Your publisher has just received a mailing from "O'Connell's Associates. 329 Water St., Binghamton, N.Y. 13901 with a flyer for Communications Moniter (sic) Association. The gist of CMA ("a division, Community Enterprises") is a call sign registration program. Cost is \$2 for random call, \$2.50 for special call. \$1 extra outside US and Canada "for the extra cost of mailing and special handling." The only stated privileges of this registration are unspecified awards programs and "special discounts" (5%) on supplies from O'Connell's Associates. And the supplies are overpriced at best. Discount does not apply to WRTH and How to Listen which are being sold at full retail price. The publishers offer a 33% discount to booksellers so there is a fair margin for profit on all items. O'Connell's has a phone number listed with directory assistance. Community Enterprises does not. While the two ads in the O'Connell's envelope don't state any relationship, both mailers are typed on the same typewriter, apparently. Larry Rhysling, WCM2LR, is the manager of the registration program. The letterhead and envelope might appear printed; actually, they are done by electronic mimeo stencil (33 each). All aspects suggest that someone is out to make a fast buck. Let the buyer beware. O'Connel Associates (without 's on the flyer) "Catalog #171" lists BCB Reporting Forms at \$3.00/100 with the claim "one DXer who uses these forms gets 92% returns." It is the opinion of your publisher that the claim is a fraud. In checking hundreds of reports from a dozen of the largest stations, there is no sign that anyone has used such a form. This station was also heard by NRCer John Shannon, Pittsburgh, at 1010 GMT on MM Dec. 7th. Power is 10kw per NRC DX News. Antigua, like Al's earlier tip on St. Kitts, is a new country for most everybody. So get them now while the getting is good. If anyone logged and verified ZIZ-585, ex-570, please let FJP know. Al reports they have not yet verified for his reception 12/9. For those DXers not overly familiar with geography, i.e. your pub., Montserrat, Antigua, and St. Kitts are all part of the Leeward Islands. WRTH lists all three under Leeward Islands on page 225, 1970 edition; none of the three are listed in the index by their separate names.

(XEMO, XELO, XETRA, etc. are in Mexico, not in Calif. and Texas).

Note from Publisher to those above with 4 or less countries: please make sure you are counting all countries, not just "foreign" countries. First three, for most, are US, Canada, and Mexico. If you have PJB and can hear any Mexican, you have 4 countries. Likewise, those with those 4 should try Radio Belize-834, TGJ Radio Nuevo Mundo-880 (from WC), Cuba CMQ-640 (from EC), etc. Let's all add at least one country for the next Foreign Heard listing. Your publisher wants Qatar! hi. -DEE

Well January 15th is the first phase of the clampdown on Canadian broadcasting by the government. All radio stns must play 1/3 Canadian mx. About the only format that will have problems is classical & opera, as that field is almost dead in Canada. The next step (by 1972) will require all Canadian TV stns to play 60% Canadian produced shows. The govt. plans some drastic actions in the TV field like forbidding Canadians to advertise on U.S. stns, resulting in the death of KVOS-TV (99% Vancouver oriented). They are also going to put cablevision companies out of business and set up signal blockers (like in eastern Europe) where U.S. TV sigs penetrate into Canada, such as Vancouver, where with a good antenna we can get Seattle stns. I doubt if these laws will pass. The public outcry will be too great. But I agree, as some of your TV shows are meant to brainwash you and our government desn't want us to watch trash. Only time will tell. (Are you sure your govt. isn't trying to brainwash you, Dan-BJ.) We've had a mild winter so far, temps in the 35 to 50 area, resulting in poor DX. #### Communications Handbook

By courtesy of DEE, I have been able to finally get my hands on a copy of Popular Electronics' Communication Handbook for more than a few minutes. The 34 page article by Richard Wood, while concentrating on SW DXing, is excellent. (The magazine even managed to use IRCA's current address instead of an ancient box mumber.) On page 27 in a box are two lists of MW stations, entitled "First Twenty Countries on Mediumwave." "Here are 20 interesting countries that are audible in North America--20 on the East Coast and 2. on the West Coast--on the medium wave bands."

I don't know whether these are REW's choices or those of the editors of Poptronics, but I feel that there are some easier stations to log than some of the ones listed. Radio Barbades, of course, recently switched frequencies to 900, but the following would be stations I would suggest to our newer members as alternates to some of those listed: Cuba--CMGN, 720; Venezuela--YVOZ, 1200; Japan--JOBB, 830. I would also suggest North Korea, 655; Nicaragua, YNX, 750; British Virgin Islands, ZBVI, 780; and Bahamas, ZNS-1, 1540, in place of Senegal. Perhaps some of our East Coast members might also like to suggest alternates to the ones on their list.

Chile Chile's leftist government has ordered radio stations to devote 40% of their music programs to Chilean songs, effective Jan. 1. The first reaction from commercial broadcasters indicated the new policy would fail. Government secretary Jaime Suraez signed a decree 12/26 ordering radio stations to play music composed by Chileans 25% of the time and to devote an additional 15% of music programming to "Chilean folkloric rhythms." "The public will not accept this," Eduardo MacDonald, manager of Radio Presidente Balmaceda in Santiago, asseted, "and I don't think there's enough Chilean music in Chile to make it possible to comply with this order." Chilean radio stations play a large amount of foreign music. Chilean songs are heard only occasionally. Radio Balmaceda, which broadcasts 19 hours daily, has a special 2-hour program on Sundays for Chilean music only. An executive of Santiago's Radio Mineria commented: They tried somethings similar to this a few years ago in Argentina, and it was a failure." The new decree also prohibits the use of prerecorded advertising after March 1. Local announcers will have to do all commercials live. (Rocky Mountain News, via Larry Godwin. 12/28.)
