In fact the VOA itself now admits, for the first time, that there was a DT relay during the Cuban missile crisis. Previous stories of this DT XMTR were, so far as I have been able to determine, based entirely on unconfirmed newspaper accounts. And most will recall the extremely evasive answers given out last summer by VOA concerning the original Further as IRCAns will recall; VOA 1040 initially rec. 1040 relay. its programming off the air and one of its pickup points was Radio Americas, itself an off-the-air relay. The EI piece concludes -"One might also wonder if there is another chapter in this story namely, that RA could have been located much closer to Dry Tortugas at that time".
