Of course, any try for CFFB should be made during periods of the best high latitude reception. This is all theoretical, but give it a try! It ought to be there!

- 970 XEJ Mexico, Ciudad Juarez, Chih. surely the one in here at 1250 11/15, as it gave RCN IDs which, if you believe the WRTH, would exclude all other Mexicans. (GWE,W)(Only RCN station here listed in RFS list. Ed)
 - ??? UnID, I think SS, fair under KOOK 11/10 1153 with vocals, if I'm correct, the type of music played on this station sounds very much as if it were a Colombian. (GF, W)
- 940 YVNN Venezuela, Radic Punto Fijo with "Esta es Radio Punto Fijo" after 4out of orderspot string. Into what sounded like a heated delivery of a newscast fater this. 11/15 1023, over KIOA, but under an UnID carrier which did not originate from KFRE. (SK,W)

In at 0700 but faded before ID could come in. DF wrong for any type of DU so I would say it is likely a Caribbean station if anything, as that would make the DF correct. 11/15. Any ideas, FJP? ECers? (GWE,W) (Nothing here, Gary, Ed)
- 1225 TIGM Costa Rica, Cartago, Radio Victoria with "G-M" ID 11.15 0500. Heard from 0451-0530+ with format consisting mostly of old MoR US songs. Recorded IDs at :00 and :30, giving last 2 call letters and frequency, among other things which I wasn't able to comprehend or/and dig out. Signal generally weak, but peaking to a fairly good level on occasion. (SK,W)

The name of the new amalgamation is Stimme der DDR—The Voice of the German People's Republic. (SCDX)

International Waters Radio Neptum is a new pirate radio station, which according to broadcasts in English and German, broadcasts from the Radio Ship Faithful, 6.4 kilometers from the coast of Clacton, Essex on 1320 kHz with one kilowatt.
