Am American, apparently WJZ, Had Charlie Chan at 7:30 PM. 790 YV5RB Caracas, Venz and just about the loudest station on band R9 plus 800 CMHQ Santa Clara, not sure of this one, was R-8 and mentioned Cuba. ???? 820 Same program as on 300, but no Cuban listed here, have no idea. 855 OAX4A Lima, Peru This one more or less a guess as it is about the only one listed on 855 or near it. My listening with a freq meter so freq are exact. Buenos Aires, No question, he announced in English, good sig. 870 LR-6 Caracas, Ven, another super h-9 plus, must have been right in their beam for they roared in. 880 YV5RQ 920 CMJL Camaguey, Cuba apparently as program same as one hrd on 800 kc. 950 WVDI Port of Spain, Trinidad with American Dance Tunes, uses 300 watts 960 YV5RA Caracas, Venz, not as strong as the others. San Cristobal, Venz with an R-6 signals 980 YV2RB 1010 YV5RG Caracas, Venez with R-8 sigs, again not quite as good as others 1050 YV5RZ Maiguetia, Venez a 500 watter with R-7 signals 1060 HJCC: Bogota, Colombia, first Colombian on band with chants in Spanish 1110 WBT Charlotte, one of few Americans with good carrying powers. Maracaibo, Venez with fair signals. 11.20 YV1RF Shreveport, La in a hard fight with HJGE who is usually on top 1130 KWKH 11.40 WRVA Richmond, Va another American with good carrying powers 1160 YV5RL On top at times but too many on here, same on 1150 kcs. 1180 HJEQ Palmira, Colombia possibly, but it is another R-9 plus signal, and I doubt that RJEQ could do it. But I have no record of anything stronger here in Spanish. PRE-3 is stronger but this station used Spanish, not Portugese, as like PRE-3. 1190 HJAN Barganquilla, Colombia with a good 4-7 signal 1210 WCAU Philadelphia with an h-8 signal. 1220 HJAJ Barranquilla, Colombia another R-9 sig, this was identified. 1250 YV1RK Maracaibo, but not very strong. Barranquilla, Colombia, another power house. 1275 HJAT Maracaibo, Colombia again not so strong, but understandable. 1310 HJAK Barranquilla, Colombia, only R-7 though 1320 WNEL San Juan, P.R. another R-9 plus powerhouse.

TIPS and LPO REPORTS BILL GABRIEL JR-LAKEWOOD, OHIO Few more reports have been sent out to WJEF-ZNS-KMAC-CKEY-WAGM-WBML-WRRF with follow ups to KAVE and KWLC and overdue reports to KWAT-KRBC-WMBH. Veries in from WBML-WRRF, dup and WJEF all letters except WRRF which sent a folder with a verie written on it, and a card from WBBB. Reports dont seem to bring the veries like they used to and it'll probably be worse next season. WAGM was heard here with a neat show, but I really had to strain the ears to hear their R-5; Q-2 signal. ZNS is R-7 every Sunday at their 10:20 PM s/off; CKEY is a daytime station here with their new 5 KW; KVEC wont DX this season since the C.E. and Manager feel it wouldnt be of much value, but Mr. Travis says he will put on a show for the NRC if a grant for 1KW and a new frequency comes thru next season. Sure hope its cold for KORE tomorrow Morning. C.E. SLEICHTER-DEL PASO HGTS, CALIF I was rushed to the hospital Dec 19th and operated on Dec 21st, throwed out to make room on Dec 27th, every one had a plesant time but me. Now in fair shape but no late hours at radio so do not know anything. Am going to try for CKPA soon as able, either something is off in my radio, or air is extreemly bad, just cant figure which it is although I do know short wave is not coming in, but HCJB on 12455 is new one at 4:35PM with good power. Now as to KFAR, I really see no reason why you cannot get them after 3 AM EWT. At that time they are on with 15 min of Scandinavin music followed by old time dance music, such as CFCN puts out every Thursday night, as it is with R 6-8. Maybe a Cuban or Mex interferes. (No C.E. just do not come in unless its extreem-ly good DXing) Glad that you got CKNW, I am sure not many in the East will get that station, just a break. Quite a blow to Salt Lake City, both new stations deleted and I do hope the same thing happens to the expected 2 out here and the other one near here. Wonder why 2 new ones in Reno, dont know how they can exist very long. Must be money in the radio game. (Well C.E. you can be sure that all of us are very glad to hear that you are back home and that your recovery will be a speedy one-Ray) CHAS C BOEHNKE-SAN FRANCISCO, CALIF DX is much better around here, now that I have the old S22R in operation. A few probable TPs are around and one one identified, 2BL in Sidney on 740 kcs. Don't have much time to do DXing as my education seems to take first place around here (You can bet on that) Also studying radio theory and math, that go with radio so am tied up. Been up a few mornings and will try for the coming DXes if I can fix my alarm clock. Going to try for something on the long wave dept if I can. All I hear at present is a lot of airport stations and beacons. If I do hear music on long wave its got to be a European, so I am hoping. The multi-station channels are a real nusiance, so much so that I seldom DX on them. The worse ones here are KGFJ-KXO-KAST-KOOS a real borther-KFXM-KROY-KFXD-KFIO-KWG-KRRE-KHUB-KRE-KSAN and then the babies on 1490 KDB-KVOE-KTBI-KRNR. (Y s it is something, but we can only hope that when this is all over many of them will resume to normal operations) HANK WILKINSON-BALTIMORE MD Rec 2 more BBC (bcb) veries from 1474 kes (Forces Service) and 767 kcs (Home Service) Makes 5 of them and I'm proud to have them in my loose leaf cellophane envelopes that I keep all my foreign BCB veries in. Also added HJAN-1190 kcs, Berranquilla. Have air-mail rpt to him. Past 2 eves (jan 17-18th) seen many mid-western stations completely blanked out while SA & CAs pounded in. Has happened several times this year and I always take advantage of it by sending more rpts out to them there foreigners. As of now have 14 rpts out to foreign bcb that havent answered as yet. TO BURNHAM Tax for the Brazilian tips, your the guy I'd like to hear from sometime-I'm an old IDA member and there's several questions I'd like answered. TO CHAS BOEHNKE-I'll be seeing you around Feb 20th or so, I'll contact you when I arrive. Am leaving here on Feb 12th by train.

