PHIL NICHOLS-E HARTFORD CONN Report covering DX from Fri evening 10/5 thru MON 10/8 inc. Fri eve the 5th reported VONF for dup rpt. Sat 10/6 managed to pull WGTC thru 1490 on their 1st SAT F/C from 2:30-3 even through WKBV was on at same time, besides the 2 alniters, then sent in a long report to KOTA, hrd dedication to Pop Edge and one to myself, this rpt for a dup to get their swell new letter head. Sunday 10/7 As soon as WJLB signed at 3:03 AM found KNAK coming in week, thru a carrier which stayed on till 3:37, then channel clear till 4, with plenty of dope on KNAK who signed at 4:21. Following KNAK's s/off I discovered a very weak station coming thru at times on 1400 and stayed with it to 6AM or daylight, got several classical selections and at 5:30 I understood the announcer to say 2PK. If so it is an umbelieveable catch as they are listed at 200 watts, perhaps they have increased power. Were inaudible a lot of the time, but in the bursts I managed to recognize several classical numbers for a fair report. Went to bed at 6:30 couldnt sleep so up and thanks to HERB CAMPBELL of Athens, I got the sign on of WKPA on 1150 at 7:45AM very well for some 5 min in broad daylight. Thx Herb. For AL BARTHOLOMEW WINC was hrd on top on 1400 at 7:35 AM SUN 10/7, minister reading a list of names of people in and around Winchester, try for em SUN AMs. Mon 10/8 A beautiful DX morning here-hrd many stations and got 2 I have been wanting for a long time. KIT on 1280 from 2:10-3AM over another station I believe was KFOX. WDSU was off the air. At 4:27 AM I was lucky enough to run into KUTA on 570 kcs testing and s/off at 4:30 but got 2 numbers and two announcements with identifying words for call letters. Have been after that baby for a long time.
