### DX Tests

There were some very large solar flares on February 3 &4, leading to geomagnetic storms later that week, A-indices were quite high for several days and peaked at well over 200 on Saturday, February 8: Rader Neder-land reported that the storm was the biggest since 1960, rather ironic when you consider we're supposedly at the bottom of the solar cycle. There was quite a bit of good foreign DX from Latin America and down under reported around that time and early the following week. See the DX Worldwide columns this week for details. And probably next week, too. Since solar activity follows a 27 day cycle, it would be worthwhile to watch out for similar conditions during the first week in March.

KOFY-1050 has left the air, according to newspaper articles sent in by Robert Wien and Doug Nyholm. The move is only temporary, however, as they plan to return to the air March 1 with an English language format. (They were Spanish). The new owner of the station is Jim Gabbert, long station was KIQI-1010 which switched from English to Spanish after he sold it! The station's new format has not yet been revealed, but long term plans include raising (or trying to raise) power from 1 kw to 50kw.

In other format changes, Karl Jeter reports that WQXI-790 is dropping their personality-oriented hit radio format, in favor of something else, like FM simulcast or a satellite feed. Low ratings are the reason for the change.

### MINI MWT-1C

### A Simple, yet Versatile, Medium-Wave Tuner

### Introduction

This article is a continuance of DX engineering work on the MWT family of tuners (previous articles: 18 DEC 1985, 07 JAN 1986).

The Mini-MWT-1C, to a certain degree, resembles the other Mini-MWT's; however, some less-necessary features of the -1A and -1B have been removed to permit simpler operation and to provide other capabilities possibly of greater worth to some DXers. Reducing the cost of the unit and the complexity of its construction are also design goals of Mini-MWT-1C. For instance, the BBA-B Broadband Amplifier Card (estimated cost to build = \$ 10) is used rather than the RFE-A Front End Card which costs nearly twice as much to make.

Items that were removed: Q switch, car radio/car ant. jacks, special setting for wires shorter than 3 m. / 10', non-medium-wave tuning, and vernier (fine) tuning. For many DXers, these items are unneeded frills.

Added features are passive tuning (a feature shared with the larger MWT-1) and broadband amplification (a feature not provided by any other heretofore-released MWT-family tuner). The four functions of the Mini-MWT-1C are governed by the settings of two simple toggle switches, 52 and 53, in accordance with Table 1:



The broadband amplification function is very useful in beefing up the anemic output of smaller tuned loop antennae such as the Palomer.

Construction details are being foregone other than to provide a schematic (Figure 1) and a hole list (Table 2). Much of the information (frequency coverage, operation, construction, parts lists, etc.) of the two previous MWT-family tuner articles may be applied here. The BBA-B Broadband Amplifier card is fully described in the article "MMDX-4 and Mini-MWDX-4 series Phasing Units", dated 11 OCT 1985.

The Mini-MWT-IC may be purchased, fully assembled, for \$ 50 (US) plus \$ 5 shipping within the continental USA / \$ 10 shipping to Canada, Alaska, Bawaii, and US territories/ \$ 15 shipping to anywhere else. Checks / money orders should be sent to Mark Connelly - 30 William Road - Billerica, MA 01866 USA. Note that this price is about \$ 25 less than that of a Mini-MWT-IA or Mini-MWT-IB and about \$ 50 less than that of the MWT-I Regeneration-Capable tuner. An available option for longwave-only DXers is frequency coverage of 100 - 550 kHz by using different tank coils (LI = 10000 uH, L2 = 3900, L3 = 1500, L4 = 560, L5 = 2200, L6 = 820, L7 = 330, L8 = 120) and a higher C4 (56 pF instead of 39 pF). There are no additional charges for this longwave version (which we'll call Mini-LWT-IC). Delivery time is approximately 4 weeks after receipt of order for the medium wave version and 6 weeks (because LW coils are not normally stocked) for the longwave model.

### Operating the Mini-MWT-1C

The tuned modes of a standard Mini-MWT-LC provide coverage of 450 - 2000 kHz (ship traffic, standard AM broadcast band, and 160metre ham band).

