

Religious radio has apparently been outlawed in Mexico. XEMO-860 has reduced its broadcasting hours. KMJC-910 El Cajon CA has switched from top 40 to religion to fill in the gap in San Diego. XERF-1570 Cuidad Acuna has gone to beautiful music. XEPRS-1090 Rosarita is mostly Spanish top 40 with some Yiddish & Arabic programming.

Format rumors: WLS-890 to talk. The 94.7 station in Chicago has already applied for WLS-FM and a third of the AM's broadcast day is already simulcast...KJR-950 Seattle WA has just been taken over by Metromedia and in spite of the fact that the takeover was proudly announced in Broadcasting in a 2-page color ad, rumor has it that KJR will go country...WRIV-1390 Riverhead NY may soon be switching from a more traditional MOR format to pop when new management is in place.

Station news: DX programs can be heard in some parts of the country. WPTF-680 Raleigh NC has a locally-produced one, on 2102-2130 ELT Sundays. Mike Blackman is the host, and often uses inserts from DXer Glenn Hauser's WORLD OF RADIO series. That's also on KERE-710 Denver CO 0830 Sundays MLT...WTAR-790 Norfolk VA runs talk in the evenings now; so does competitor WNIS-1350...The 1500-1800 PLT show on KMPC-710 Los Angeles is now called the GARY OWENS MAGAZINE and, as you may have guessed, includes talk, news, traffic, weather, general fooling around and no music...Al Collins (ex-KGO-810) is now at KKIS-990 Pittsburg CA. His talk show may be networked around the Pacific states soon...The Saturday salsa show which was dumped from the 106.7 station in New York when it went country has resurfaced on WJIT-1480 on a daily basis 1900-2300...Dick "Haynes at the Reins", KLAC-570's morning man, is seriously ill and probably will not return to the station...WPKX-730 Alexandria VA, as threatened, has given away \$250,000 to a listener from Oxon Hill MD. The listener was well-prepared and was able to name the last three songs and artists played when telephoned at random and asked.

Off-the-air department: WPRZ-1330 Evanston IL; WVAB-1550 Virginia Beach VA; KATR-1320 Eugene OR.

Network stuff: Mutual's New Year's Eve special COUNTRY MUSIC COUNTDOWN will be heard on at least 536 stations. It will be hosted by Ann Murray and WHN-1050's Mike Fitzgerald...There's a new NIGHTCALL net, formed by several former NITECAP SHOW hosts, originating from San Diego and providing telephone small-talk in the wee hours...Enterprise Radio, the new all-sports network, has signed up a few affiliates: WWRL-1600 NY, KDIA-1310 CA, KIKK-650 TX, WDIA-1070 TN. It feeds 48 daily sports updates plus twenty 2-minute weekly features and a three-hour overnight sports talk show...The first live concert satellited nationally by a commercial network was fed on 11/26 by RKO. It was BOZ SCAGGS from Radio City Music Hall in New York...CBS has scheduled several holiday specials including performances by the SALT LAKE TABERNACLE CHOIR and a CBS CAVALCADE OF CHRISTMAS MUSIC. All feeds are between December 21 and 25 inclusive.

Syndicated: The new MERV GRIFFIN RADIO SHOW is on KMPC-710 at 1405 PLT and on KVI-570 at 1905 PLT...There's another syndicated country program: the STAN HITCHCOCK RADIO SHOW, based on the TV series. It's on WKDA-1230 TN, WPLO-590 GA, KSON-1240 CA and WMNI-920 OH...a new 30-minute JEWISH SPECTRUM public affairs program is out, available as a tradeout... Oh, yes, and National Public Radio's traditional JAZZ ALIVE NEW YEAR'S SPECIAL will take nine hours this year, uplinked live in stereo from four different cities, with cities appearing live conveniently as midnight passes in their time zone.

