

Web Sites for AM DX Stuff

The Canadian **Institute for National Measurement Standards**, part of the National Research Council, has a web site that covers all aspects of time and measurement, including an explanation of, and links to, shortwave time station CHU; maps of the standard and summer time zones across Canada; an explanation of, and definitions for the dates Easter is held; the solstices and equinoxes, and much more. Look at http://www.nrc.ca/inms/time/tze.html.



Art Blair sent me a link to a website that maps out how to hear radio programs depending on which highway you are driving on. It's called www.radioroadtrip.com, **"Your guide to find** *Radio* **stations on your next** *Roadtrip*. Stations listed by Highway from North to South or West to East. Just as you would read a book." The example he used was Art Bell. It lists, by Interstate, in numerical order, the city, frequency, calls, coverage area in miles, day and night, and the time the program is on if different from the normal hours.

Confused about the continually expanding number of **area codes**? Want to know if 264 is practically next door or is actually in one of the islands in the Caribbean? Check out http://www.areacode-info.com/ to keep track.

There's been a flurry of activity in the **digital radio** front recently, including a demonstration of the Ibiquity system at NAB in Las Vegas. Another scheme not as widely talked about is the DRM, or **Digital Radio Mondiale**. As the website states, it's a "worldwide initiative to bring AM radio into digital era (sic)". They demonstrated their version at NAB as well. Their url is http://www.drm.org/indexdeuz.htm.