The controls and connector lists (below), coupled with the schematic given in the 10 JAN 1986 article, should be referenced during the operating instructions.

### Applications Notes

Use Radio Shack 278-120 adapter to convert J3 to SO-239 (VHF) type jack. Use Radio Shack 278-251 adapter to convert J3 to "F" type jack.
Use Radio Shack 278-254 adapter to convert J3 to RCA phono-jack.

These adapters may be used to convert Jl similarly.

\*

\* NOTE: NEVER CONNECT A WIRE OR OTHER RF SOURCE TO J1 OR J2 \*

(Failure to do this may result in damage to the Broadband Amplifier Card.)

Before operating any of the four modes, connections to/from the Mini-MMT-1C must be made. The antenna or other signal source may be connected to Jl or J2. Earth ground should be connected, via cliplead, to the "Gl" ground lug (on the left side of the unit) if the cable to the receiver will be longer than 10'/3 m. or if the receiver is not grounded through mains or by some other connection. Grounding may help to reduce RF noise conducted or radiated by nearby power lines. Connect a coaxial cable to the receiver input from J3. A shielded communications-type receiver should be used; successful tuner operation with receivers using ferrite rod aerials (e. g. portable radios) is not always possible because of the inherent stray pickup of ferrite rods.

### Standard Operating Procedures

1.0 Mode (1) direct feed of antenna to receiver

Note: Cl and Sl are not used in Mode (1); their positions are irrelevant.

- 1.1 Set 53 to Amplifier Off (= down).
- 1.2 Set Rl initially to fully CCW (the switch on Rl takes this attenuation pot out of the line).
- 1.3 Set S2 to Broadband (= down).
- 1.4 With receiver on desired frequency, check that the wanted signal is of sufficient strength and has no spurious mixing signals or images from strong local stations. If spurs / images are present, adjust Rl until they go away. If the wanted station is now too weak, use of operating mode (2) or (3) is suggested.
- 2.0 Mode (2) passive tuning

Note: Minimum suggested wire length for passive tuning is 33'/10 m.

- 2.1 Set S3 to Amplifier Off (= down).
- 2.2 Set Rl to fully CCW (attenuator out of line).
- 2.3 Set Sl for operating frequency range desired, per chart below:

- 2.4 Set S2 to Tuned (= up).
- 2.5 Adjust Cl for maximum desired-frequency signal.
- 2.6 If overloading-caused spurious responses QRM the desired signal when Cl is properly peaked, adjust Rl to make the spurs go away. Slight re-peaking of Cl may then be necessary.

### 3.0 Mode (3) active tuning

- 3.1 Do all passive tuning steps 2.1 through 2.6. Note: If Rl adjustment was required in step 2.6, active tuning might not offer any signal-to-noise improvement.
- 3.2 Set S3 to Amplifier On (= up).

- 3.3 If overloading-caused spurious responses QRM the desired signal when Cl is properly peaked, adjust Rl to make the spurs go away. Slight re-peaking of Cl may then be necessary.
  - 4.0 Mode (4) broadband amplification

Note: Cl and Sl are not used in Mode (4); their positions are irrelevant.
Note: This mode is not recommended for wire antenna inputs (medium-wave and shortwave spurs will likely result). The following procedure outlines broadband amplification of the output of a tuned loop antenna (e. g. Radio West loop, NRC loop) or a phaser (e. g. Mini-MWDX-4A, Phase One).

- 4.1 Set S3 to Amplifier Off (= down).
- 4.2 Set R1 initially to fully CCW (the switch on R1 takes this attenuation pot out of the line).
- 4.3 Set S2 to Broadband (= down).
- 4.4 Connect loop or phaser output coaxial cable to J1; connect nothing to J2. (Receiver is still connected to J3; battery to J4.)
- 4.5 Adjust loop or phaser controls as you normally would.
- 4.6 Set S3 to Amplifier On (= up).
- 4.7 If overloading-caused spurious responses QRM the desired signal, adjust Rl to make the spurs go away.

