KPOF DX not heard, all I could get was a veritable blitt of static, so sent tnx card. 12/19 KBWD well heard for a good report. 12/20 WPRA testing 3:10-3.30 AM Q4 4-9; WPAB on from 3:30-3:43 with some fading; 12/22 KUOA for DX hrd well but inclined to fade a bit and KPOF not heard at all. 12/24 WAWZ on club DX well hrd with much enjoyable music, also CKOC rather CKCO on 1310 kc covering all statioms 7:03-8RM. WSAN from 6:50-7 PM on top for a spell. CKWS from 2-2:30 PM for a good daytime report; 12/25 WHIT testing, logged 5:08-5:25 and patially covering WWDC, newest 24 hour station. Hope no one starts on 1240 kcs again, what became of WEDC? WMBH not heard at all, so sent tnx card. Yes I was up and listening.

Bursts of static prevented necognition. CMX hrd on 1000 at 4AM. CMJL on 920 after 4; Cubin networks were on till I went to bed at 4:30. I'm a little chary of Cubans in reporting not too many ever reply. There were unknown Spicks on 820 and 1120 kcs; Frenchie on 1240 persumably CHLT; XECR also had on 1030. Only one I am interested in is one on 650 kcs from 3-3:30 AM. For the rest of my DXing this season. First of all I received a very nice Chritamas present in the form of a long delinquent verie from KPAS, was for report of last Jan, first time I ever reported them. Sent them reports also in March and a couple of them just recently and a follow up. KPAB was very welcome here as they completed the state of Calif for my 66th verie from there. On 12/18 Mexico City stations were all over the dial before 4 AM am not bothering with those Spicks the will get more US stations first before I concentrate on them. Believe these stations were on due to the beginning of fiesta time for the Xmas Holidays-it seems it always begins a week shead down there. Well I guess I might as well quit DX. GRANT BATSON tells me KAVE was on their test and then to make things worse DAVE THOMAS says KOVO was on their test also, so fellas I bow deeply in humble submission-hi. CFkB covered XEL very well here with R-6 signals, nice show with dedications to Officers KJBS hrd R-7 after 2AM on 12/15. I'd like to wish every member of the NRC and especially those fellas in the Armed Forces (Who I'll join in 5 or 6 months) a belated MERRY XMAS and the BEST and HAPPIEST NEW YEARS. JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. Stormy weather of past week had its effects on DX, weaker signals generally, and a sleepy DXer because of too much snow shoveling and valking part way to work. KTRB and WKNE very well

heard here, WKNE perfect C-5, hard to understand why he could not break thru QRM before with a signal like that. Interesting programs, both of em. Glad to hear Phil at the mike too. Set alarm for 3:30 on CFBH and shut it off without waking up, missing this DX as well as the WELO and WRLD checks which I wanted to hear. Found my DX pretty spotty on 12/18 when trying for KOVO, could just tell that someone was on 1240 then, faint traces of carrier and that was all, and KYUM and KGLU had been coming in good with the religious program at 3. Mexico also coming in well with several of the regulars on, also a few not had here before. One on 1420 am sure was XECJ, hrd call twice and it sounded just like that, also heard Morelos mentioned several times. Another on 1430, not sure of him, call had an N or M in it. Nothing new in veries except a nice card from KWBU.

