Howdy y'all. For LBG and others who asked about the AL-4: The AL-4 is designed for use w/ Drake SW-4A rx. It measures about 18" x 3½! and is similar to the loop descr'd by Fish in 12/6 DXM but is of all-metal construction w/ 1 wire running around the outside. It plugs into a standard phone jack on the rx chassis. This is connected directly w/ the 1st input stage thus making it a DCL. Since the AL-4 ends in a phone plug, you would only have to install a phone jack in the rx to use it. On my SW-4A, the ant's center pole goes down through a hole in the rx cover to the phone jack. I would say the AL-4 is the best ant. available commercially for BCB DX, although not in the class of GPN's superloop. If you have more questions, just write. 73s, a Merry Christmas and hope Santa leaves everyone an HRO-500!

DX activity has been sporadic of late, and now has come to a standstill since my klutzy soldering job on the HQ-140X resulted in a couple of roasted resistors (among other maladies)! One lone v/l in from KBMY-DX, and thanks to PRK for arranging this one. Contrary to Paul Lotsof's allegations in the 1/4/70 DXF, there is a provision in the editorial policy for deleting items which are potentially libelous or slanderous. Libel and slander are unlawful, and items in violation of the law may be omitted under 111 F.4 of the EP. In fact, that is the precise reason that this section was added to the policy (and I should know, since I proposed the amendment). The purpose of the IRCA, according to our Constitution, is to "promote the hobby of radio listening on the AM Broadcast Band." (emphasis mine) The hobby of BCB DX incorporates much more than just the IRCA, though of course club pride is important -- without it there would be no volunteers to carry on the work of the club -- and disparaging remarks about other clubs engaged in the hobby do not, in my opinion, support this purpose. Valid criticism, constructively presented. is helpful in guiding the course of the club and shaping our relations with external organizations, but unfounded statements, misleading innuendos and fiery slogans cause nothing but internal strife and interclub ill-will.

Jay Murley - 1733 Candlestick - Newport Beach, CA 92660 In all the controversy about Monaco-1466 counting as a separate country, I feel there is one added aspect to consider. While their transmitter sites are located in France, there is the matter of the practical extraterritoriality of the antenna farm. Postwar updating to the Franco-Monagsque Treaty of 1918 did extend and perpetuate Monaco P.T.T. autonomy, so that Monte Carlo's control over broadcasting is not affected by transmitter locations (the limitations being a factor of Monaco's overall relative soveriegnty). The comparison that the Mexican border stations are American in studio location isn't quite valid: without exception, the concessionaires -- the ownership -- is at least 51% Mexican (regardless of permanently leased sales and programming rights). Moreover, they must air "La Hora Nacional" each Sunday and periodically identit in Spanish under penalty of law. The XETRA's and XELO's have "studios" on both sides of the border; if Monaco had studios in France I suspect that their news policy might have resembled ORTF's at certain times in the Gaullist era. The most valid point to me is that we log all stations licensed to New York City as New York State, regardless of those with antennas in Jersey's swamps. Personally I doubt that I'll ever log Monaco, and don't need New Jersey. I don't feel justified in moving one of my Districto Federal loggings to the needed estado of Mexico on this tenuous premise.

In September you made note of the new "Radio Today"magazine. You said payment rate was from \$15-20 a page; this worked out to be \$4-5 per double-spaced typewritten page. I sold them starting last May five articles, pay averaged \$5 a page, and I was quite happy with my relationship with them. Recently, Wayne Green became publisher and Ken Sessions took over as Editor. On December 27, 1969 Is ent a five page manuscript to "Radio Today" along with some QSL cards and charts. On January 2, I received a check for the article—pay was \$5! This must mean that they are now paying at the rate of \$1 per typed page! I don't know how much experience Ken Sessions has had in editing electronics magazines, but he had better learn that no one is going to write for such rock-bottom prices—getting an article published like this is almost like publishing a book in the "vanity press."
