LATE NEWS ON WARC

from HR REPORT

"...the FCC's final WARC position was set at a closed Commission meeting Tuesday, Dec. 5. Few details of the actual U.S. WARC frequency tables were provided at a Wednesday press conference announcing the action, but the Commission's press release did specify that it enderses expansion of AM broadcast to 1.86 mHz (1860 kHz), lopping 60 kHz off of the 160 meter amateur band.

Release Of the Complete WARC report is promised "in the near future," providing further information on the U.S. position with respect to all services."
