a card, letter, or e-mail to the station personnel, thanking them for going to the trouble to run a test!

**Sunday, February 3, 2002** - WKDK-1240, Newberry, SC will conduct a DX test from 12:00-1:00am EST. Tones of 400 Hz and 1000 Hz as well as Morse code IDs will be broadcast. The station's regular format is AC - some DX music (marches) will be played. WKDK will be operating at 1000 W non-directional. For QSLs, a SASE is REQUIRED! QSLs will be sent on station letterhead with a refrigerator magnet, and a Newberry County calendar will be given away. Also, calls will be taken during the test at 1-800-749-WKDK (9535) - callers will be put on the air!

Further, this station will send CW IDs every day during the month of February, 2002 at 6:04 am EST, immediately following ABC news.

Here's the result of the most recent DX test that has been received here:

WRNI-1290, Providence, RI - tested Sunday, January 20, 2002 from 12:00-1:00 am EST: This test was heard by mainly those in the East. Rick Kenneally in Wilton, CT reports that WRNI is a semi-regular at his QTH most evenings, but he heard the test very weakly, with some CJBK and others mixing in. CJBK was also mixed in with WRNI in what Barry McLarnon in Ottawa, ON and Mike Battaglino in Madison, NJ heard. Jason in SE NJ says he heard WRNI very faintly under a mess of other stations. Phil Greenspan in Marshfield, MA says WRNI's signal was strong at his location; Charlie Washburn in North Perry, ME, heard the test well. Gordon Bell in Melrose, NY (near Troy, NY) detailed the entire CW sequence in his report. However, from the reports received here, the rest of the country didn't fare as well! Rick Dau in Omaha, NE, tried, but reported he has KKAR nearby. Larry Russell in mid-MI tried for the test but didn't hear it, as did Tim Noonan in Madison, WI, Nigel Pimblett in Medicine Hat, AB, Randy Stewart in Springfield, MO, Kevin Redding in Mesa. AZ. Tom Kraft in Billings, MT. Paul LaFreniere in Grand Marais, MN. Bob Foxworth in Tampa, FL, Patrick Griffith in Westminster, CO, Robert Wien in San Jose, CA, Jeff Falconer in Clinton, ON, Mike Brooker in Toronto, ON, or Joe Rocchino in Cuddy, PA. Charles Bernth in Eastport. NY reports that he heard a CW "R", "I", and "9", but CJBK was far too dominant.