### Possible Mini-MWT-1C Enhancements / Modifications

- \* For those who habitually use shorter aerials (i.e. less than 100'/30 m.), the coupling capacitor (C4) could be increased to 47, 56, or 62 pF with no degradation of unattenuated-input tank-circuit Q. Greater coupling efficiency would be the result.
- \* The CCW pin of R1 may be separated from the R1 wiper arm. (The CCW pin would go to C3; the arm to switch S2 section A arm.) This has been found to give somewhat smoother level adjustment with certain lengths of antennae in strong-signal urban/suburban environments.
- \* A 1K linear pot with switch may be substituted for the 500 ohm Rl pot (if no 500 ohm pots are available). There are no detrimental effects on level-adjustment-smoothness as long as the CCW pin and wiper arm of Rl are not tied together (see previous item).
- \* Some might want to try putting the Rl pot on the line between the S2B arm and the S3A arm rather than in its present position (see schematic in 10 JAN 1986 article). Doing this will improve tank Q under some circumstances requiring attenuation; however, certain inductively-reactive inputs could cause poorer Q tuning if not shunted by the attenuator pot. The beauty of the Mini-MWT-lC design is that it's so simple that it lends itself to easy experimentation, modification, and restoration to its original state (should a given experiment not result in a performance improvement for the particular user).
- \* A different broadband amplifier (Al) could be used. If the unit was going to be used with an external power supply yielding higher current and/or voltage than a 9-volt battery, a more "muscular" amplifier (giving much better dynamic range, gain, and noise characteristics) could be incorporated. AGC (automatic gain control) might be an amplifier feature worth investigating.
- $^\star$  A six-position two-pole switch could be used for S1 (along with additional coils /  $\tilde{a}$  la Mini-MWT-lA) to provide extra frequency ranges.
- $^\star$  . Other types of connectors could be used for Jl & J3 if a given user is not happy with industry-standard BNC types.
- \* Those who use many wire lengths could install a "length switch" SPDT toggle at the present C4 (electrical) location. This switch could select one of two different coupling capacitor values: a low value (e. g. 33 pF) for longer wires and a higher value (e. g. 100 pF) for shorter wires. I left this feature out because the whole idea of Mini-MWT-1C is simplicity. 39 pF or 47 pF is a good "middle-of-the-road" C4 coupling capacitor value usable with most of the wire aerials that MW DXers employ.

Greetings and all that. Things have slowed down considerably with little attention paid to current DX due to inactivity on my part.

Please keep in mind the new and revised IRCA Anniversary issue deadline. I've never lived in a place where I didn't immediately know the location

of the local radio transmitters, so for the last three months I've been miffed at the lack of information of local transmitters, I had already found KSAC, KXOA and KGNR, but still had a shopping list for them.

My big break came on OB February. I knew that KSMJ 1380 (ex-KGMS) had moved when they upped their power. I knew that they nulled east/west when their old defunct location would null north/south. I also knew that logically that because Sacramento had virtually no growth to the west (thanks to a deep water shipping canal and further west a flood control basin) and because they had to protect KTOM 1380 Salinas 120 air miles southwest, they had to be to the west of Sacramento beaming back into a metro area of one million that extended from 10 miles north and south from downtown along the Sacramento River and eastward 35 miles along I-80 to Auburn (KAHI 950) and 25 miles to Folsom (KHWY 1030) along US 50.

I happened to be in West Sacramento that day, and upon checking 1380, noticed their slop all the way down to meet KGNR 1320. So set the radio on 1400, followed the slop, and headed south on Jefferson (the only road south, hi). About four miles later scored what I thought was a "kill" with four towers to the southeast. That was KSMJ, right? Wrong, plate- voltage breath, hi. A moment later the  $\,$  trees on my right cleared to  $\,$  pasture and  $\,$  I was looking down the barrels of  $\,$  three towers on my right. ### South's pioneering station caters to posterity

TLANTA - From the simple hillbilly days of Dixie to the current boom times of the Sun Belt, the South and radio station WSB grew up together.

