This time Harold Wagner, Arthur Robb and Nick Evangelista comes forward to say that they positively identified it as XEL (Editor Note: From Art Robbs report dated Nov.13 at 6.0 Ann CST he heard a announcement in English and now from the other end of the country comes a report on the same Date from Nick Evangelista comes a report almost the same hour with the same announcement-location is Mexico City P.O.Box 9975, listeners were invited to write in and tell how they like the program.) Harold says he heard several announcements and requests for reports. Since XEC have verified reports on the same frequency. it remains evident that there are two stations on this frequency. What shall we do about XECL is another problem but it is also possible that there may be three Mexicans on that disputed channel. Let's consider it too tough a problem and give it up as a bad job.

The FCC have decided that we DXers need a few more stations to log, hence a new station will soon be blasting forth 100 watt from Wallace Idaho. The new station will operate on 1420 kcs., and will use the customary 250 watts day power. Owners are Chester Howarth and Clarence Perger, the latter being affiliated with KGCI.

WCLS, Joliet Ill have changed owners. With the new arrangement comes news that they will install a new transmitter and a new site, and add a vertical antenna.

Amarillo Texas gets a new station to be operated on 1500 kcs.with 100 watts. The new enterprise is headed by C.S.Gooch, J.Linger Nunn, and Gilmore N.Nunn. How many NRCers remember J.LNunn when he was the owner of old WDAG. Incidentally WDAG was sold for the lowly sum of \$50.

A daytime station for Vancouver, Washington has received official approval so the Vancouver Radio Corp, will erect a station in that city to operate on 880 kcs with 250 watts days only.

Power jump for WHP, Harrisburg Pa and WBEO Marquette Mich arc forth-coming. WHP will increase to 1 kw night and 5 kw days while WBEO will install new equipment and increase day power to 250 watts.

WTRY, Troy New York will not go on the air January 1 1939 as planned. Protests from WOKO WABY and WCSH have resulted in a rehearing of the original petition in which the FCC granted Col. Harry Wilder's Troy Broadcasting Company a license to build WTRY for operation on 950 kcs with 100 watts day only. It is expected that the rehearing will be only a formality and that WTRY will be on the air by March 1 1939.

Prairie Farmer Station WLS are now using their own transmitter. They had been sharing with WENR with whom they share time. The new xmtr is located to the southwest of Chicago and is a single tower affair. It is expected to enhance their coverage of Metroplitan Chicago. Several NRCI-ers have reported hearing tests of the new unit.

DX RELEASE--WTAR RADIO CORP.

WTAR always is happy to receive reports of reception and glad to issue verifications when proper proof is received. By "Proper Proof" we mean complying with our set policy which requires the listing of at least three programs, announcements or selections broadcasted over the station at the identified times as shown by our station log, two of which must be local presentations. These need not be in successive order , but we have determined this definite procedure to protect the legitmate DXers, who spend hours listening, from the "collector" who scan the program listings in a radio magazine, write a portion of them down as a report, perhaps adding a ficticious "5-R9", and mail them to the station for verification. We feel that in employing this method without variation, that although we refuse perhaps 30 % of the requests for veries, at the same time we render the hobby a service by making certain that when a WTAR verification is issued, the person to whom it is addressed has heard the station as reported. Return postage of 3ϕ is requested (or 10ϕ for an Ekko stamp if desired) and verifications usually are issued the same day they are received.
