It stretches across the top of Canada from Greenland and the North Pole to near Alaska in the "west". The UUT spans four time zones and covers an area larger than the whole continent of Australia. I would assume that any DXcr considers such places as Frobisher; Invik and Tuktoyaktuk just as exotic as Tonga or Thailand. The MWT is divided into three large districts: Keewatin (no stns), MacKenzie (home of CHAK CFCT & CFYK as well as many easily logged LPRTs), and the many islands of Frankin (home of CFFB & the alert CFB stn). The distance between CFFB & CFYK is "piles of miles", and I feel that since CFFB is now being hrd, such a vast area should be split in two and counted as 2 exotic Provs: MacKenzie #12 & Franklin "Lucky 13". The NoT is already counted as Prov. /12 for DX purposes. Besides PRK & myself, there are others who have hrd the NWT. There's little interest if you've never logged it, but I feel that by splitting the NWT in two we would give the extra award to anyone hearing the DX needles in the PAT haystack. If you comments are good, I'll make a proposal. If size is your bag, consider how many New Jersey's (or old ones) would fit in one million sq. mi.

In the daytime the groundwave signals closely follow the lakes. For example, the Buffalo stns are very strong in the St Lawrence River up near Mentreal over 300 miles away. In particular, WBEN-930 & WKEW-1520 fare very well. There are humourous effects as well. Teensy 250 watt WNYR in Rochester sends a tremendous signal up the river totally deminating and making a mockery out of the 10 kw signal of CFTR-Toronto. Geing the other way, Lake Eire pulls the signals down to Ohio. WKBW is pulled within a few miles of WTTO-Toledo, some DXers say even closer like right into Toledo!

- Morth Korea, Pyongyang with woman yakker and short segments of classical music, and man talking 1225-1247 10/17. Signal varied from "strong" to "oh wow" to "you would not believe the signal they had". (BP,W)

- 720 ??? China possibly the one poor 1225 10/17 with gal singing in CC. (FJP,W)
- 725 ... North Korea, Kim-chaek fair through horrendous KIRO/CKLG slop 1310 10/17 in KK. (BP,W)

- 735 ... North Korea, Pyong Kang presumably the one in KK 1345-1400 10/17. Not //655. CKLG slop wiped out any possible IS at 1400. Oddly enough LG was playing a song called "One Fine Morning"...it sure was, for TPs, at least.(BP,W)
- 750 JOIB Japan, Sapporo pretty good, equal with SSC 1136 10/17. (FJP,W)
- 770 JOUB Japan, Akita under KOB 1139 10/17. (FJP,W)
- 825 ??? Weak TP carrier noted 1220 10/17. China? (BP,W)
- 830\* JOBB/Japan/Hawaii audible many mornings, sometimes just one or both. Window KIKI has been occurring around 1220-1235, after WCCO and XELA are weak or gone. Latest examples: 10/13 at 1235 JOBB with JJ talk, SAH mixing with KIKI, which by 1238 was dominating with pop music, respiratory PSA, jingle ID, and again at 1247. Sunrise here currently around 1230. Next day, 10/14, KIKI was alone at 1223 taking a call from Kauai, IDs. (WGH,M)
  - JOBB Japan, Osaka starting EE lessons 1140 10/17. (FJP,W)
  - +Powerhouse 1215 10/17. Strongest they've been in a long time. (BP,W)
- 835 ... China just a carrier, not much-else 1141 10/17. (FJP,W) (See below for BP) 836.1??? OC here, faint (very) music and voice 0715 10/20; looped 125/305 which could be LA or TP. (FJP,W)
- 869.6 ?? Similar to 836, except only a carrier; forgot to record bearing. 0548 10/21. (FJP,W)
- 877 ... North Korea, Wonsan must have been the one here 1305 10/17. Powerhouse carrier but almost no audio. (BP.W)
- 835 ... China Nanchang yakker fair 1217 10/17. (BP,W)
- Previously reported UFO. I listened to the tape again; it sounds now like six short pips, then one long pip. Then music played before pips, then more music. ## Geomagnetic Indices

October 13-19 9 10 7 3 4 2 2

Gene Martin comments that European reception on 10/19 contradicts the theory that high latitude conditions do not develop until after several days of low order auroral activity. He says auroral conditions were severe over 10/14-17. Local squall line static on 10/18 prevented him from judging. The indices above indicate that conditions during this period really were not auroral; TAs reached the West Coast on 10/20, and have been in for 3 days.Al Merriman noted that as of 10/15 no decent opening to Europe has occurred. Let's see whether they improved during this time. I got a very excited call from DEE on 10/20; 1214 showed up here almost as soon as I turned on the set; Grant found them also. Many other hets noted, looping NE, as indicated in the loggings above. Let's hope that a giant aurora doesn't wipe us out for the rest of the season now. As I recall, the WC TA opening two years ago was in November.

Okinawa Apparently the VOA test on 1178 has been postponed because of the possibility of auroral conditions around the end of the month; Will probably be held in

first two weeks of November.

Norway Uke-Senderen will start test transmissions from the Technical University of Trondheim on October 14 on 1313 kHz. Regular broadcasts on October 23-November 14 will be from about 30 minutes after the s/off of the regular Norwegian home service. (SCDX) If the schedule in WRTH is correct, this should be about 2330.

Australia Bruce Portzer sends along the information from ABC-Perth that their schedule is 2159-0402 Mon-Sat, 2228-0402 Sun. The are GMT, but dates are local (Western Australia). Bruce assumes that the schedule is for all ABC stations in Western Australia, even though none are specified.

Alaska Alaskan Forces Radio Network (AFRN) recently celebrated 30 years of service to the military in Alaska with the formation of the 5049th Broadcasting Squadron. The new squadron will include all personnel who were formerly attached to the Alaskan network under Hq. Alaska Air Command. The giant AFRN network was born in Alaska when Radio GAB went on the air on Kodiak Island in January 1942. The Alaskan network now includes 88 radio outlets and four TV studios located at Tatalina, Galena, and King Salmon AFS and Shemya AFB. In addition, TV service is provided at Sparrevohn AFS through a signal translater from Tatalina AFS. There are 53 Air Force, seven Army and one Navy personnel assigned or attached to the network. (Air Force Times, October 20, 1971, via Glenn Hauser)
