Announcements are all in French and are frequently made by a woman. Identification is the striking of a chime followed by the announcement "Ici Radio Alger" (Mann)

BELGIAN CONGO OPM 10.140 & OQ2AA 15.175 Leopoldsville are well hrd daily from 2-2:45PM. All programs are in French and news at 2:15PM. Interval signal is 4 chimes and identifying announcement is "Ici Radio Cono Belge de Leopoldsville, Capital de Congo Belge. OPL 20.040 which operates 6-7:15 RM daily is not heard here. (Mann)

EGYPT SUX 7.865 using 10KW at Abu Zabal still transmits news to NBC in New York frequently in the early evenings. Usually on Sundays between 7-7:12 PM. (Mann)

FRENCH MOROCCO CNR 12.830 & CNR2 11.940 Radio Maroc uses 25Kw and located at Rabat operate daily in the afternoons on an irregular sked. CNR is much louder than CNR2. Interval sig is a note chime followed by the announcement Ici Radio Maroc. All programs are in French and Arabic. They verify with a card showing the xmiter towers. (Mann)

FRENCH EQUATORIAL AFRICA FZI 11.970-5Kw Radio Brazzaville at Brazzaville is hrd daily 3:30-4:15 PM and later. Sig is good but badly heterodyned Identifying announcements Ici Radio Brazzaville is given often. Programs are all in French with news at 3:40 PM. (Mann)
