Probably some DXWW readers have wondered where my rpts have been, but work has kept me busy as that proverbial one-arm paperhanger. Have been trying a few DX specials without any luck. Since I cannot stay awake until those odd-ball hours, I use the Knightkit R-195 transistorized rx (which splits 10kc easily) and a cassette auto-level-record machine on a timer and then check the tape next morning. I set up the loop to knull known 24-hour stns, which works OK. WODI-1230 was completely buried on 11/9...I couldn't pick out any IDs on the tape from any station. I haven't seen any rpts yet either. WCRV-1580 on 11/23 was a stn in my backyard when I was still single, living in Stockton, NJ, but nothing here. The only thing audible on the tape was an 0100 ID from WSRF in Fort Lauderdale... after that, a jumble. The timer system works OK, with instant start for both pieces, and no drift on the R-195. 73.
