--PREPARING FOR BROADCAST RELOCATIONS--

The Federal Communications Commission is considering the tentative reallocation of broadcast bands in the U.S.A. to conform to the provisions of the N.A. Regional Broadcast Agreement, now ratified by Canada, Cuba Haiti and Mexico as well as bythms country.

The treaty provides one year in which to make the prescribed changes in station assignments. By agreement, this time may be reduced. However it does not appear possible to effect such changes within the three-month period suggested by the Mexican Association of Broadcasters. The exact time when allocations will become effective will be determined by the Commission survey now under way, and to meet the convenience of all the North American countries involved so far as may be possible.

Until such time as the work is completed, the Commission cannot

undertake to consider applications of changes in individual cases under the reallocation. The Commission will give due notice to all licensees when the general plan is determined.
