Steve tells us the program was the best he has ever heard and that they broadcast a special message at the conclusion advising him the intent to present such a program EVERY Sat FOR THE NRC FROM 3-4AM EST. We are most grateful for this favor and urge all members to drop this station a card at once thanking them and telling them you will listen and report future programs. YVARA Valencia, Venezuela will honor our club on the morning of Oct 8th from 3-4 AM EST. This station operates on 1350 kc with 330 watts. REPRINT OF THE RULES FOR THE SHORT WAVE CONTEST OF THE NATIONAL RADIO

1. The contest will be for reception of SW stations during the year 1941 ONLY. That is from January 1 1941 to and inc December 31 1941

2 Only verifications will count in this contest.

3 Pointage will be rigured on the basis of the number of countries verified times the number of verifications. For example, If one has 16 veries from 10 different countries, his pointage 1s 160 points.

A Veries need not be submitted for inspection unless called for by the

contest manager if there is any doubt.
5 Participants in the contest will be allowed until June 1 1942 to get their veries in and final results will be announced in the July 1942 bulletin. By June 1 1942 it means veries postmarked till then not after.

- 6 Prizes (to be announced later) will be awarded at the annual NRC convention in Buffalo, N.Y. Labor Day week end 1942. Winners not present will receive their prizes by mail at that time.
- 7 The contest is open to any NRC member and there is no entrance fee. 3 The contest judges shall be Fred Van Voorhees-Leo Herz & J.Siringer.
- Their decision shall be final. (Note the change in Judges, this was due to Larry Lundberg dropping from the DX hobby and Fred Van Voorhees taking over the editorship of the SW column.

RULES OF THE NATIONAL PADIO CLUB

- 1 Headquarters of the National radio Club is Buffalo, N.Y. and shall not be changed except by a vote of at least 2/3 of the Board Members. The office of Sec & Tres shall be held by one person who lives within a reasonable distance of Buffalo. Editor or Sec & Tres does not have to be a Board Member and shall be appointed each year by the Board. The Sec and Tres shall every 3 months sent to the Chiarman a complete financial report of the club, he in turn shall send a condensed report to the other Board Members and the President.
- 2 The annual election for President and Directors shall be held in July. Terms of office shall be from Sept to Sept. Voting cards will be sent with the July issue of the DX News. The 10 highest will then vote for President & Board Chairman. The following officers will be appointed at the Annual Convention by the Board if a majority attends, if not then by mail. 3 V.Fresidents, 1st & 2nd must be Board Members, 3rd may be from the membership at large, a Vice Chiarman. If at any given location a goodly number of NRC members reside and no Official is among them, one of their number shall be appointed NRC representative and shall officiate in that manner. No Chairman is eligible to succeed himself. In order to be eligible for President or Board Member he has to be in his Second Consecutive year as an NRC member with his dues paid.
- 3 All Board Members including the Chairman are entitled to vote on all matters. The President will vote only in case of a tie. Any member has the right to submit questions to the Board for a vote, if he submits the same to the Chairman. In case of a vacancy the next highest on the list of Directors will be appointed at once.
- 4 Should any Member include in his DX report to HQ any item which the Editor believes would not be for the best interest to the Club if published, has the right to eliminate such item but must write the Member stating his reasons. If the Member is not staisfied with Editors reasons he may appeal to the Board of Directors whose decision is final.
- 5 The Board of Directors have the power to change any Rule or add new ones by a simple majority EXCEPT Rule 1. No vote shall be final until all Board Members have had an opportunity to cast their vote. All Contests must be approved by the Board of Directors.
- 6 All correspondence received by any Cificer-Director or Member of the NRC with the heading OFFICIAL BUSINESS or BOARD REMEASES must be held strictly confidential. Any infraction of this Rule will cause the Board to act
- 7 The Editor has the right to appoint any associate Editor he sees fit and who would benifit the National Radio Club.
- 8 The Board of Directors ONLY has the power to expell members or remove OFFICERS. This must be done in a fair manner and a copy of the complaint must be sent to the effected person by the Board Chairman
- 9 Officers-Directors and MEMBERS pledge themselves to uphold all Rules.
- 10 The Editor & CPC Chairman shall work hand in hand and the Board shall no interfere unless they feel the CPC is not being managed business like.
- Dues of the National Radio Club is \$2.00 per year and shall be sent to the Club HC. All Officers as well as Members are required to pay dues. When either Officer or Member fails to renew his membership or Resigns from the Club he shall be dropped from the membership list and the Official Club Bulletin "DX NEWS" will not be sent to him. In case of an Officer he will also be removed from Office. When a Member sends in only \$1.00 he will receive 15 consecutive issues of the DX NEWS and if the other \$1. is sent before he receives the 15th issue he will receive the remaining 19 issues making the full year. Membership to the NRC includes 34 issues of the Official Club Bulletin known as "DX NEWS". There will be no donorary Memberships.