BOB GORSUCH-THREE RIVERS, wICH This morning was one of the queerest for reception that I have experienced for some time. After 2AM EWT about all. I could hear here were Mexican stations. Eastern stations like WJZ-WIP and WOR were very weak signals as bad as R-3. West coast stations like KNX-KFI and the lower powered stations were R-2 to not showing at all. Mexican stations were very storng and the following were identified, 660-XEBZ, 860-XEMO, 940-XEDP; 1030-XECR; 1150-XEJP; 1290-XEDA; 1380-XEMX; 1440-XELZ; 1470-XESM; 1500-XERH; 1550-XEML and 1590-XEMC. All of these were R-7 to 9. Besides these which were identified, Mexicans were also heard on 790-590-970-1070-1090-1270 and 1410 kcs. Since all of those identified were Mexico City, except XEMO a good guess could be made on those not identified. All could have been copied for verification since about every two or three numbers they threw in some American selection. XEDA and XEBZ were the only ones copied here and reports are going out · to these 2 today. 1230 kcs had a Cuban dominating the channel but outside of the announcement CMC? Havana failed to identify it positively. About half of these Mexicans mentioned above were on till 5AM and after EVIT. Practically all were on till 4AM EWI. WKNE and KVCV and KTRB were all heard very well here and reports sent. Thank you card sent to KGBS. Slept thru CFBR for first strike of the season. Felt very bad about this hope to get another shot at them again sometime. Since last report 2 weeks ago, rpts have gone out to KVCV-CKRC-CKBI-CFRN-KVOF-YKME-KVRC and KTRB. XEDA and XEBI streedy in mail. Veries received from VEBA-VMOH-KTKC-KPAS a beautiful letter head and WATN. So for this season 30 of 31 veries are letters on station letter need. The card from PTOP. The Mexican stations on 1430 and 1440 kcs have been checked the past 2 AMs and on both occasions the Spick on 1430 kc was Q-4 R-7 and announced XECZ. The spick on 1440 kc was Q-4 R-8 and announced as XELZ. This definite and not a guess. So many spanish stations on the dial this AM 12/25 that I cidnt know where to listen first, checked 1430 and 1440 kcs and went to bed. I havent heard XEFI on 1440 this winter as yet. Sent a report to XEMX on 1380 kcs on reception from 3-3:30 12/24. Have come to the conclusion that if you listen to a Mexican station long enough you'll hear "Star Dust". On the 6 Mexicans reported in past 2 weeks it has been in the report of 5.

Veries back from WMOH-WHIS-WPHA-KWBU-ZNS-KLPN. Anyone heard from WSLB-CJRL or CKRN?? Hope you all had a swell Christmas. I know I did. Dest of DX to you DXers in 1945.

On Xmas AM I found many Costa Ricans on the sir until 5AM. I copied TILS on 380 and a report will be in the nir mail tomorrow. Also got a nice report on HJBJ on 1140 kcs "La Voz de Santa Marta" danta Marta, Columbia. Besides these reports I have 5 others out in past week, namely HJCB on 1105; HJCZ on 1040; OAX4A on 854; YV5RL on 1160 and HJAT on 1275, With my YJS verie, the 3 BBC's on 668-1013 and 1149 kcs-TIEP and the 2 Hawaiians KGO-KGMB I believe that this DX season will show surprisingly good results even with a war on and strict censorship. I prize every verie as I only DX for those stations outside of the US-Canada-Cuba and Mexico. By the way the BBC on 1149 kcs has but one station, not 3 as snown in DXA. My verie shows it to be the "Home Service and Overseas Forces" station. The station must be at least 100, 600 wats in power.

C.E. SLICHTER-DEL PASO HGTS, CALIF For MCLEOD KFAh on 660 kcs rebroadce to Information Please and for KAUER kana is off from lOPM to lam for WTAM. It amuses me as to why some of the west coast boys get veries and some do not. Some of my enperiences are KTRB-KHAL-KHYC-KLOY-KTYW were all reported on first day of reg broadcast, also KPAS and have never got a verie in fact know owner for one, owner says C.E. attends to that dept. and C.E. told we he did not like DX fans, maybe a new C.E. now. Don't know Any way I don't listen to any of them, some satisfaction. WKLA interfered with WMOH but I got two new ones. KYCV & KThB Da perfect, only listened enough to know they were operating. WKNE total failure The new station in Modesto is a spite station. CKIN is on one night late monthly, never paid any attention which one, but will check. Your Editor's suggestion is that a list of the needed stations be compiled(NONH INCLUDED THAT CAN BE HEARD ON A CHECK) and also if you will guarantee to report to these stations if they are contacted and favor us with a DX Special. The reason I ask that you also guarantee to report is that we can judge the number of reports a certain station would receive. It must be remembered that it would hurt the DX game if one of these hard to hear stations came on with a Special for us and then received only 10 or 15 reports. So to you bob if this idea is OK with you, drop me a line outlining what system you wish the members to use when sending you their list.—Ray)

