## THE CPC CORNER

WMIS-NATCHEZ MISS will honor the NHC by dedicating the first DX program from that station to our club on the morning of Dec 7th from 5:15-6:15 AM. Please note this time. WWSW signs off at 6 AM on Sunday mornings and we are trying to get WJBK to give us the last fifteen minutes also. If this program is 4RMed during the first 45 minutes be sure to try during the last 15 minutes. P.K. Ewing is General Manager of WMIS. (E Cooper)

WWSR-ST ALBANS VERMONT will dedicate their Dec 8th frequency check program to the NRC and will read a script prepared by the Flatbush Flash, Ernie Cooper. Ernie is taking a course in radio script writing and production and WWSR have agreed to let him write a script for this program.

WEIM-FITCHBURG MASS called your Editor long distance Thursday morning asking him to contact as many DXers as possible in order to secure as many listeners for their DX program to the NRC on Nov 24th. They are giving a couple watches to listeners, not just to distant reports but for other reports, the kind will be told during the program. They are to be on from 3:00-6:00 AM EST which is one (1) hour earlier than originally planned. They want to see just how they can be received through QRM. Any of you members or others who have any way in giving this program publicity please do it as it will be greatly appreciated by station WEIM. This last spring station KCRC asked a similar request and they received 207 reports. Lets see if we can get WEIM a greater number.

I am sure a great number of DXers could use this station to fatten their loggs, so as the NNRC says lets show our appreciation by reporting to this program as it is the only way we can show our appreciation. This program will also be broadcast on 9715 kcs so come on you Short Wave listeners. As you all know a stations pay for DX programs is reports. No reports then no Programs.

HAROLD CRISWELL-LEWISBERRY PA I'm still around yet, haven't DXed much as I am working all night, 10 & 12 hrs and 5 & 6 nights a week. Meet with an accident a couple weeks ago, fortunately my left one. It is getting along OK. Am DXing now as I have lots of time. Got my hand badly cut. Reception has been terrible here. Veries rec this summer and fall are WKWK-WPAT-WCOP-WOCB-WWDC-KDTH-WABC-WJZM-WCED-WLAG. Reported all the Club specials I could. Didnt wake up in time for WGAA-couldnt hear KEVR and KGBS. Some of the stations gave us a fine send off. KHMO on check 11/5 for a new one, WWNY also a new one. WRRN testing the 7th, WJMA hasn't verified yet. I've missed plenty of the new ones, hope reception gets better soon. When I work 10 hrs and quit at 4:30 the 5 to 6 specials were made to order for me. Some of the NNRC specials were good, didn't hear CKUA-CHLN-CKCW-CHRC-CJCJ or CFRC. Heard CJIC-CKRN-CKNB-CKNX-CKCO on 1310 kcs very good. Glad to have a report Harold but am sorry it has to be an accident to you, Lets hear from you often.

MEL OLIVER-HOUSTON TEXAS Only veries rec this week are WABC-KCSJ-WAVE-WJZM-KHMO, will pick up as I have sent 10 reports in last 2 days. 11/6 Static severe, 3:05 WCBI testing; WLBJ-WGOV-WJZM-KLUF-WRBL on frequency checks. 11/11 Hrd the following freq cks KELD-WCMI-KXYZ-WTA4-KGKL-WCOV-KRGV-KTOK-KGFF-KFVS-KOCY-KICA-KBTM in order hrd. Also KAVE on monthly DX program from 5 AM. 11/12 CBH s/o 3 AM; KLO & WHIS with fine DX programs from 304, for no clubs in particular; WBOW-WGIL-WCLO freq checks. Didnt catch any Canadian programs for NNRC, just couldnt hear them.

NORM MAGUIRE-ALBULUERQUE N M DX has been pretty good here lately. Have had a little more time to do some DXing. However, very few veries have petered in. Those include KTSA-KRLD & KSOO. New stations had here were-KRNT-KGNO-WLB-KGKO-KMMJ-WTAX-WJZ-KFJI-WHBQ-KMLB-WLS-KGU-WWNY-KPFA-KWLC-WSLI-KINY-KFDA and KCMB. All these stations have been reported. However KGMB-KMLB & WSLI have been reported before with no siccess. Also hrd. but not reported, LYA-KHBC-KGBU; KGBU & KINY are my first Alaskan stations They came thru on this mornings FCC test programs. Only KINY was hrd well enough to report. TP reception has not been up to par the Last 2 weeks. That is for the few mornings that I have been up. May have been some that I missed. The only news here is that our local KOB has changed freq and is now on 770 kcs. As far as reception around this locality the change is not too good for reception qualities. However don't know how this change may effect KOB\*s signals to the East. They now have WJZ to compete rather than WBZ. KOB's sign off time is rather early, being 11 PM MST or 1:00 Am EST, so that many eastern listeners will not be able to pull the 50 kw station thru. The mystery station on 1153 kcs has been heard to announce as XEJP Mexico City. They announce the frequencies as 1150 but do not operate on that one. They seem to be on every morning and sign off at 4 AM. 10/29 logged 44N & 44S. TP's fairly good that morning. 11/8 LR1 R9 plus at 6:45 PM. At the same time YV5RQ-882 kcs was also R9 plus. OAX4A-854 kcs heard weakly. At sign off 11:30 PM TIPG 30DB above R9. HJAN good that evening and also in morning, being on until past 3:30. SW relay on; CMCK hrd well every morning. Also relayed on 3.7 mog. I finally received my H4 120 after a 2 months wait.