## OF SPECIAL INTEREST

I happened to be glancing through the Eastern DX Roundup and came across the item of CJGX-940. This item was in the vol. 18, no. 8 issue. Saul Chernos mentioned receiving CJGX and another station he took to be CJRI because of the mentions of Kenora. I agree with there being no Ontario station on 940 or CJRI moving.

What I think actually occurred was that what he heard is actually one station, that being CJGX. He did not mention any fading but there quite possibly was some. CJGX is one of my locals and many times I've heard commercials for a town which I've passed through on the way to Yorkton - that being the town of Canora which is approximately 50 km (30 miles) north of Yorkton. Further to CJGX - if someone hears mentions of towns in Saskatchewan or Manitoba on 940 it more than likely is CJGX as their salesmen travel great distances to get advertising. It might pay to consult a map if unsure of the name - best bet for area to check is Melfort & Hudson Bay, Sask. to the north, Saskatoon & Melville to west, Regina, SK and Brandon, MB to south and Dauphin, MB to the east. There are also many mentions of advertisers in Swan River as well. Needless to say, this area is in their primary coverage area.



It could be a good year for BOB DX, as I think I see the beginning of a trend AWAY from ANING by PCB stations. I've noted some Mid-Western DXers mentioning three or four stations in the MI area who've quit ANING on AK, but have their FMs running 'round the clock. In the Great North East, I know of two who have given it up - WWC0-1240 Waterbury CT now signs off nightly at 1 am, and WAEY1400 Albany NY goes off at midnight, having dropped the Larry King Show. They are now REL/GCS. In their area, WTRY-980 picked up King, and our semi-local here, WCAP, Lowell MA now on with fulltime, is also carrying Sir Lawrence's AK thing, and the two together set up an interesting echo, much like I hear on 1350 with WUIS and WWHW both carrying his jabber, and on 1590 where WQQW & WAKR set up the same echo-like effect. (Remember the days of WIS on RCY/WPOP?-FRM) One thing this does for us DYers - it cleans out the channel of music, and any testers can be heard readily through the two carrying King! My gripe with 1980 radio has more to do with attitudes than with specific songs or artists. For example, when WTRU tells me that they are the station I grew up with (and I did, in a sense - they were the only station in town for me when I was in junior high), but then refused to play any songs that even mildly rock, the subliminal message is that "growing up" means slowing way down (senile by age 25?). I refuse to accept that notion. Rock radio isn't the only type of radio hurt by the "take the edges off the music" notion, however. I have noticed several commercial classical stations have adopted their own version of "Top 40" - they only play super-familiar works by the very BIG names, refusing to air lesser-known works or more controversial modern music. Some Black stations (WBLS a prime example) have "whitened up" to such a degree that they refuse to play any song by any Black artist that hasn't crossed over to pop lists. Black DJs are forbidden to speak to the inner city, instead they sound just like every other suburban white AdCon DJ. And in country music, how many of the nouveau-country DJs really know anything about country's roots, and how much of what is labelled "country" these days on the radio is really true to these roots? There are still stations that do programme intelligently - WBON with rock, WEWK-1140 with soul, WFFT with classical, WJEZ with country. But the examples of such good radio are getting fewer. Free offer time: If you like rock and roll oldies, old-time screaming T40 radio, and really wanna feel good, send me a C-90 and I'll send you an aircheck of WLAV-FM's DUNG. That's the airname this person uses, and he offers up one of the best rock and roll programmes I've ever heard. George Greene, PRM, and Mark Connelly have heard this dude, and they like him. You will too. Bye.



If you can get CHWK 1270 on another set (if KGOOK or KTLG doesn't bother you), it may be easier to hear CFVR (twins CHWK on AN show). CFVR blasts in here, but KTAC/KOA can be heard on the null, and CKRD at times when they switch to DA pattern.

C-ISLe 940 Richmond has a great directional pattern, true to the registered pattern. They blanket Richmond, Vancouver, most of Burnaby and the north shore (N. Van and W.
