My suggested answers to these problems was to lower the VSZl frequency from 844 kHz to say 600 KHz and hence to boost the ground wave for the Southern Gilberts and to instal a new 2 KW transmitter in the Ellice, again operating at the bottom end of the MF band. (This would also enable us to build a studio in the Ellice to provide a locally originated programme for the period whilst we were broadcasting in Gilbertese from Tarawa.)

I have put these suggestions to Messers Marconis and although they cannot think of a better solution they think that a lowering of the VSZ1 frequency would only make about 2db difference at 300 miles which would not be significant. So I will give further consideration to this problem. The Ellice island transmitter will probablygo ahead to be completed in the order of 1 year—18 months, but here again there are difficulties. I was considering using a s.s.b. link at between 17 and 21 mHz for feeding the new transmitter from Tarawa. This now seems impossible due to lack of standard equipment and hence high costs. So we may have to use a normal HF link or devise another method of feeding.

As you see our plans are still rather fluid but I will certainly let you have details when I know more for certain. It will be interesting to see if anyone can pick us up in the 'States' from a 2 KW.

The Communication Ministry says 250,000 watt stations will be built at Belem, near the mouth of the Amazon River; Manaus, 900 miles upriver, and Porto Velho, in far western Amazonia Soldiers, doctors missicraries and explorers who have visited isolated river settlements in the Amazon jungle report that the programs which come in best there are short wave broadcasts of the Voice of America, BBC, and in certain areas, Radio Havana. Thousands of people in the Amazon region get nothing in Portuguese, the national language. The new stations coincide with the government's program for opening up the unseltled and potentially rich Amazon basin.