TIPS and LPO REPORTS January 27 1945 CLARENCE BURNHAM-GLOUCESTER, MASS The Brazilians finnally came thru good on Jan 17-18-19th; PRE4 Radio Culture on 1300 kc was Q4 R 5-8 on 17 and 18th from 6:45-9:30PM; PRG3 Radio Tupy on 1280 kc and 10 KW was Q 4-5 & R 6-8 6:30-10PM, WOV could hardle be hrd at times. Northern lights I suppose; PRB7 on 900 kc 5KW Q 4-5 R5-7 9:15PM then XEW got too strong; PRF4 on 940 kc Q4 1 5-8 from 7-9 PM thru Canadian; PRB9 on 1000 kc Q5 R7 from 7-8:30PM. Cuban here too, PRES on 980 kc Q4 R 6-8 thru heavy interference at 7-8PM; PRD2 on 1060 kc with 10 KW Q5 R 5-8 at 6:45-8:30 PM; PRH8 on 1130 kc Q5 R5-8 ruined WNEW and broke thru at 7:30 PM. PRE3 on 1180 kc makes mince meat out of WHAM, one of the best and consistent Brazilians Q 4-5 R 6-8 at 6:30-10PM; PRA2 on 800 kc excellent signal 8-9 PM, on the 17-18th. Plays high class opera music. Some nights the Canadians and Cubans on this free are inaudible but PRA2 will be pounding in Q5 R7-8. Some freak reception eh? Also hrd were PRH2 on 600 kc; LT1 on 780 kc; PRH9 on 840 kc; PRA6 on 890 kc; PRB6 on 1200 kc; PRA9 on 1220 kc excel-lent signal; LR1 on 1070 kc and LR3 on 950 kc. The last 2 were Q5 R7-8. The Brazilians are freakish. Channel will be empty one minute and 5 minutes later they will be pounding in Q5 R 7-8 only to fade out of the picture entirely in another 5 minutes. This makes it difficult to make an accurate report. It takes plenty of time and patience. dent 15 reports to Brazilians last winter and only received one answer. That was from PRE2 on 1430 kcs with 3500 watts. Radio Vera Cruz. However will keep trying, and have 8 PRs verified.

