Speaking of WEDC, they do have permission to operate mornings, they obtained this not long ago, they allso use 250 watts now, as do WJBK, so its just too bad for DXers, they will block these channels for weak signals all winter. Thursday, Oct.19th something was going on down in Argentina, had a special program on at 4:00 A.M. and heard it untill daylight faded them out, all talk, and in spanish, with frequent mention of the larger cities of S.A. Among the stations had were LS2, Q5 R7. LT5, Q3 R5 on 1160 kc/s. ???? on 1020 kc.,Q2 R4 LR3, Q3 R4 on 950. LR2 on 910 Q3 R4. LR6 on 870 Q4 R6 and LT1 on 780 Most of these stations calls were heard.
