WIMA-1150, Lima, OH - tested Monday, February 21 2000 from 1:00-2:00 EST

Steve Francis of Alcoa, TN heard this test with "half-time" music, a voice ID by Fred Vobbe, and code. He described the signal as surprisingly good strength over and under CKOC (Hamilton, ON) and others. Rick Lewis in Sparta, NJ, had much the same experience and heard the ID at 0139 EST and marching music. In Ellicott City, MD, Tim Thompson reports he heard the test on his AOR AR5000 and Kiwa loop with moderate fading but multiple IDs, both voice and CW. Bill Harms in MD also heard the test but mentions that WRUN (Utica, NY) was strong by him, rather than CKOC. Tim Noonan in Madison, WI says he tried for this test and heard some code, tho the signal was pretty weak at his QTH. Bob Karchevski in Sunnyvale, CA tried for this test but heard nothing that sounded like tones or code - but he did get a new log of KAGO-OR. Tom Jasinski in Shorewood, IL heard this test fairly well at his location he reports he heard Morse code, voice IDs, march music, test tones, as well as the station mailing address and URL. He says the signal was mixing with FF talk from CJRC (Gatineau, PQ) and an unknown station with rock and roll. Mike Stonebridge in St. Isidore, AB says that while conditions at his location were better than of late, he was unable to hear the test, just some talk stations under CKIQ.

WDWS-1400, Champaign, IL - tested Tuesday, February 22, 2000 from 1:10-1:25 EST:

Mike Stonebridge in St. Isidore, AB was unable to hear this test, as was Jim Renfrew of Roxchester, NY, tho Tim Noonan in Madison, WI reports he tenatively heard it. He describes what he heard as "tones and the sound of a phone off the hook, but no IDs". Mike Csorbay of York, ON also reports tentatively hearing WDWS and the "phone off the hook" sound, along with a very weak tone and some CW. Barry McLarnon in Ottawa, ON describes hearing about the same thing, but he says it was a pure tone, about 1 kHz or so, and he heard what he described as more like random dashes instead of CW. Mike also reported that he'd received an e-mail from Eric Loy of WDWS that confirmed that the "phone off the hook" sound WAS used for the test and the test was what Mike heard.

Per call to KKJX-960 Klamath Falls, OR. 2/25/00, is on the air with ESPN sports, and is 24 hr. NSP.

Per call to KXPL-1060 El Paso, TX, is on the air, 10 kw. daytime only, but using slogan "Radio Sol" and not "La Explosiva". Signon at 6:45 AM, El Paso time in February, s/off 5:45 PM, El Paso time in February.

Shawn Axelrod of Winnipeg. MB. Passes on the following (via Pat Martin): 1150 CKX MB Brandon - 02/19 1600- Good signals with country music. Now ID'ing as "The new kicks 1 oh 1 point 1 FM CKXA-FM" Or as "The new sound of country Kicks" Also dual ID as "CKX AM 11-50 and CKXA 101.1 FM". The new FM transmitter is on. They should be gone to FM and let AM go dark within 90 days. Will open up 1150 for me for SRS and SSS skip. Tried to hear the FM signal but only got bits of it when up on a bridge in traffic. 200 kms is too far in winter for FM.

Per-Ole Steneman of Jakobstad, Finland passes along the following (via Pat Martin):

In a letter received today from Salem station KCCS I found some interesting notes regarding their transmission, could anyone in West coast area comment on their sky wave signal today compared to previous years:

AM 1220, KCCS is operating under Special Temporary Authority from the FCC to use a temporary antenna, because we no longer have a broadcast "tower". Around August first we put a three inch copper strap up the side of a 75 foot tree on our studio property. We then "Top Loaded" it using steel cables stretching from the 74 foot level to other trees in the area. This is providing a decent local signal but probably doesn't allow for a good departure angle so "skip" reception would be affected. also, while we are 1000 watts in the daytime, we lower power to 171 watts at night. We are going to build a "Valcom" 74 foot fiberglass whip antenna for permanent use. This will be a lot more efficient that our tree, but still may prevent people in your part of the world from ever receiving us again.

Pete Taylor of Tacoma, WA. passes on the following (via Pat Martin): 1110 KWDB WA Oak Harbor: After two days of testing with non-stop ID-less music (even as late as 2130 on 2/24), ID finally given 2/26 1315: "You're listening to KWDB, the voice of Whidbey Island." Signal about the same as the former KJTT's (splatter from KYCW-1090). No phone listing.

Pete Taylor also passes on the following directly to me:

1110 KWDB WA Oak Harbor. After three days of non-stop music, RS began 2/27. Ad for Whidbey Island Technical Services heard 1850. Promos include "We built it for you" and "Just what you wanted - news, sports and weather, island style." Automated with contemporary music (90s) but no rap or metal. Same voice on everything (owner is former Seattle DJ). Taking a beating from KBND at 1945.

KGHO-920 Olympia came back on the air yesterday with a "Good Time Hit Oldies" format. Also noted with a live "playing the hits of the Northwest" promo 2/10 11:15AM PST. They are currently playing ALL BEATLES.

Pete sends this on via Pat Martin:

This supersedes my 11:43AM PST E-mail on this subject.

