section 2, part 1, l: rephrasing to read: "The President must submit all suggestions and proposals within 21 days from date of receipt by him to a vote of the Board of Directors."

Rephrasing the "Guidelines for Submitting Proposals" Article III, B: "The President will send 1 copy of each proposal within 21 days to each Board member, with his own comments and recommendations if he so wishes. Board members will communicate their decisions to the President within 21 days of the mailing to the Directors.

Bylaws amendment to Article V, Section 2, Part 1, addition of sub-part o to read: "The President must assign a number to each suggestion and proposal on the basis of the date of its receipt; such number shall increase with each additional suggestion or proposal."

Bylaws amendment to Article XII, Section 1, with rephrasing to read: "Any irregularity of club policy must be brought to the attention of the Board of Directors and the President. A statement of the irregularity and the member or members charged must be made in written form and must bear the signature or signatures of the members making such charges, and shall be submitted directly to each Director and the President; all shall determine any action which shall be taken."

An amendment to Article II, C of the "Guidelines for Submitting Proposals" to read: "A proposal must not violate procedures established by the IRCA Constitution, the IRCA Bylaws, or the incorporation laws under which the IRCA is organized."

The President shall send copies of his comments and recommendations on proposals and suggestions sent to the Board of Directors to the member(s) who submitted the proposal or suggestion.

The IRCA should offer to exchange bulletins with the Australian Radio DX Club, upon a request initiated by that club, with the exchange going to the DXWW editor. The proceeds would come from the IRCA foreign member fund (currently at \$11.00).

The Chairman of the Board cannot be decided in strict accordance with the IRCA Bylaws because there are currently two Board members (Ed Krejny and Ernie Wesolowski) who have been with the club since its inception. Under these circumstances, it would probably be best for the Board members to vote between these two candidates.

The basic documents of the IRCA, which contain most of its policies, are the Constitution and Bylaws, the Editorial Policy, and the Guidelines for Submitting Proposals. If you don't have a copy of all these documents, please notify Don Erickson, 6059 Essex St., Riverside, California 92504.

1969 is election year for the IRCA, and nominations for President, Secretary-Treasurer and the seven Directors will be sought in April. If you are interested in serving in one of these capacities, it's time now to start thinking seriously about it. The term of office is two years and the only requirement to hold office is membership in the IRCA as of September 1, 1969.

Regulars— Gray Scrimgeour, Toronto, Ontario. Bermuda-1235 (the Toronto rule-of-thumb is that when 1235 is loud, DX will be lousy), PJB-800 over CKIW every evening, and XERF-1570. And of course a number of Cubans, such as 640, 690, and 840 after 0005. HJED-820 is often heard under or even with the Texan. And some of the Latin splits are heard several times a week during the winter with good levels.

Work is progressing on the domestic non-English list. Gray sent me several Canadians, and Ron Schatz sent a lengthy list of US stations broadcasting in SS, PP, and Navajo.

Frequency and Callsign Allocations in the Americas— (Continuation)—Ron Schatz

Colombia
 In Colombia, 540 through 1000 khz are international frequencies, while 1010 through 1600 are regional frequencies. Only one station operates on each of the international frequencies, with a power of 10kw or more. Assignments on these frequencies are placed 40 khz apart in the same location.

Each regional frequency is shared by from two to six stations. Assignments are 30 khz apart in the same location. E.g., in Bogota, the frequencies run: 540, 570, 610, 650, ... every 40 khz, ... 930, 970, 1010, 1040, ... every 30 khz, ... 1550, 1580 khz.

Colombian callsigns consist of the IP of HJ, a regional letter, and a fourth letter. Each group of "departamentos" in Colombia has a letter:

HJA Atlantico, Bolivar, Cordoba, (Barranquilla)
HJB Guajira, Magdalena, Norte de Santander
HJC Cundinamarca (Bogota)

In recent years this regional system has been breaking down, as it would appear from looking at the latest logs.

Costa Rica

The Costa Rican frequency system is unusual, in that each station is assigned to one of 44 frequencies, each separated by 25 khz. These frequencies are 525, 550, 575...1575, 1600. The IP in Costa Rica is TI.

Cuba

Cuba, once a NARBA member, now offends its neighbors with high-powered stations on the wrong frequencies. Cuban calls consist of the IP of CM, a regional letter, and a fourth letter. Each of the six provinces is assigned up to three regional letters:

El Salvador

The Salvadorian IP is YS.

The Guatemalteco IP is TG. Unusual is the fact that stations in the same location are placed 20 khz apart. Frequencies assigned to the capital are the "evens," 540, 560, 580, ... 1580, 1600 khz.
