- 540 **MÉXICO** XEWA, San Luís Potosí, SLP. FEB 18 0625 – rock song in English, “Cuarenta Principales” interjected into song during a brief pause in lyrics and again a minute later plus some other DJ comment. I would find this extremely annoying if I were enjoying the music, which I almost am; 0628 to a duet in Spanish. It’s XEWA in San Luís Potosí, dominant now instead of XETX in Chihuahua, and forget about CBK. Still I doubt they are running 150 kW as listed. [Hauser-OK]
 680 **MÉXICO** XEORO, Guasave, Sin. FEB 18 1300 – starting local newscast about Sinaloa with activities of PAN party, ie XEORO, 1/0.5 kW. No problem from KNBR or KKYX yet. [Hauser-OK]
 800 **MÉXICO** XEROK, Ciudad Juárez, Chih. FEB 18 1303 – paean to Papa Francisco who just visited Juárez, from XEROK, holding own by skywave at right angle to groundwave from KQCV OKC. [Hauser-OK]
 860 **MÉXICO** XENL, Monterrey, NL. FEB 17 0532 – romantic music in Spanish from south is dominant, no problem from eastward KKOW, in somewhat auroral conditions; 0602 choral Mexican NA, 0606 ID as Radio Recuerdo, ie XENL, 5/1.5 kW. [Hauser-OK]
 1620 **CUBA** Radio Rebelde, Havana. FEB 19 0137 – Spanish pop music. Must be Rebelde FM, since not //1180 or 5025 which are in béisbol. Well, their top players defecting to MLB still have their choice of Rebeldes in América! [Hauser-OK]
 1630 **MÉXICO** XEUT, Tijuana, BC. FEB 11 0540 – Classical symphonic music. Very Good. [Barton-AZ]

- 3290 **GUYANA** Voice of Guyana, Georgetown. Feb 18 at 0458. Voice of Guyana is stronger than usual at S9+15 – but just barely modulated! 0459 I make out an ID for BBC World Service and timesignal ending one second late before news relay. Hearing this much is a feat as normally it’s a much weaker carrier only. [Hauser-OK]
 3325 **INDONESIA** RRI Palangkaraya. FEB 17 1312 – song at S4-S6, apparently only one station, so is it RRI Palangkaraya, or NBC Bougainville? Ron Howard says on this date, both were heard at 1237, but by 1305, only RRI. The day before, NBC stayed on much later. By 1325 today, circa sunrise, my 3325 has faded to S3-S5. At 1332 however, it seems like there are two carriers. I also have a JBA carrier on 6020, which I assume, and he says, is nothing but Vietnam. [Hauser-OK]
 4055 **GUATEMALA** Radio Verdad, Chiquimula. FEB 18 0505 – Radio Verdad mentions Dr Édgar Amílcar Madrid, hymn in Spanish changes to one in English, introducing “Spiritual Songs” to enjoy. It’s good at S9+25-30, but I will not assume the signal is being magically “injected” into my radio without benefit of a transmitter; rather, tropical southern signals are getting a boost, as WWV reports K-index of 4 at 0300, rising to 5 at 0600, after geomagnetic storms reaching the G2 level occurred. [Hauser-OK]

The 14th annual Long Beach Island DXpedition was held November 13-16 2015 at our long-time base, the Drifting Sands motel in Ship Bottom NJ. Some of the participants arrived Thursday, others Friday and one or two were able to attend only for one evening. Upon arrival, we discovered that since the 2014 event, a major beach replenishment project had been undertaken, resulting in a total re-configuration of beach access and protection, including a large new dune at the back of the beach.

This coupled with another re-design of the fence protecting the dune made it immediately evident that there would be no use of BOG's this year or going forward. We were able to deploy the 16x36' flag, the 6' broadband loop and two Wellbrook loops.

Conditions however were at best mediocre with a few TA's evident Thursday evening, but mostly nothing after that, and also there was no significant enhancement to the South either. Thus much of the group's effort was directed toward domestics this time. This was a distinct disappointment knowing that a number of previous regular TA transmitters on both LW and MW would be closed down before our 15th gathering.

As is often the case when conditions work against us, there was plenty of time for DX chat, checking out the various SDR's, and repairing or retuning some of the Drake R8 series receivers.

The new configuration on the beach includes a landing atop the dune along the main access area to the beach. In addition to providing an excellent vantage point for one of our antennas, this also will permit us to relocate our operations to the end of the building closest to that accessway which in turn will permit us some added area for loops, and also a better radius for them, as we will now be able to aim inland without directing the antenna pattern through the building.