AL BARTHOLOMEW-BRENING N.Y. FOR LEN KRUSE-About NAA; They have been deleted a long time at least 5 years. Were a station owned by our Government at Arlington, Va and transmitted weather reports and time signals twice a day, once around 11 AM and again near 10PM. Were only on for no more then 10 minutes, forgot duration now. I verified them a long time ago. They operated on 690 kcs with 1KW. My record shows I hrd and verified on Oct 1933. By the way VAS in Glace Bay, N.S. operated on same freq with 10 KW and were on as I remember once a day near 3AM with weather reports, especially for the fishermen at sea. FOR BURNHAM He says I might have heard PRD2 on 1060 kc on New Years day but he also says they signed off at lAM. For his info the station I hrd was not a Brazilian as they use Portuguese and the one O heard, which I believe was CBlO6 was hrd 3:30-4AM at sign off. Since last report I caught KVOP on Jan check already have verified with nice letter. Another report went to KBUR on Jan check and they verified by letter, both reports made in Dec and Jan, finally cleans up Iowa for me. TIEP was landed easily for a report on evening DX. Never have been able to get a verie out of them, this is probably fifth report. WMLT was caught on 7th with reg equiptment test and HJAK on same AM, reported to London Reg on 877 on the 9th. Reported to WAGM on special; WGKV as they came on the air one morning; WRLD on check and on 12th hrd WJEF testing on 1230 kc, very little data thru WITH-WCOL so sent a double card to make sure. Reply came back promptly verifying report. Watch for tests after 2:30 AM between now and Feb 1st. They say they will begin reg sked in Feb.. Nice going on CKNW, also the boys with KFAR, thats my one DX ambition, had them once but not enuf for rpt, will keep trying though. 1/22 coasters very good, even KPAS. "In reply, I may say that the stations to which you refer are low power transmitters located in remote areas not ordinarily adequately covered by regular broadcast stations. These stations are established at points through which the network lines pass and are for the purpose of boosting the signal to provide listeners the opportunity of hearing the network programmes. No programmes are originated at these transmitters and no Figned Walter A. Rush individual identifications are broadcast." Controller of Radio.

FRED VAN VOORHEES-FLUSHING N.Y. Station ZYB5 Natal, Brazil promises me faithfully that they will go on the air from 3-4 AM EWT on the AM of Feb 20th. I dont trust them though but it will be worth wetching. I hope to be back in Natal before then to sort of get them on the ball, I hope to make it, and I might even be there to appear on the program, but I doubt it very much. They operate on 1270 with 1000 watts and unless I am there they will announce in Portuguese and very broken English, dedicating to all Americans and perhaps the NRC. I told them to and they may, but they are a little unreliable. Station WXLQ in Kondley Field, Bermuda operates on 1240 kcs with about 200 watts and can be heard all over the island. It is an Army station and so they say cannot put on a DX program, but will verify all reports addressed to The Army Radio Station, Kindley Field, Bermuda. I did a little listening along the run over the North coast of South America and am listing my findings. LARRY YALNES-SAN CARLOS, CALIF Tried for WAGM but no luck, may have heard sign off with National Anthem, sent a thank you card, rather tax letter. STAN MORSS-BRADFORD MASS Reports out to WMLT-KVSO-WAGM-WCAZ-WHIZ, and veries in from WHBU-WKBZ-KFDM-CBF and about 30 Police Broadcasters with a thank you letter to WWDC.

PAT REILLEY-JAMESTOWN N.Y. 1/19 WCOS-WPAD-WGBR-WELO-KYUM all OK on checks by Maley's list but WJLB not heard on check. 1/20 TAs on 877-1149-1123 hrd first time in weeks here today. KTBC checked 3-3:30 on 590 kcs; KARK tested at 3:32; KAVE on reg check in Maleys list and good here; 1/21 WHTD hrd at sign off at lAM; HJAK hrd on 1310; WMLT behind the mess on 1340 kc WKAQ checked at 3:02; CFRB tested at 2:45; ZNS a good 4-8 in evening with Salvation Army program 7:30-8:30PM; 1/22 WGNC on check 4-4:30 when KORE came in but very weak as it was terrible noisy and used cellar aerial, outside one too noisy to get a peep out of them; 1149 TA also good today New veries from XELZpWJEF and dupes from WISE-CFBR. Betty said she received more than the usual number of reports this month. I see where she verified your report El Lechuza, in New Mexico.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. DX Continues on the slow side here. Only 2 replies in this week, a very nice card from WIGM and a photo card from CFBR expressing regrets I missed the DX and hoping I have better luck next time. Nothing new heard except test of WJEF on 1/20 hrd between 2:30 and 3:30 AM. Very hard to log thru the QRM. Yet on same date WLAV was Q5 R9 with its reg test and QRM on 1340 is even stronger than on 1230/Another freak reception on 1/21 at 9PM WHTD was riding in here with a Q5 R9 signal and no sign of QRM on it, as clear as WBNY and in Nov they were buried in QRM every time I tried them.
