So as to further interest in foreign BCB Daing, the Cleveland Radio Club is sponsoring a contest for NRC members, in which only verifications from countries other than USA-Canada-Cuba-Mexico-Pureto Rico and Hawaii will be acceptable. There are to be two divisions, individual and team. In this contest all prizes will be consted by the Cleveland Radio Club.

The entire CRC will serve as "Board of Judges" of this contest and reports of verifications received should be sent to Jack Siringer, 1451 Lincoln Ave., Lakewood, Ohio. The aforementioned board has the privilege

of calling in veries in case of doubt.
Points will be awarded as follows; For each North American verie other than Central America 1 point; For Central America-2 points; South America

3 points; Oceania & Europe-4 points; Africa & Asla-5 points.

The teams will be comprised of 4 men each, such as a Cleveland team-Chicago-Milwaukee-Buffalo etc. In cases where there are but one or two members living in a certain town or city, he or they may band with other members in neighboring towns, so as to form a 4 man team, For example Pat Reilley-Dick Cooper and a couple others could get to gether to form a team etc. It might be added that although more than one team member might possess the same foreign veri, the veri will count but once in team pointage.

Other rules are--Prepared or raply cards are acceptable--The contest will run from Oct 1 1941 until April 30 1942 inclusive. All stations entered in the contest will have to be heard within this period. So as to allow time for receipt of veries, entrants have until June 30 1942 (Postmark) in which to get lists of veries received to the contest editor. No entries in this contest will be accepted after December 31 1941.