Just waiting to get 110 DC currant as soon as I can get around to hitching up the Kohler motor. Even then I will have only a 5 tube set for DX and I imagine that wont amount to much. Wish I had something to use for DX. I think there is more than 2500 ft of solid cpooer wire to use for sky wires (dont tell Uncle Sam he might think I am hoarding it) so am going to see what a little wire and a little radio will do. Wish I knew Dave Thomas's antenna ideas. (Well Dave if you see this, Joe's address is Celo Community, Celo North Carolina) Well Joe you should do OK even with a small set as Jim Walker did OK with one-Ray

(Dage how did the election come out-sorry I couldnt send a few votes down to you) SPECIAL TIP within 2 weeks KEH will change from 1250 to 1420 kcs and use power of 1000 watts. Both English and Spanish will be used. Sked is daily 5:15 AM to 10 PM. On Sundays it is 5:30 AM till noon. REPORTS DESIRED on 1420. P.O. Box 147, Monterrey. Verie just received with this dope. (They also verified for your editor in 8 days) 11/11 CKUA & CHLN not hrd; CFGP questionable; CKNB fair and CJIC good; CKRN & CHLN fine with NNRC DX programs. Notice that last yrs FCC list still runs very close to form in 1941; 11/12 Station hrd behind WOL all morning, maybe CFRN or is it one in Mexico. If so Who? No sign of CHRC-CJCJ or CFRC on NNRC DX. CKNX & CKCO on 1310 very good. WHIS on 3-4 with DX program; KLO-3-3:45 request DX program. Latest veries here, KGMB just out 21 days-exchange of post cards, thats service, XEH-KSKY-WGAA-WLAG and YV4RA. FCC tests again this AM was true to form but WSLS on 1490 kcs at 3 AM, rest the same. (Dave WSLS was on at 2:50 that AM-3:05)

Veries in from YV4RA a swell definite verie card; KAVE sent me nice letter head verie of their new call. KRKO came back with nice letter verie stating they were using loo watts or less on test I caught. Also veries from WWDC-KDTH-WLAG-WJZM WGTC and WWSR.

Hrd CFOS well, HJAN over WOWO-WPRA on test; WNEL R9 on reg program; TFJ Iceland last week, also CR7BE-OPM-HH3W-TIEP and HJCB on 1105kc Latest veries are KFAB-XELO-CBR-KGMB cards and letters from WPRO my 1st from R.I.-KFUO-with stamp-KGGF-KMMJ-WLAG and literature and cards from PSH; nice card OAlA. Have reports out to all over and why dont WJMA & XEG answer? I sent my report to Monterrey over a month ago. XEMO also does not answer and CJRC sure should have by now. I agree with Carroll's poem. By the way Radex has a fb mag now hasnt it? I now have a VIC of 24 with all continents and have hrd 66 countries most of them on 2 tubes. I have had this Sky Chief only 2 months. HOWARD KEMP-WATERBURY CONN WAYS-610 kc Charlotte N.C. opening held up until Dec 1 1941 because of antenna accident, keep looking. KVOS Bell-ingham Wash has changed from 1230 to 790 kcs and from 250 w to 1 kw full time. CKUA Edmonton Alta now on with 1kw on 580; KJR & KOMO s/o 9AM EST.

LEN KRUSE-DUBUQUE IOWA The past several weeks DXing was only fair but but now old man winter is close by so reception promises to be quite favorable for yours truly. This is by the way my first report to the NRC and I hope to be a weekly reporter in these DX NEWS columns. Starting the DX hobby in February 1941 I have 561 stations logged on the BCB while I have 307 verified. On 10/22 hrd KWBW several hours in early AM broadcasting flood bulletins as their town was partially flooded. New stations logged 11/6 WJBY-WTMA-WCBI-WORD; 11/7 KWAT-WBOC & WRRN testing from 3:15 AM to 4:15 AM for equiptment purposes. Among other new stations logged on 11/8 KOBH-WHLN-WGNC-WTOL-WKBZ-WBRW-WOLS-WJW-KSAM-WLAK-KBIX-WOMT-WHBU-WTAL-WMSD. Of the half dozen Canadian stations on the air on 11/11 dedicated to the NNRC I logged only one that being CJIC; It seems that these programs conflicted quite a bit with the regular FCC checks and thus is the excuse I will give for not logging more. Received verie from PSH by registered mail, card and books on Brazil, took 7 months to reply to my report but well worth waiting for.

TED NEIDER-SEA CLIFF N Y Since becoming a member of the NRC I hope to let the other members know I'm alive and have been burning the midnight oil during the past few weeks.
