FROM: RADIO JOURNAL Windstorms affect LA broadcasters. Southern California is still catching its collective breath after surviving record windstorms last week. On the radio, the most obvious victim of the high winds was CBS Radio's KNX, Los Angeles (1070), which lost its incoming audio feeds Wednesday night. But the biggest damage was up on Mount Wilson and neighboring Mount Harvard, more than a mile above the LA basin, where the winds took out both the main and backup power feeds and toppled one TV antenna on Mount Harvard, forcing KSCI-TV (Channel 18) to switch to a backup site. Remarkably, the KSCI antenna fell down the side of the mountain, missing the other TV antennas and transmission lines on the crowded Mount Harvard community tower. Mount Harvard is also home to public broadcaster KUSC (91.5), the tower's only FM tenant, but it survived the windstorm and antenna collapse without incident.

FROM: RADIO JOURNAL Another directional AM goes non-DA. The Cromwell Group's WVJS, Owensboro, KY (1420) has long enjoyed the best AM signal in its market, with 5000 watts by day and 1000 watts at night from a four-tower array near the western end of the US 60 bypass and the Ohio River. But the array was becoming a challenge to maintain, especially in the last few years after a cable TV company built a headend tower nearby, and so WVJS has now applied to drop three of its towers, going non-directional from the remaining tower with 980 watts by day and 20 watts at night. That won't affect the station's coverage as much as it once might have, though: WVJS now has an in-town FM translator, W263BG (100.5), to provide a 24-hour signal to Owensboro and vicinity. Shorter tower for an AM near Charlotte. Concord, North Carolina is best known these days as a major hub of NASCAR racing, home to the Charlotte Motor Speedway. But there was a time when a radio facility on Concord Parkway was something of a local landmark, too, home to WEGO (1410) and WPEG (97.9). The FM station eventually moved both its studio and transmitter facilities closer to Charlotte – but the AM station, now known as WTIX, continued to use the 510-foot tower behind the building until just last month, when the tower was dismantled. WTIX is operating from temporary facilities while it rebuilds at the site on a shorter tower. It will continue to use 1000 watts by day, but will drop from 18 watts to 9 watts at night.

FROM: RADIO JOURNAL New AMs on "graveyard" channels, big and small. The 2004 window for new AM applications continues to grind out new signals, ever so slowly. In western Kansas, Steckline Communications recently signed on a brand-new class C AM facility, KGGG, Garden City (1340), running 1-kw by day and 880 watts at night, non-directional. And in Hilo, Hawaii, Mark Allen now has a construction permit for a new station on 1450 – but unlike any other US-licensed station on those "graveyard" channels, Allen's new signal will run 5000 watts, non-directional day and night. The FCC's rules allow for class B stations with up to 50-kw on those six channels (1230, 1240, 1340, 1400, 1450, 1490) outside the continental US, but the provision has never been used for an actual station until now.

FROM: RADIO JOURNAL Two late license renewals mean a big fine. Hope Broadcasting's WFGN, Gaffney, SC (1180) failed to file for its license renewal back in 2003, and it took the FCC a while to catch up: it wasn't until earlier in 2011 that the Commission notified WFGN that its license was being cancelled and its call sign deleted. On May 25, WFGN filed a renewal application for the 2003 cycle, as well as an application for Special Temporary Authority to keep operating. That STA was granted – but now the FCC says WFGN has again missed an application deadline, failing to apply on time for its 2011 renewal in August. The FCC has now issued a Notice of Apparent Liability for \$10,000 against WFGN: \$4,000 for unauthorized operation after the 2003 renewal went unfiled, plus \$3,000 for each late renewal.

FROM: Radio Info Dot Com: The "Occupy" movement is targeting San Francisco's KGO-AM. Unhappy with the recent changes made by Cumulus Media in San Francisco, fans of KGO-AM (810) have set up an "Occupy KGO" Facebook page, and even planned a protest of the firings of several talk hosts, and the new direction of the station. The group, which has over 670 likes, posted on their site their mission, expressing outrage and disappointment the decision to "change the station's formatting to all-news, most of the time! No tents required ... Our primary objective is to drive listenership down significantly and encourage major sponsors to pull-out of KGO. Our ultimate goal is to educate listeners about the emerging corporate monopoly over radio and about FCC regulations relating to this problem." KGO issued a statement after the talkhost firings, which included Gil Gross, saying, "KGO listeners are passionate about their station. We appreciate their input and feedback as we evolve from a news talk format to more news and information."

FROM: ALL ACCESS Dot Com WWCS flips to Sports BIRACH BROADCASTING Spanish WWCS-A (LA EXPLOSIVA)/PITTSBURGH, currently a simulcast of sister WSDS-A/DETROIT is flipping to Sports using FOX SPORTS RADIO and PREMIERE's JIM ROME. FSR was previously heard on crosstown CLEAR CHANNEL Sports WBGG-A before that station picked up ESPN affiliation. "After a short hiatus, FOX SPORTS RADIO is thrilled to be heard again in the great city of PITTSBURGH, stated FOX SPORTS RADIO NETWORK VP/GM DON MARTIN. "The new FOX SPORTS 540 takes pride in offering our listeners the chance to once again hear FOX SPORTS RADIO, The JIM ROME Show and The DAN PATRICK Show in the STEEL CITY," stated WWCS-A GM SIMA BIRACH JR. "We are happy to provide PITTSBURGH with the best line-up of sports programming around the clock with FOX SPORTS RADIO, and our mission is to please the great sports fans of PITTSBURGH."

FROM: Radio Info Dot Com: In Madison, Mid-West Family's talk WTDY (1670) adds an FM simulcast. The simulcast is now WTDY/WTDY-FM, adding the 106.7 FM signal that had previously simulcast country "Q106" WWQM. The Mt. Horeb, Wisconsin-licensed 106.7 comes toward Madison from the West.
