Priced at \$200, the XDR-S3HD radio has a backlit display, a built-in AM/FM/HD digital tuner, an alarm clock, stereo speakers, a wireless remote and an audio jack for an MP3 player. www.sonystyle.com. I think it means "receiving" instead of "broadcasting". I don't know if it is worth the \$200 or not. Only time will tell, but it is the first radio I have run across to handle the new technology.
