Please note on front page a special program broadcast by station PRF3 on January 8 1942. The complete dope is that they will broadcast for the NNRC on 11765 kcs from 11:30-12 Mdt Jan 8th and then continue on from 12 Mdt to either 12:30 or 1:00 AM Jan 9th for the IDA on 6095 kcs.

Also on our special program from YV6RC on 3450 kcs on January 13 1942 This will also be transmitted on 1080 kcs for our BCB members. Please listen in and if heard send a report to both YV6RC and PRE3. REMEMBER Fred's new address-3445 Stettinius, Ave., Cincinnati Ohio. The following are the frequencies for the BBC broadcasts for the United States listeners for the coming week, from 4:15 to 11:45 PM EST. GSL on 6.110 kcs and GSC on 9.580 kcs.

Your editor at HQ tried listening to SW last week but as usual he cant get interested, seems all announcements are in some language that he doesnt know anything about and then there are others who never seem to do any announcing. He did however think he had South Africa at 2:15 AM broadcasting sitting up exercises but it turned out to be an English broadcast from London. Listened to a station on about 12,000 kcs one noon from about 12:15 PM to 1:30 PM but could never catch an announcement. Dont know whether they announced in a foreign language or if they just didnt announce. If I recall correctly I heard an XE mentioned on several occasions but that is all I could make of it. They seemed to be to men announcers, changing off about every 10 minutes or so.
