British Columbia is Canada's most mountainous province, which is probably also the reason it contains the greatest number of LPRTs of any province, around 77 to date. The most well known of these LPRTS is CBXQ-540 in Ucluelet. This relay often makes it down the coast as far as California and has also been heard in Alberta. But in general most LPRTs do not get out that well, and are certainly not your best bet if you have not heard British Columbia.

Your best bet for British Columbia, unless you happen to live near XETRA, would be CBU-690. If you live in the east the best time to listen for them seems to be a MM after CBF signs off but before CBU's 0300 sign off. For those living in California or those who have heard CBU, other possibilities include CKLG-730, CKWX-1130, CKDA-1220, CHQM-

1320, and CKVN-1410.
