Also hrd test for new WHTH-1000, vy strong until WCFL carrier on at 0234. Preceding all via Alan Merriman. Blake Lawrence rpts WAYT-1510 w/fair-good sigs; KGA QRM. Non-CPC items from Blake: WQXL-1470 Columbia, SC noted testing as was WLCY-1380 Fla. Traces of rr mx noted u/ZNS during WNIO time, no IDs. WHLW not tried. KSRM not hrd. Jim Boyd logged WAYT-1510 w/fair sigs 0319-0355 2/14 w/IDs, time, and temp. checks + MoR mx. WNIO not hrd but did log ZNS-1, in the clear. All other flash tips are from previous week's stuff. No rpts of KSVC, WBRW, WEEZ, or KSDR. KLEB and WAYT/WNIO were definitely on. No word on KSRM either. Keep the flash tips coming, mailed as quickly as possible. - 962 ... Finland, Turku finally heard mixing with Tunis with newscast in what I believe to be Finnish. Followed by several "Suomi"s and variations thereof which naturally left no doubt whatever for country #90, 2/2 2325-30. (RJE,E)
- 1205 ... Sierra Leone, Freetown, snakecharmer flute notes slipped through the hash briefly about 0557 2/6, along with traces of probable Bordeaux interferences. Thought Europe might be reviving, for noted carriers at 1214 and 1034 about same time, but by MM, 24 hours later, no trace of TA signals. (GM,M)
- 1313 ... Norway, Stavanger, finally this one produced something more than patches of audio 0547 2/7, with upbeat music, lengthy commentary between selections. (RJE,E)
- 1367 ... International Waters, Radio Northsea International noted with fair strength at 2300 1/28 while, strangely enough, their 49 meter channel was not audible. Weird conditions. (CMS,E)
- 1394 CSB80 Azores Islands, Angra do Heroismo atop Spaniards, looping 85° 0720 2/7 with lengthy commentary by man in PP. Thought I heard ID, but not sure. Enough though to count as Country #93. (RJE,E)
- 1493 ... European R.F.S.R.F.? Leningrad presumed the one here with femme announcer in Russian, femme vocals and instrumentals, some with pentatonic scale (indigenous to the Eastern countries), 0005-0030 s/off 2/3. Bearing about 38°. (RJE,E)
- 1529 CSB91 Madeira?, PP heard here, looping about 80°, quite strong at times, but almost all music. Brief talk about 0830, but nothing definite. PT heard mention of Funchal here at s/on... Maybe next time... (RJE,E)
- 1578 ... Norway, Fredrikstad, heard per PT tip from previous evening with news, good signal over/under Portuguese 0032-0035 2/3; country #91. (RJE,E)
- 1578 CSB5? Portugal? Emissores do Norte Reunidos, Porto tentatively identified as the one here with continental style latin music, occasional brief announcements from 0010 tune in 2/3. If so, was the only TA on the band although the regulars on 1554 and 1586 were heard later that night. (CMS,E)
- 1594 ... Holland, heard Dutch MoR program here over/under UnID talker in UnID language 0537 2/7. PT sez it was the Czech. (RJE,E)

Latin America

- 554 XEPL Mexico, Cuahutemoc, Chih., has moved here from 545. Heard apparently testing 2/6 0630-past 0840 with slow Latin music, no voice except IDs with call letters and location at 0728 and 0742. Carrier cut 0720 briefly; quite good at times despite slop. Not heard next evening, but het noted on high side of 550. (FJP,W)
- 645 ZP.. Paraguay? UnID, what is it? Heard here with poor to fairly good signals three out of the last 4 MMs. Male announcer, rapid speech with very rolled R's. Mostly talk with occasional musical selections. I have 21 minutes of tape of reception of 2/7, 0839 to complete fade out at 0900. After many replays of the tape, I am sure that the slogan, Radio Sonora, is being used. Just before fadeout, a short musical fanfare is played followed by "Desde Radio Sonora" followed by a bad static burst, naturally. Not a clue to location on the tape as far as I can tell. If any of our members who are fluent in Spanish would like to listen to the tape and see if they can come up with anything definite, let me know. Sure would like to get this one definitely identified. (AM,E)