KGHO is promoting its "Good Time HIT Oldies" format. I guess if you are well trained, you can tell the difference. Sorry about having to send a second message. Haste makes waste. Anxiety leads to impropriety!

Gary Jackson of Sacramento, CA. passes on the following:

"Per call returned on my answering machine from Rich Weathers of 580 KMJ Fresno, California on status of on when they will go to 50000 watts, he said it would be a company decision, probably based on capital available. If they decide to go this year, by the time they acquire the land and everything - else it would be end of the year before they would go 50000 or they may go to a 2 year plan. No decision has been made yet."

Pat Martin sends along additional info on this subject:

They (KMJ) are going to 4 towers 26 miles from Fresno. They are currently 1 tower 16 miles out. As you can see from the pattern, most of their signal will be due West, so little signal North & South. They had 700 mv with their non-directional pattern and with the new pattern a lot less power N/S.

Gary Jackson sends along the following (via Pat Martin):

1690 kHz - CA, Roseville- KSXX according to Gary Jackson of Sacramento CA. KSXX will be on in a month. He got a phone call from Freedom Communications. So watch for testing.

1700 kHz - OR, Astoria-KCHT according to the new owner, 1700 should be coming on sometime this year. They are going to // 1370, which is talk for 5 years and then turn 1370 off.

Pete Kemp (location unknown) sends along the following via Pat Martin: WINE-940 (Brookfield, CT.) and WPUT-1510 (Brewster, NY.) have switched programming from Country Western to satellite fed Music of your Life. It does sound rather strange hearing Motor Racing Network (MRN.) with Daytona reports, coupled with standards programming. It fits much better with country music.

It looks as if WTKZ in Allentown, PA has gone over to SS and "La Mega". Judging by the bearing and strength (realizing a recent power/pattern change CP is on too.) I'm pretty sure on this, and of course SS domestics are even harder to get a legal EE ID from the sportstalk stations. Also, I had two ID's at 1630 this afternoon, one for WICO-MD and the other for WATK-CT, one with AC and the other with REL, although impossible to tell which was which due to the SS. Any help

will be appreciated, and, I guess we can look for a call change soon in Allentown...

Pete Taylor of Tacoma, WA. passes along the following information on 1650 Denver, CO.:

In the DXN received today (2/9/00-ed.), I note that three DXers have reported reception of "KBDJ-1650" in Denver. My tape of their ID says KBJD, and a call to the station confirms this.

As I recall, it seemed like the FCC was assigning alphabetically sequential call letters to X-band stations which as they got closer to going on the air, requested different ones. I do not recall seeing either KBJD or KBDJ specifically requested by the owners (Salem); that of course doesn't mean it didn't happen. Salem is a fairly sophisticated operator and I don't think they would just randomly invert a couple of letters for kicks. What's interesting is that the lady answering the phone went by the name "DJ."

I talked with the Assistant engineer, Chris Rand (he built the studio) and told him the station had been listed as KBDJ ever since we first saw it in the FCC files. He mentioned he didn't quite understand why all these reports had come in addressed to KBDJ. He confirmed that the FCC had assigned the calls in sequential order and that the owners (Salem, out of Camarillo, CA) had sent the grant forms to the station. It is carried in the FCC database as KBJD. Chris conjectures that he thinks KBDJ must have been incorrectly entered in the database the first time around.

Randy Stewart of Springfield, MO. Passes on the following (via Pat Martin of Seaside, OR.):

Today's Springfield News-Leader (Feb.9) notes some changes in local AMs. Our email server on-campus has been down or I would've made mention of some of these sooner--however, I didn't have all the info 'til the article came out in this morning's paper.

KGMY-1400, formerly "Memories 1400 AM" (nostalgia-music format) is currently airing ESPN Radio 6am to 6pm and simulcasting its Sunburst Media sister station, "US-97," classic-rock KXUS 97.3FM overnight. As of April 15 they hope to go 24 hours ESPN Radio, after ESPN's current contract with rival Meyer Communications expires. Meyer is LEASING KIDS-1340 12 hours a day (6PM to 6AM) running ESPN; daytime is Branson Information Radio (Branson tourist infomercials). Now, Branson Information Radio ALSO runs on KLFJ-1550 (NOT a simulcast, though...). Meyer is in negotiations to purchase KIDS, and says he won't run "infomercials" on it if & when the sale goes through, supposedly in 60 days. (KIDS, as you can tell by the call, used to be a kid format -- and not Disney or Radio Ahs, but all LOCALLY produced... which meant a lot of old kiddie 45s and 78s and the like. Obviously they couldn't keep THAT up forever.) Meyer also owns all-talk KWTO-560 and several FMs. KGMY turned off their stereo generator last fall--in anticipation of this change perhaps?

Wow, 4 weeks' worth of columns! I was sick last 2 weeks so jam-packed everything I had to catch up on into a mega-column here! Hope I didn't miss anything or anyone, if I did, it was inadvertent. Wow, tomorrow is a leap day, hope our PC's don't go wacko on us! Have 2 promising job leads locally (one offer), and 2 promising ones in the L.A. area. Will keep you abreast. 11 days and counting to a San Jose GTG with some other DX'ers too! 73's.


