Have printed cards for WFEB & WFEB & WDBC and hope they will verify now. Also WDBC is a new check time. Spent a Sun in Latrobe with Art Hankins being the host to Sully Sullivan-Hal Robis & myself. Had magnificent time. During afternoon Mayo wired gerrtings from Montreal. Discussed an inter-club co-operation plan and a system of grading veries. Hankins the VRC editor and pu publisher has some excellent ideas and am sure the NRC will be interested in his plans. Greived to learn death of C E Sleichter and Don Wattenbarger. C.Es rpts were as valuable as any our club has ever rec from west coast DX-ers. His correspondance reflected a personality of highest calibre. I'll keep you lads posted on new Indiana, Pa sta, just 20 miles from here.

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TIPS and LPO REPORTS N Y July 21 1945

LT FRANK SUSORENY-0878009 (Well Frank your letter arrived July 19th so
 137th A A C S Sq am including an addition to your report as
 APO 858 % POSTMASTER received from Phil Nichols who so generously
 NEW YORK, N.Y. called me by phone on the 18th, giving me your
 new address and the highlights of your letter to him-Ray) Havent written
 for some time and you will notice that I am finally out of the states. I
 left for Artic Duty end April 12th. Spent 18 days at home and left the last
 minute for Gremier Field, N.H. so couldnt stop off in Buffalo, maybe when
 I come back next year it can be arranged. While laying over at Goose Bay
 Labrador I copied their local BCB VOUG "The Voice of the North" also "The
 Voice of Labrador" on 1340 kcs and power unknown. Have an Armed Forces
 network station here, WXLS "The Voice of Greenland" at Narsarssvak and it
 operates on 850 kcs with 1KW from 11AM-11PM EWT. Here is news. Greenland
 has a standard BCB station, run by Greenlanders on 475 meters (abt 632 kc)
 power unknown and located in Godthaab, the Capitol of Greenland, located
 on west coast about 64 or 65 degrees North. Info gained from local Danish
 Official. Operates aprox 6-8PM EWT daily. Not heard here yet as we have
 practically continuous daylight at present but expect to hear it during
 the long winter night. Have about an hour of dusk now, but towards the end
 of June the sun would rise for about 30 minutes. When I first got here in
 May we had about an hour of near darkness, accentuated by a heavy overcast
 and light rain, I tuned over the band at about MDT local time. Some of the
 stations heard were XEW-KOA-WJW-KSO-WOC-WKBW Hi who were R-7 here-WENR an
 R-8-WBBM-WCKY-WLW-WHAS and many other eastern stations. Expect to log
 quite a few Europeans this winter. Did some DX at New Haven and San Antonio
 In New Haven I verified WINS-WBRY-WICC-WNBC-CBO-WELI-WLIB-WATR-WBRC-W3PR-
 WBNX-WSRR-WBYN-CHNC-WTAG-WKNE-WORK-WIBX-WHTD-WHEB-WHDH-CJBR-CBV-WFAS-WNAB-
 CFNB-WLAW-WNYC-WNHC. In San Antonio I also logged some more "super-super"
 DX by verifying the locals, practically XEQ-XET-XEMU-XEFL-XEBX-XEH-XERJ-
 XEFW. Now have over 750 veries and wonder if I will be able to hear any of
 the NRC DXes this coming winter. In AACSS we have Super-Pro receivers, got
 no BCB on them but will have a BCB receiver as I plan on winding a BCB coil
 for one of our Spare Super-Pro's. We can operate here on about 80 frequen-
 cies and the call letters are WYXE, if anyone in NRC can read CW. Call
 signs at Cape Dar are WYTO. On the Army Hour July 8th a spot broadcast was
 relayed to New York from here on 10,240 kcs over WYXE. If anyone has de-
 finite log they can get a verie from Lt Francis X Earls 137th AACSS Sq.
 APO 858 % Postmaster, N.Y. N.Y. They tested before they relayed and only
 call mentioned was WYXE, so if any of you have anything definite you can
 get it verified. (OK Frank and lots of good luck from us all and thnaks
 for all the info.-Ray)

ARN OLD E GERRARD-MIAMISBURG, O Reception for the most part of July has been
 good here but seem to get only those stations that are already verified.
 A few of the last veries are WHGB-KIUL-KANS-WSON-WBAC-WRNL-KWFC. WBAC has
 been testing almost nightly between 2:15-2:45. Signer is R W Rounsaville.
 WCBS on every Monday AM 1:30-1:45 with a sport cast. 7/2 CMBQ has heard on
 1150 kcs giving calls in English. KFJB was also on 7/2 with DX program &