JOE LIFTINGOIT-CELO N.C. A great deal of interest having been shown in TA reception and I am willing to serve as NRC TA Elitor provided members will try to supply info that can be used. I suggest the following method, of reporting. (Listing by freq) FREQ-CALL or location, Sked if known with time heard underlined. The following is an example (Hypothetical example) 500 kc XYZ Bohank 1223----78 The above indicates that XYZ was heard between 2 & 3 but was on from 1:30 AM till 3 or later and was on at 7 and until 8 PM. Also I think it would be helpful to indicate the stations that are in the clear, ie without interference from domestic stations. For instance Wales on 804 cant be hrd here now due to QRM on adjacent frequencies. Anyone with a selective set can get it. In additions to the above listing which will be condensed report of times on the air in such a was as to be seen at a glance, there will be a summary below of such data as languages used. Verifications received and anything else of interest. It should be noted that I propose to include data on BCB and Long Wave in this list. Many of you are hearing BBC stations so here is data on them for a starter;

The following carry programs for Europe in many languages; 200-804-977-1050-1122-1149, Not always same program. The following carry Home Service program; 1474-767-668. The programs listed in Radio Times are always the same for these stations. (also on 6.18 meg) The following carry General Forces Programs; 1013-877 and S.W. It is possible to verify, yes VERIFY BBC stations if you want to go to the trouble to do so. If you are willing to become a monitor for the BBC and send regular reports on THEIR report forms and will give a number of reports on SW along with your beb reports; you can get verifications. It should be noted that the report forms to be used from day to day. Unless you are interested in verifying a station it is not necessary to give date as to type of program you hear. You need only give an entry of date-time-station call and report your signal strength-fading etc. There is a column for remarks which I use to give data to prove reception when I want a verie but otherwise I merely use it for noting strength of TRM etc. (CONYINGED ON PAGE 6)

