DXNEWS JANUARY 2.

Well now that the holidays are about a thing of the past, perhaps we shall be able to get ourselves together once again and do some honest to goodness DXing once again. The best part of the DX season lies before us in the next two months. Let us all make the best of the excellent DX conditions that this month and February offer to us and add many new stations to our logs.

This week we want to give you the details of our Mexican Nights which our Chairman, C. G. Huber, Ray Lewis and Earl Roberts have been working on so earnestly during the past two months. We want to take this opportunity of thanking them for such a wonderful job as they have turned out.

However there is still a question surrounding some of the DXes that have been scheduled, for we found that WEDC Chicago, Ill. would not be able to stand by during the time these programs were scheduled, but they told us that they are never on the air on Tuesday mornings, so that Earl Roberts has taken it on himself to write those stations on 1210 kycs. that have signified their intention of giving us a DX program at a time that WEDC would not be able to leave the air, and try to schedule them for Tuesday morning, January 15 and 22 instead. As yet we have not heard anything from any of them as yet, as to just what they plan to do, but we shall list both dates in our DX calendar and also mention both dates in our write-ups on these stations. Perhaps by next week we may have some definite news, however if not, you'll just have to watch closely for them on both of the mornings we have mentioned in connection with their programs.

As you already know the first of these Mexican Nights programs is scheduled for January 2 over XEAO Mexicali, B.C. This program will take place the same day that this Bulletin is sent out and we may find room to make further mention of it on page four.

The next station we wish to call to your attention is XEWZ, 1150 kycs. Mexico City, D.F. This station has promised to run a program for us on the mornings of January 11, 12 and 13 from 1:00 to 2:00 A.M., EST. We are proud to have these three fine programs from XEWZ as a portion of our Mexican Nights Party.

XEAA. 920 kycs. Mexicali, B.C. have also been exceptionally kind to us inasmuch as they have promised to give us programs on Friday morning, January 11 and Saturday morning, January 12 from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M. E.S.T.

XEU, 1010 kycs. Veracruz, Ver. will take part in this Mexican DX Party on Saturday morning, January 12 from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. We know that station XEU is needed by many of our members and hence we are sure that most of you will be on hand to hear this program for our members from their station.

Durango, Dgo. promised us a program for the 12th from 3:00 to 4:00 A.H., E.S.T. but inasmuch as this is one of the stations operating on WEDC's wavelength, Mr. Roberts has kindly asked them to change the date to the 22nd from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M. EST at which time WEDC is not on the air.

Continuing with more news on our Mexican Nights. XEFJ 1210 kycs. Monterrey, N. L. have sent us a confirmation of a program for the members of our club on January 12 from 5:00 to 6:00 ... M., E.S.T. However on account of our not being able to clear their frequency on the 12th Mr. Roberts has asked them to change the date to Tuesday morning, January 15 from 5:00 to 6:00 A.M., E.S.T.

On Sunday morning, January 13, in addition to those which we have already told you about we find that the powerful XEPN 590 kycs. Piedras Negras, Goah, will be the first of the Mexicans on the air for our club on that morning between the hours of 1:30 and 2:30 A.M., E.S.T.

Following XEPN we were to have a broadcast from XETH 1210 kycs. Puebla, Pbla. from 2:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. but owing to the fact that 1210 kycs. will not be clear at that time Mr. Roberts has written the station asking them to come on for us on Tuesday morning, January 15 from 2:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T.

After the program which was to have taken place over XETH we were to have a program from XEFV also on 1210 kycs. located in Juarex, Chih. from 3:00 to 5:00 A.M., E.S.T. However again it was necessary for us to ask them to change the date to Tuesday morning, January 15 from 3:00 to 5:00 A.M., E.S.T.

On the same morning we are to have a broadcast for the members of our club from XEMO 865 kycs. Tiajuana, B. C. from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. From what we understand there may be some very valuable prizes offered during this program so we would especially urge you to listen to this broadcast for the members of our club.

As stated before we do not have any replies to our requests that the dates of those stations operating on 1210 kycs. who have promised us a DX progr am at a time that their frequency could not be cleaned, be changed to such a time that the channel could be cleared, therefore let us urge you to keep this list with both times and dates mentioned, for it is altogether possible that we may not hear from them in time to notify you if there were any changes in dates as per our requests. We can only suggest you watch both dates very closely for we are sure that you will hear these fine programs on one of the two mentioned dates.

There have been numerous inquires about a station which many of the members heard operating on 810 kycs or thereabouts last week several mornings between the hours of 2:00 and 5:00 A.M., E.S.T. Can any of our members identify this station. To us here at headquarters it sounded as though it might have been a Mexican station but we too were unable to identify them.

XEFZ 1370 kycs. Mexico City has been heard operating between the hours of 1 and 3 A.M., E.S.T. several times during the past two weeks. We thought maybe some of you heard this station and were unable to identify them.

We have just received a verif here at headquarters from CFQC Saskatoon, Sask which we feel we should call to your attention: - "We also appreciate the courtesy of your enclosure of return postage. Many DXers apparently imagine this matter of return postage unnecessary. A lamentable mistake!"Hence you can see the attitude the stations have on this.