The history of the relationship between the self-proclaimed "Voice of the South" — indeed, its call letters stand for "Welcome South, Brother" — and the region it helped raise is being preserved in an immense archival collection that includes thousands of phonograph records and other memora-

There was no more room for the records, tapes, logbooks, letters, scripts, photographs, microphones and turntables that had been accumulating since WSB first went on the air in 1922 with a meager 100 watts of power. It was the first radio station in the Southeast, hitting the airwaves just two years after Pittsburgh's KDKA received the nation's first call letters.

WSB management decided to clean out its closets and donate the items to Georgia State University,

"WSB has been the major radio station in this part of the country from the 1920s until now," says Christopher Paton, a Georgia State archivist.

"In terms of reflecting and ex-

plaining culture, records are a pretty good way to do it. You can get insights into the different peri-ods. Someone could come in here and, by going through this collection, see the character of WSB and how it grew over the years," Paton said. "This collection is amazingly complete."

Said Mike Faherty, general man-ager of WSB, "We were sitting on a piece of history here. I thought it was important that we get them into an environment where they could be preserved for future gen-erations."

The collection of nearly 55,000 cataloged phonograph records runs the gamut of musical tastes -from Joe Stafford and the Pied Pipers to Herb Alpert and the Tijuana Brass, from Johnny Mercer to Boy George."

There is evidence of a heavy influence of religious and hillbilly music, particularly from the early days, as WSB mirrored the tastes of the South. Before phonograph turntables became prevalent, old logbooks reveal records of local entertainers performing live on the air - from the "WSB Orchestra" to church choirs and amateurs at

WSB gradually increased its

power and its regional impact. Its growth accelerated in 1939 when Ohio Gov. James M. Cox purchased the Atlanta Journal and WSB.

As the South grew and became more sophisticated, so too did WSB. The AM station powered up to 50,000 watts in 1956, reaching beyond its regional boundaries and across much of the nation after dark, and moved its playlist toward mainstream, popular mu-

There is plenty of history, too. Speeches by Roosevelt and Churchill, plus the ceremony of the Japanese surrender ending World War II are preserved on large metal discs, the forerunners of magnetic recording tape.

While the station was physically small, it was an enormous breakthrough for the South. It intro-duced listeners to the strange new world of immediate news and, for a time, provided educational programs - spelling bees, lectures and storytelling - to the Atlanta school system.

WSB also was viewed as something of a new toy for the masses.

Henry Ford, the car magnate, was so impressed after visiting WSB in its early days that he went

home to Michigan and applied for a broadcasting license. Ford later installed a transmitter in his Highland Park plant to supply entertainment for his employees.

Paton expects students at Georgia State and other nearby universities, as well as researchers from around the nation, to profit

from the collection.
"These things are here to be preserved for history," he said.

There are a couple of reports in this week's column that were rescued from my previous QTH in Erie on a recent visit there. Looking over the 1/25 DXWW-E ! noticed an error concerning my mentioning the possible TA on 1502. I meant to say "iust before local sunset coinciding with just after sunset in W. Europe". I doubt it was of TA origin, anyway. A new development in the Cuban US interference issue a Rebelde net station, seemingly running at least 50kW per my observations, came up on 704 kHz recently. An article in a recent DXM mentioned that the FCC speculates two Cuban transmitters operating on 710 (the newest Radio Rebelde frequency), so one of them may have dropped down 6kHz. It was running parallel the others, including 710. And regarding Matt Stutterheim's possible Tanzania reception on 656 (1/18), Richard Eckman suspects that it was Laayoune, Morocco (formerly Spanish Sahara). It was often heard on the East Coast, and the European Broadcasting Union lists them as being heard on  $65\underline{6}$ kHz recently, which agrees with Matt's observation. Thanks, Rich. In a different report Rich mentions that his reporting Bulgarian, Czech, or Croatian languages as simply "Slav" may offend experts such as Richard Wood. Well Rich, I'm sure that Richard, being an expert in the DX catagory also, understands that sometimes one just cannot differentiate between similar sounding languages, or music or whatever. Once again, Rich, good luck at Cambridge University. Times in this column are expressed in GMT/UTC!


