Would like to know if Ted Saling or Larry Yearns could give me any help
on these 2 stations, one on 1290 kc or 1300 and same program on 1450 kcs.

This was hrd at 3 AM ENT with religious programs (mentioned some network)
signed off at 12:15 AM PWT with selection "America The Beautiful". This
was heard MON Nov 13 at 3 AM ENT. ZNS hrd for 1st time on 640 kcs signing
off at 10 PM on 11/12. Will try for KXO and KVNU on their DXes.

*RALPH JOHANNS-BUFFALO NY Just a little more dope. WGAR hrd on 1220 kcs and KFAB now on 1110, they gave a single test signal at 4:17-KFAB testing and again at 5:01, and went on the air at 6:01. WCOL was on till 3:30AM drowning KXO, then at 3:30 WMFR came in with a test and signed off 4:10. WISE just about faintly hrd, could not get a report. Will send KXO Tnx Card.