- 660 4VUE Haiti, Cayes. I think I have heard in in English, not FF always. Superior signal to WNBC many mornings at 1000 and always stronger than the Cuban here, believed to have 10 kw. (GM,M)
- 660 HCLG2 Ecuador, Guayaquil noted with Latin music, Radio Carrousel ID 2/7 0820; faded shortly. New on frequency, from 655. (FJP,W)
- 664 TGRT Guatemala, Guatemala silent Sunday night before 0400 2/7. Think you can rely on this one being off the air Sunday nights. (GM,M)
- 670 HRN Honduras, Tegucigalpa gave call ID 2/7 at 1057. (RJS,W)
- 680 XELG Mexico, Leon, Gto., "L-G" ID 2/7 at 0913 after KNBR off. (RJS,W)
- 700 HJXC Colombia, Cali, "Radio Sutatenza" IDed 2/7 at 1033 after I had ascertained it was //810 using 9 transistor radio. (RJS,W) (XETRA off? Ed)
- 712a HJFT Colombia, Ibague, "Ecos del Combeima" heard 2/7 at 1040 as KMPC put OC on and off. Almost missed it. Excellent AM for HJs. (RJS,W)
- 720 HJAN Colombia, Barranquilla has become semi-regular since early in January. Often heard better than the Cuban when WGN is nulled 0200-0300. Barranquilla is so distinctive in its sound that it registers repeatedly as a word to listen for. Its final two syllables, KEY-YAH, are conspicuous. (GM,M)
- 770 HJXX Colombia, Bogota, "Radio Tequendama". I worked hard 1/17 to get 2 or 3 audible IDs out of this one, then 2/7 tuned here at 0917 to get perfect ID. AN. (RJS,W)
- 770 HOL62 Panama, heard here with WABC off, with SS MoR, talk 0815 over/under 400 Hz (approximately) het which messed up frequency a bit. Probably from TIW, but no audio. 2/7. (RJE,E) (I thought the call on this one was HOL83, Chitre, Russ. Ed)
- 810 HJCY Colombia, Bogota almost as loud as PJB 0959 2/6 with list of stations (assumed for Accion Cultural Popular) with HJ calls; despite good signal, buzzing static from our furnace starting (a constant hex every 20-30 minutes for about 90 seconds until it starts) made it uncopyable. No doubt about this 250-kWer, though. Also assumed to be the SS behind KGO after 0900 on good LA nights. KGO is off both SM and MM. (BH,W)
- 840 HOL80 Panama, Panama heard here with WHAS off 0630-0650 2/7 with a program featuring a rolling surf sound effect and Hawaiian music briefly between each selection. Since when do they try to fool DXers into thinking they've got something good? (RJE,E)
- 860 XEMO Mexico, Tijuana, B.C. Everyone's favorite goes off around 1000 each AM except MM when it does us a favor by staying on until 1106. Wipes out 840-880 here, less than ten miles from transmitter. (RJS,W)
- 881 ??? UnID regular het from Caribbean on WCBS many mornings after 1000. (GM,M)
- 900 HJEY Colombia, Cali, "La Voz de Cali" IDed 2/7 at 0958, difficult with XEMO/KDEO splash. Other SS there, but still no Barbados. (RJS,W)
- 930 HJCS Colombia, Bogota, "Radio Continental" heard 1/17 0915-1015 off and on with KHJ off and with OC. (RJS,W)
- 951 CMBF Cuba, Habana, Musical Nacional has been here for past week or so, badly hetting pest WPEN evenings. (RJE,E)
- 970 XEJ Mexico, Ciudad Juarez, Chih. very poor, ID at 0223 2/7. (FJP,W)
- 990 ??? Two UnID SS here, likely HJDB and the second, one of the YVs with characteristic Rumbos news, but no ID. 2/7 1045. (RJS,W)
- 1000 ??? Two UnID SS here 2/7 0830-1100 with KOMO OC at times. No readable IDs on 200 feet of tape. Is Cartagena AN? (RJS,W)
- 1017 ??? UnID LA since about mid-January, appearing here between YSC-1015 and 1020 stations. Heard about 0200-0500. Think it is not a Cuban. (GM,M) (Note Peruvian OAX4A reported here last week. Ed)
- 1018.8 CMAS Cuba, San Cristobal, Radio Guama now down here 0312 2/3. (RJE,E) (In the 2/71 RFS Cuban list, this is listed as CMAC. Ed)
- 1020 HJDP Colombia, Neiva, "Radio Colosal" ID 2/7 at 1025, heard under KGBS at 0830 with chimes and SS. After 1000 KGBS S/off, just about the only time for this in SoCal. (RJS,W)

