Broadcasting Yearbook

The 1971 Broadcasting Yearbook is to be off the press in January 1971. So figure about March judging from years of broken promises. The price will be \$13.50 per copy when it is released. However, UNTIL NOVEMBER 30, 1970, you can order for \$12, their annual pre-publication special. Each year, or so it seems, the pre-pub offer is last year's regular price! Known as BYB, this fine publication has been sky-rocketing in price; just five or six years ago it was \$5 and wasn't much thinner. However, even at \$13.50, it is a must for the domestic DXer who can afford it and wants the latest source of station information. Included in BYB are AM-FM-TV stations in the U.S., Canada, and Mexico. The listings are not deadly accurate but no such listing is. Addresses and station personnel are included for all US and Canadian stations along with power and pattern facts, date station started, rep, phone number, TWX number, and so forth. In addition, there is loads of material on stations carrying specialty programs (farm, Negro, C&W, etc.). I use a Heathkit GR-64 receiver, a Webcor Royalite tape recorder and a newly constructed IRZA spiral loop. I haven't done much DX lately due in part to the breaking down of my typerwriter and my lazyness in obtaining stamps. The last time I did some decent DX was in May. I hope to start picking up again DX wise this season.

Hi gang! Just thought I'd put my 2 cents in. I just got done reading
the ECDXF and read Jim's report. He was saying about not receiving
the NRZ log. If he belongs to the NRZ I can't see why he didn't

Well getting down to business, I received some new stations: WIP610 kHz., wEUP-1600 kHz. I received them on a car radio. Well I got
my new receiver (Heathkit GR54), I really haven't had a good chance
to use it yet. 73 and good DX'ing!
(Last two reports typed by Big George becaue MD was away on a trip.)

Bob Foxworth - GPO Box 2111 - New York, N.Y. 10001 I am planning an addition to my receiver which will be a frequency counter measuring the local oscillator frequency, and subtracting 455 kHz from the reading, to show the freq to which the rx is tuned to the nearest tenth of a kHz. Am also planning a solid state front end which will be compatible with the electronic dial. I am using a NRC loop pre-amp and have no trouble with it, but I have found that both the parts layout, and the neutralization are tricky, especially when the DXer is near strong locals, and those who cannot get the pre-amp to work have likely not used good shielding or layout. It is possible to use Motorola MPF-105 FET's which have less gain and are more stable. The drain current can be set as low as 2 ma for both FETs and adequate gain be had. Bias is not very critical in the source line and fixed resisters of 2700 ohms or higher can be substituted for the dual pot, but should be trimmed for equal bias voltage on the source terminals of the FETs, with a total current of 2 to 4 ma, if the plastic MPF-105. FET's are tried. Loop tuning remains extremely sharp, which is the important criterion here. Best.

Report From Panama -- SPA Bill Hardy, 535-48-0583; 9th Psyop Br., 8th SFGA, Ft. Gulick, C.Z., APO N.Y. 09837 until November 15.

It sounds like the Panamanian government is cracking down on distorted radio! One by one, the distorted stations are leaving the air, then reappearing one or two months later with clean signals. Since I haven't reporte since May, there are a number of changes:

- 640 HOK Panama, Colon, C.P.R. (Cadena Panamena de Radiodif.) parallel to HON-1500 Colon and R. Aeropuerto, HON31-550, Panama City. IDs for both. Also mentions HOC-1440 Panama City, but this station is off air and has been for more than 18 months. Sked is SS 0700-2000, EE 2000-2200 Mon-Sat., s/on and s/off with Panama NA. Sunday sked is 0800-1230 EST, so would not be heard Sun. night. Power definitely is 1 kw or more, not 250 watts as per WRTH.
- 650 HOS22 Panama, Panama, R. Mia s/on cold 0430 EST weekdays, usually un'IDed until 0500 news. At 10 kw, this is easiest Panamanian to log, along with HOX0-760 at 0540.
- 760 HOXO Panama, Panama, changed s/off times in May. No more SS classical music 2200-2300 (SCN airs it at that time now). S/off 2200 M-Th, 2400 Fri and Sat, still 2230 Sun, with Panama NA. S/off SS M-Sa, EE Sun. EE rock 2200-2400 Fri. and Sat.
- 780 Ho.. Panama, David, R. Chiriqui, new station recently on air. Power 1 kw or better. S/off 2300 with NA weeknights, probably 2100 Sunday.
- Panama, Panama back on air by 10/30 after being off six weeks. Stronger signal, maybe new 1 kw transmitter, and no more distortion. Distortion was terrible on old 500 watt xmtr. Same format: Jamaican EE, soul music, jazz and calypso; sitll off 2300 M-Fri, 2330 Sa, 2000 Sun, with NA.
- 920 HOS56 Panama, Los Santos, R. Mia. This is correct city, (Not Panama as per WRTH) paralle to 650.
- 980 HO.. Panama, David, another R. Mia relay parallel to 650. I believe these relays also s.on 0430.
- 990 HOR59 Panama, Panama, R. Impacto, s/on 0500 M-Sa, s/off 2400 daily and sometimes 0100, but no longer NSP.
- 1045 HOJ2 Panama, Las Tablas, Ondas del Canajagua, easily heard evenings, not heard AN, so apparently no so any more. (Please note, Tom Sundstrom, Ed)
- 1125 HOF47 Panama, ???, listed in WRTH as RPC station. Unheard here or in any province except Darien (where I haven't been). Phone book ad for RPC lists relay in Darien, but s/on and s/off list all relays except a Darien relay. So, unsure of this one. Definitely not "Onda Popular" which is Panama and Colon only.
- 1180 HOC20 Panama, David, new call, ex-HOOC. Did a remote AN 9/6 from hotel in Boquete where we stayed and I know it was AN, hi!
- 1190 HOL47 Panama, Panama off air for several months, not AN.
- 1210 HOE91 Panama, Panama back on air in June with new slogan, "R. Eco". Sked 0630-2400, M-Sa, off all day Sunday.
- 1240 HOM36 Panama, David, correct slogan is "R. David, La Reloj de Panama". MSP
- Panama, Panama back on air in August with new 1 kw transmitter, very clean signal. "R. Exitosa" with same announcements through echo chamber. MSP.

 Apparently the EE radio newspaper, which used 1250 until October 1969, will continue using SS stations on 575, 990 and 1505 one hour a day. Presume HOQ is still the call.
- 1540 HOE28 Panama, Panama, R. "TNT" no longer AN, but noisy (FM) OC AN. Sked 0600-2400 weekdays, 0700-2400 Sun. S/off and s/on with Panama NA.

- 888v ... Thailand. Nominal 890, Yankraw outlet in Bankrabue (Armored Car School).
- 980 ... Thailand, SWKSHPT, Yala. Over/under Chinese at 0659 10/5 and suffering from local splatter-975. Supposed to be a 50 kw station provided through Austrlian aid.
- 1030 ... Thailand. Another 50 kw station appears in official lists, at Phitsanulok-I cannot hear it but it may come on eventually.
- 1075 ... Thailand. Noted 10/4 1105-1140 during rock music and ads for James Tailor, Id seems to be Or Chor Sor 1-0-7.
- 1188v ... Thailand. The Khorat station previously reported is: Kongthap Phat Thii 2 the Second Army Division.