TIPS and LFO KEFORTS _____December 30_1944 JUE LIPPINCOTT Cont Veries received this season include all freqs now active including one on 5000 wett Penmon on 800 kcs hrd on test after the stronger station had signed off. I count this one of my best veries. All these veries on BCB plus about 30 BBC veries on 5W were received this fall and signed by H.L. Thorp of BBC's New York Office. Mr Thorp advises me that the BBC vill be glad to have additional reporters who will cooperate. Frite Mr. R.L. Thorp, BBC 630 Fifth Ave., New York 20, N.Y. My report on SBV, Falum, Sweden was sent to Swedish Embasy in Wasnington, and I had a letter from the embasy saying my report had been forwarded. CHARLES BUEHNKE-SAN FRANCISCO, CALIF DX has been pretty good around here and I have been hearing a few stations that might be considered good. I have been trying for a TP or 2 but no Luck. Stay up to all hours and listen with both ears. Dont fallsasleep. Best I can get is KGU or KGMB and they are nothing for Pacific Coast DX. KGMB can be had good by 2 AM EMT at times and push KHQ quite a bit and very good after KHC s/off. 12/3 at 5AM ENT KGMb was 3-5 h-9 plus. KGU isnt so hot and its never better than K-4. As to KHBC and KTOH, I hear nothing but static and more static. Will have to do something about the man made static around here. Am one block from street car line and half block from another. Also half block from main car line (Lombard St) and all cars give me a headsche. WIOD hrd now and then but not good enough for a report. CKUA on 580 has been identified as the station pushing KMJ at night. A 3rd Xmtr is hrd under the mess on 710 but I am unable to get them under KIRO-KMPC mess(Its probably WOA-Charles-hay) These 2 really battle it out the KIRO is the stronger. Hear them in broad daylight now and then. Report out to KXL for daylight DX but they refuse to answer. Quite sure it is CMKJ on 720 that QRM's WGN around 11-2 AM here. Havana is mentioned although I believe CMKJ is in Holguin? KFRL on 950 breaks thru KJh and XEGM real nice here. KTKC is terrible here, have a terrific howl and bad hetrodyne from some body. On 1150 kcs, one of my favorite freqs KSAL can be hrd good at times and I have had WISN give the time. The trouble here is that a station will come in for a short time then fade. Regarding XGOY on 1450 kc. I still thinkvI was hearing KGOY last June etc. Station KSAN was hrd at the time also and identified as KoAN, but this other Chinese was heard at same time. In the June 5th VRC bulletin I believe I mentioned the fact that KSAN was hrx also. I know it would be quite a thing to hear XGOY at that time but --- I personally know that freak reception is possible as a few years ago I was in Hawaii and I remember how my Dad and I would go to the Eastern side of the Island in the morning and listen to the DX coming in from the mainland. This would be about 7AM Havaiian time and 9:30 Pacific time and 12:30 PM Eastern time, stations like KFI-KOA-KDKA would boom in like nobodys business on a car radio. Naturally this did not happen all the time but it was spread out over a period of six years. The Honolulu stations would be blotted out by the mountains and once in a while we would get a power house on the BCB and it would turn out to be some U.S. Station. December 30 1944 TIPS and LPO REPORTS PAT REILLEY-James TOVN, N.Y. 12/19 Forgot to set alarm, no DX and an hour late for work. 12/20 / -pick on 600 kc and an hours copy but couldn't decipher a call, they signed at 4:05 but sounded like XE?R, very noisy above 900 kcs; 12/21 660 Spick good again but no call deciphered; WDC with a Dawn Patrol program, the Mexs on 1380-1440 and 1470 kcs were all good but quite a bit of shushing noise today; 12/22 14 below today, reception funny XEG-XEL and ones on 1290-1380-1430 and 1470 good but the regulars such as WHAS-WOK-WLW-KFI etc were barely coming in good enough to copy. Verie back from ZNS, a verie is very rear here in spite of the 25 reports out. Did not hear KPOF at all and KDOA quite weak and bothered by a Spick. Postmaster says mail is 3 days late in delivery here because trains are so full, but all outgoing mail is stocked at the Erie Depot waiting for space on the mail cars. No DXing over Xmas, away from house, in a houseful of Vifes relatives. (Your rpt was dated 12/25 5PM arr Dec 27th AM) MORM MAGDIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N M Veries include WESD to complete Louisiana, WMOH on Joe Beckers Special, WKLA-WINK for new ones. Doy they were sure hard to get, had to tune with a wrench-the push button trimmers. However DKing is a little better now. Couple questions. First that Cuban on 670 over rides WMAQ here and sounds like he is announcing as CMQ. Who is covering WGN on 720 kcs? Does it every evening. 660 and 650 kcs are my international channels. TIBAS is on the high side of WaM and CX-6 on the lower side. Up on 660 kcs its a toos up between WEAF-KFAk and XEB2. Hrd this morning with a Christmas program, a openish speaking station on 1140 kcs. Would like help on this one? TIBAS seems to be snifting freq. He wanders from 651 to 650 kcs. Never seems to be on the same spot 2 nites in a row. With this Worth-South antenna I've had no luck with TPS or TAS lately. KGU and KFAR are heard daily but thats all. The station in freq frolics on 1490 kcs that I asked about hasnt been had goving any other identification. The selections are all announced and at station break all I hear is "This is the Armed Forces Radio Station". Its no harmonic either. Well I missed KPOF and KUOA the other AM, set alarm and forgot to push the lever, so I awoke late for work and missed 2 specials (OH another Pat Reilley) Also missed KSJB earlier. WHIT put a big dent in WADC and could be verified easily thru WADC. 12/18 Lots of Mexicons on, stations on 1440-1430-1420 besides the usual late hour mexicens, one on 1440 probably XEPI, one on 1430 had an M or N in its call, not sure of him, one on 1420 seemed to be XECJ, call sounded Like that and 4th letter was definitely a J, also mentioned Morelia several times. 12/24 XEDA hrd on 1286 until after 3, station on 1240 signed off with "Silent Night" at 3:55. HJBJ coming in Q5 R7 at times on 1140 until 4:35. YV5RL was h-6 on at 6:30 AM s/on as per tip in bulletin. On 12/25 lots of stations , few call announcements, French-Canadian on 1240
