Financial Statement of the National Radio Club will be publish for all the members this year:- At the closing of the 1939 season inventory shows this stock left on hand, 8,000 sheets of mimeograph bulletin paper, 450 membership cards, 1000 large envelopes for mailing bulletin 3800 small stickers, one mimeograph machine, two pounds of mimeograph ink, 26 stencils, 600 application blanks, outstanding bills \$44.16, fees owed to the club \$58.00. Also a few miscellaneous supplies that belongs to the club. Cash on hand \$20.00 held in reserve for the S & E contest. Also a small balance of cash on hand for supplies that are on order by the members. There has been rumor's that a DX club cannot be placed on a paying scale, well I believe the facts above prove this can be done 'thats'if each and every member does their part in paying his or her dues when they expire. Doing the past year from January 1939 to January 1940 the National Radio Club has only lost 9 members, in which all 9 have quit DXing. And we have a grand total of 44 new members to our credit. A gain of 35 members this year, not quite up to that of last years grand total of 76 members for that year, with a loss of 15 old members. We believe this years increase was small do to the reason that conditions have not been so good, as many Diers have written into the NRC asking about the club, but have mention the fact as soon as they are back to work they will join. Lets hope that all you members will make a New Years Resolution and help the Club to go forward in 1940. Remember its your club and its up to you to keep it go-

Dont forget that WTAM-Date on January 14th. Heres some information on that 'Mid Winter Gathering' The special program on January 14th, from 1:00 to 2:30 A.M. EST will take place from the Alpine Village Restaurant located at Playhouse Square on Euclid Ave. in Cleveland. Members coming in early on the afternoon of January 13th should come to WTAM studios at 9th and Superior Ave. and they will be shown around the building. A special studio will be set aside for DX'ers on this day.

There will be one large "DX table", reserved for 50 DX ers if the weather is poor, and 75 if the weather conditions is good.
