Sat 02/06/10 0000-0200 1150 WGGH Marion IL (Walker)

WGGH 1150 IL MARION. Date: Sunday morning (late Saturday night) February, 6, 2010. Time: 0000-0200 ELT (0500-0700 UTC). Mode of Operation: 5000 watts (daytime pattern). Programming: Classic Country, oldies music and various sound effects.

I spoke to the station owner today, and coinciding with some tweaking of our Omnia audio processing, we will also conduct a DX Test! It will happen on February 6th from 12am to 2am (Friday going into Saturday, not Saturday into Sunday) We will operate at our full 5000 Watts and Day pattern. The test will consist of classic country and oldies music along with tons of various sound effects. It should be fairly easy to identify the station, as our slogan is somewhat unique, "Monster Radio AM 1150". We also have TM Century jingles, including one used every hour for a legal id (spoken... "Southern Illinois Trusted Voice Since 1949, (sung) AM 1150 WGGH Marion.") The time the test actually starts will be

largely dependent on when the last classic country song in the 11pm hour ends. We will remain at low power until the exact moment before our 12am legal id plays. (It has run as late as 12:03am). I plan on being in the studio live and "jocking" the test. We may or may not have a contest with a prize to giveaway but a call-in contest. I need to find a prize of interest to people nationwide, if anyone has anything to donate, please let me know. Our studio number is (618) 993-8102. Do NOT call about anything DX test related until the night of the actual test. I will NOT be in the studio till right before the test. I will handle QSL requests, but you MUST send a self addressed envelope with at least 2 stamps, otherwise you will not get a

If you send a cassette tape, cue it up to where it needs to be or I won't listen. Our web streaming will be disabled during this test. Also, please be aware our mailbox at the post office is only checked twice a

week, so you may not get an immediate reply. Make SURE you address the envelope and letter to my attention or I may not see it right away. Unfortunately, we have no bumper stickers, pens or anything else to give out. You will most likely get just a letter. If we have coverage maps, I might send those. Martin reports that KSUE-1240 later returned his prepared card and included a brochure on their stations. The e-mail address reported above for Bill Lipis at XEPE-1700 is from a report sent in to the December 2006 Verification Signers column, since no e-mail address was indicated for the tip reported to the IRCA ListServ this month. This column was prepared on 11/30/09 and is dedicated to the memory of Harry Helms. I have three verifications in my collection signed by Harry, all for stations conducting DX tests. I have two of his familiar small, but fully detailed, tan QSL cards for a 7/26/70 reception (yes, a DX test in July!) of WBSC-1550 in Bennettsville, SC and for a 3/22/71 reception of WAGL-1560 in Lancaster, SC, but one of my most prized verifications is the letter he wrote for a 3/11/70 reception of WIXE-1190 in Monroe, North Carolina. In it, he wrote "I truly enjoyed your fine report. It seems that some experienced DXers have yet to learn that it is good practice to include song titles when reporting a DX test, as such information is included in a station's log to ease proof of reception whenever a DX test is sched. Many thanks for reporting in this manner." When you are 15 years old, such praise was very exciting. Little did I know at the time that Harry was only two years older than me! 73, SSH.

The IRCA is a non-profit organization devoted to the hobby of hearing distant stations on the Broadcast Band (510-1720 kHz).
