Bob Brown-Stations cannot be substituted.

ALL CONTESTANTS-Puerto Rico-Hawaii and Alaska count 1 point for each station. They are territories of the US and are governed by the same rules and regulations as the US stations and are licensed by the FCC. States count 1 point for each station verified and N R C specials do not count 3 points. The rules state that 2 stations may be verified in each state PLUS all N R C specials. That means you can verify 2 stations in each state and all the NRC specials that originate from any state but when verifying an NRC special you cant count it as 2 points for the special and then another point for one of the 2 stations for that state unless you reverify that station a different time.
