Some of my catches on Sw are VUD-2 ZRH-MTCY and VLR-CXALO-TGWA-OAXAC and more S As. I dont see how some fellows get London on BCB. Ivor Sutherland and I have been wondering about something? It is - are the reports still getting through to foreign countries? (Yes Don some are and some are not, it seems just depending on the censor who opens your report. It seems that reports to Canada and Mexico are going thru and coming back OK, but to the other countries they get thru now and then and many times they are returned.) GENE FRANCIS-DETRIOT MICH For the past year I had supposed that the only new stations I would be able to add to my log would be those that put on specials or conducted tests. And with 27 new stations logged in January, I didn't expect more than a dozen at the most in February. I underxxxxx estimated my location and my receiver. I can easily add to my list of top radio-thrills the morning of February 4th when my first SA, HJCU came pounding in, only to be followed 4 hours later by my first Zedder, 1YA. Both were naturally reported and since neither report was returned by the censor, I suppose they got through. Maybe the fun will begin when the veries try to pass the censors into the States. Except WMUR and WJAG (which I thought I had, but was mistaken) the only "W's" left are on the grave-yend channels. Here's what I got in February. WSAP-WRRF-WGBG-WAYS-WHB-WSBA-WSON-WMAM-KFBC-KFE4-KFSG-KGDE-KLBM (E Griebel's station, heard when he heard it)-KMTR-KPOW-KSJB-KSOO-KTFI (heard for 3 minutes each morning after WHBF signs off at 1:00AM)-KTSA-KTTS-KWAL-KWAT-KWKW-KYUM. And in Canada and other nations; CF&C-CHAB-CJKL-CJOR-CJVI-CKCK-CMJK-CMKU-XEU-XEJP-XEON-XETU-XEHL-XEMX-XEGM-XELZ-HJCC-London National and Lyons National on 648. Whispering on 680 one exceptionally good Monday around 5AM. Reports have bone out to KFJX on Lefty's tip, WGIL-WLOF-WFNC-WCED-WWSR-CKMO-CFJC. Hrd a station behind KLX playing Brazil, no announcements were heard. As I have a few other tunes I sent to CJFC. All I do now is nope. To LEFTY COOPER-Report to XEOY was sent to XEOY-Mexico City. Address on verie is Paseo de la Reforma-60-Mexico City. In case you care to phone 18-14-40-Y. Thx for tip on KFXJ, have been looking for them Tomorrow I will be trying for CKRN-CHAD-CKVD, conditions look favorable here so far. 2/24 I had a station leaving the air in English, said he'd return at 8Am and then signed with S S Banner. Veries are in from KXEL-CKY-WAKR-WASK-KROS-KFUN-CKHN-WLOG-WMBR-KOAC-WJW-WALL-WJLB-WJWC-WISH-WSRR-WLOF-WKWK-WAIT-KWON-KICD-WATW-KEVE-WISE-KARM-WTAQ-WFCI-WIBC-WCED-WSLB-WTCM-WSAP-WHLN-WMGA-WKMO-WARF-WKBB-WOSH-WBIR-WDAK-KWFC-WORD-WSKB-WCBI-KFFA-KWTh. That was a honey of a location, several of the Australian stations were almost daily visitors via my radio there. In fact I used to get 2YA even in the Summer time. In 1934 I moved back to Detroit and practically gave up DXing as I was working long hours in a Tool & Die shop. I have been in Moline since Sept 1939, working at the Rock Island Arsenal. I statted Dring again this last fall and its surprising how many stations I need of the ones on the air now. Back in 1934 I had nearly all of the US stations verified needing I believe only 24 to complete the job. Now it is almost like starting over. I am verifying a lot of the stations over from here though that I had verified back In Michigan. I guess my biggest thrill came when Milt Christa and I journeyed over to CKLW in Windsor, Ontario to take part in the DX program put on by the Mutual Network for the Newark News Radio Club. I had a swell time there but when I was introduced over the air I got a nice case of Mike Fright. After a few words though that disappeared and I got along all right. I'll never forget the workout the engineer got that morning. He showed us arounf the studios and transmitter and it seemed every time we got quite a ways from the control room, mutual would pause for station identification. He would then dash for the control 100m, usually thru two or three coors. For a while after that every time I heard a door slam I thought of that engineer dashing for the control. 100m and all out of breath trying to say CKLW in Wingsor. When I arrived home my wife wanted to know what we did to the announcer to keep him out of breath all morning.

FRIC BRISTOW-CHICAGO ILL I heard 3 new ones last night, KGO-KLX-KTRH. I also had CKRN only although I tried all frequencies. I have the follow-ing in KGHF-WLOF-WGNC-WOL-WBTM-WRRF- I still have these out and am looking for the veries-KGCX-XEAW-KWKW-KSWO-KICD-XELO_KPAC-WGIL_WTAM-WEBR-KBIZ

WHLM-KRCS-WFNC-CHRC-VBTH-WHKY-WHFR-WIZE-WWDC-WKBW-XEG. On 610 kes I hrd a station s-on at about 1:08 AM EWT giving a talk about Liberty-Freedom and about working in defense plants etc to ald the boys in service and ended with the S S Banner. (By the way Eric send in all your veries that you want entered in the contest and keep the regular ones seperate from the Specials. If you count them twice list them so and specify which are regular and which kkm are the specials .- Ray) (WCED dont count) FRED VAN VOORHEES-KANSAS CITY MO. No DX report so guess I will relate a little of my past DX. Finally got Arizona after about 7 years. Still need Nevada though. KTAR came thru after 2 follow ups. Speaking of thrills, I guess I have had quite a few also. Like first verie WCAP Jan 6 1936, lst 100 watter on Pacific Coast KXO; 1st TA heard Rennes and 1st TA verie also kennes, finally xxx heard all states, Idaho (Kido) being the last one to be heard. Hearing and verifying KHBC in Hilo. 1st time I had a song decicated to me was by Enrique Hidalso at CaHJ in Cienfuegos, also my 1st Cuban verie.