- 1047 ??? UnID SS here 2/7 at 1050, good signal at times, but no readable ID. XED splash. Possibly HOJ2, others? (RJS,W) (TGSL only other one reported in the vicinity on 1045. Ed)
- 1055 HJFZ Colombia, Espinal, "La Voz del Centro" heard 2/7 around 1012. (RJS,W)
- 1129.3 CMHA Cuba, Santa Clara, Onda Musical heard here hetting local WNEW badly 2/3 0305. (RJE,E)
- 1165 ??? UnID SS here 2/7 at 1009, good signal at times but only when music is up. Any ideas? (RJS,W) (The same one reported in 12/25, 1/1, and 2/5 DXWW? Ed)
- 1185.1 HJGK Colombia, Bucaramanga, Radio Santander, heard here from 1180 with RCN promo, badly accented ID, then network news feature program, "Eco Sucesos" or somesuch, 0330-0355, then more RCN promos, Alka Seltzer and beer ads, (hmm-RJE), then, of all things, a "La Hora Nacional" promo, then an announcement of a program picked from HJKL SW at 0400, with a 5 minute fast TC. Excellent ;signals at times, though bad WHAM splash. 2/3. (RJE,E)
- 1185/7HJCV Colombia, Bogota, Radio Cordillera noted on 1197 kHz 2/3 at 0330, and down to about 1185 on 2/7 AN. (RJS,W)
- 1185 HJ?? UnID LA ANer new here since mid-January. Was on 1183 for a week or so hetting 1180 stations all evening. Believe I have caught a few Colombian clues. (GM,M)
- 1207a HJCD Colombia, Fusagasuga, caught 2 IDs (but no "Radio Nuevo Epoca") as "Nueva opoca..." 2/7 at 1016-1020. Excellent for listed 1 kw. (RJS,W)
- 1320 XERJ Mexico, Mazatlan, Sin., got a call ID 2/5 at 0320, but could swear he said Sonora. (RJS,W)
- 1340 XEAA Mexico, Mexicali, B.C. fading in and out with KIST 2/6 0939; SIDs as "dos ...A" apparently. (FJP,W)
- 1440 XEVS Mexico, Villa Constitucion, BCS (can't find it on map) heard 1/26 at 1300 s/on with "buenos dias" and calls, then killed by KUHL s/on. (RJS,W) (About 120 miles NW of La Paz. Ed)
- 1480 ??? UnID, what sounded like a jammer here, fair to poor signal, 1115 1/24 over weak SS; could be LA or TP. (BH,W)
- 1600 XELO Mexico, Cd. Juarez, Chih. 2nd harmonic heard with Record Roost 0759 2/7 while looking for KLEB DX. (FJP,W)

Trans-Pacific

- 770 3LO Australia, Melbourne, 6 pips taped at 1000 2/7 with SSB from WABC coming right after. WABC ending rare SP put OC on air at 0956, had verbal ID 30 seconds ahead of pips, but was saying nothing as the pips arrived. LA signals nulled. At 1100 taped across the hour with WABC nulled hoping for the Japanese blockbuster to show, but results were negative. (GM,M)
- 870 KAIM Hawaii, Honolulu, EE religious program caught distinctly for few minutes through Cuba-Ecuador competition, although I was trying to renew acquaintance with LRA at the time, 0904-0908 MM 2/7. (GM,M)
- 1178 VOA Ryukyu Islands, Okinawa heard taking the air at 1330 on both 2/3 and 2/4. Spouts Korean for half an hour and the SSBs at 1400 invariably. Never a peep out of this megawatter before or after this period, and makes it here many times during poor high latitude conditions. (GM,M)

Abu Dhabi According to the 1/28 issue of Middle East Economic Digest, "The Abu Dhabi Government has signed a contract with an unnamed company for the installation of a 750,000 watt medium wave transmitter. My original idea was simply to take the past issues of DXWW and cut them into strips, arrange them all by country and frequency, and have that offset. I now think it would be just as easy to retype the whole thing, so I have begun on that task. This way I can more easily correct errors which have occurred (although rarely, because of my excellent and accurate typing, hi). 73/FJP
