Using it have hrd TIPG and got fairly strong whistles in AM on 583 & 668 kcs. On PM of 19th till about 6:30 hrd fairley strong sigs on abt 200 kc, possibly a BBC. Hrd KTBS s/off at lAM also hrd KGNC whom I need for a verie, but WROK made good rpt impossible. Just had a visit from Carl Horton and his wife, very fine gentleman as do all DXers seem to be except Cops. By the way you can call me "Long Hair" but I'll bet no body ever called "Pop" that. Heh heh.

SID STEELE-LOUISVILLE KE DXed SAT morning and logged WBAC-WLAY-CKEY and sent reports. Veries in from KOTA-WGAU and XXXX KOTA gives me a start for the contest. (OK Sid and some Canadian Stamps will be on the way very soon)

LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N Y Report to WMAJ. Veries in from KOTA-WBAC-WMSA-WTTM and last but by no means least, WXLQ for my 21st verified country. All letters but WTTM which sends a very fine card. Not too much DX this week only one new one reported being WMAJ, hrd on its initial test Sun 10/21 from 2:27-2:51. He was way off freq, 22 kcs below 1450, which he was announcing and thus in the clear. Good loud sig but tone quality seemed a bit pinchedbase notes did not come over. Mrs Bernard Bopp was on the broadcast, is Mr Bopp their ce? (No Lefty, he was consulting ce) 10/21 Bad buzzing, WMAJ only oddity on band. 10/22 Static bad--up for KGIW but no luck-carrier on there spoiled that. English station on 1474 was doing fairly well, still in there at 3:30; Thought I had French on 1149, static bad and sig not so loudmight have been Spanish from XEJP. Who was playing band music on 1340 and s/off at 3:05 (That was WRHI Lefty, hrd them thru WEXL-Pop) Surprised to learn Bermuda is in the Pacific, see list of US Forces Stations in Pacific. (OK Lefty I did slip in a couple that were elsewhere-Pop) Dont get what Ralphie means WISE going to M.S. of T. by Xmas? The WFPG show has to be cancelled because of a shortage of help there due to war time conditions and vacations. So "Silver Throat Copper" wont have to go down there that morning. How about full QRA for AFR in New Hebrides? No I havent hrd them, just wishful thinking. Verie total now 1059, 1100 by end of season or bust.

PAT REILLEY-JAMESTOWN N Y Very little DX because of cold. WBAC back signed by R W Roundsville the owner. He says he will be glad to verify all reports 10/17 WMSA hrd on test at 3:20 but very noisy. 10/18 WPAX at 3:05; On 1350 hrd a whistle nearly all AM but no voice hrd at all, very noisy and hopped up to thecpolice band and helped Texas police chase escaped convicts from Huntsville; 10/21 radio very weak today, like northern lights bothering—WAOB on 2074c kc a relay of WEAF testing; WLS and WEAF tested also. 10/22 Radio weak again, WKWK checked on 1400 at 5:15 and very noisy. According to latest BBC mag "London Calling" they list only 2 standard wave lengths 307 meters (997 kcs) and 267 meters (1122 kcs) for services to Europe in different languages. I have a request to pal in England for Home Service freq, towns and addresses, if possible to get.

ELBERT TEWELL-CAREY O Maybe I should tell a little about my DXing during the summer and so far this fall. WPAG hrd and verified, as are WBAC-WKLA-WLIB&KOTA; WPAG are hrd here R-9 all day. Have hrd WJOL s/on but have been unable to copy enough for verie. Hrd WMAJ 10/21 and hrd them nention Pops phone call as well as those of several other of the boys. WLIB verified in just 5 days, so did WKLA who stated that my report was the most complete out of 25 that they had received to date. (Congratulations on that) Have been hearing a lot of stations, but most of them I have already verified. In checking mt heard log I see that I have nearly 600 since I have been DXing. Boy if I only had them all verified. I have entered the BCB Contest again this year and maybe I can give you members a race this year if my new S2OR gets here in time. At present I will have to be content with my old stad-by an Aircastle receiver which really pulls them in, altho as yet I have not pulled in Maguires KINY, but hope so soon. (OK Elbert, your lst class amount is not up to 60½¢ and good luck on the contest-Pop)

PHIL NICHOLS-E HARTFORD CONN Thurs eve 10/18 found TIEP coming thru swell on about 825 kcs altho listed at 830 kcs. Gave them over 1/2 hr rpt. Fri AM 10/19 was swell, first reported was Limoges on 648 for half hour 1:15-1:45 then at 4:10 found WMSA on test on 1340 kcs, and ended up with copying a little on WVUR the AFR station in New Eebrides on 1045 kcs, very weak from 4:15-4:45 or so. SAT AM 10/20 was enother lucky one for me, found KSRO in the clear on 1350 just before s/off at 1:50AM and have been after that one a long time. They stayed up and copied Canal Zone on 790 kcs at 5:30AM and was surprised at their strong sig. SUN 10/21 found me reporting Sottens, Switzerland from 1:15-1:30 when they faded out completely but got good rpt. From 2-4 I spent the time chasing WMAJ's signal back and forth from 1428 to 1453 back to 1430-1448-1440 and ended at 1443 kcs or so. Enjoyed hearing from Dick-Ray-Ralph and Carl via phone calls. Boy what a BILL WMAJ is going to have. Henry Carney their ce hit 1450 just once as I recall it. Monday morning found another swell morning for TA reception. Limoges was hrd as early as 12:15 and as late as 3:30. All BBC transmitters were on up to 3:30 or later before fading out. Spent my time copying Hilversum on 995 or so. Weak until I AM and then they boomed in, ran my meter up to 6, during which time they had some swell music, Gershwin-Victor Herbert etc, copied straight until 2:30 and got odd bits from 2:30-3:30AM. At their peak a little after iAM they were so loud I tried my little 5 tube Zenith and had them on loud speaker as good as New York in daytime, believe it or not. Writing this at 4AM MON 10/22 and have following out-WKIX-KALL-CBV-Toulouse-WGTC-2PK-WKPA-KIT-KUTA-WKWF-TI4NRH-WLEE-TIEP-Limoges-WMSA-WVUR-KSRO-Canal Zone-Sottens-WMAJ and Hilversum. In spite of Dave Thomas I predict the best TA season for years judging by the rate they are coming thru so early. Have a total of 21 this early in the season. Other stations noted testing this AM 10/22 4th MON were WINK at 2:402 f/c; WRHI at 3:06 test; WEED shortly after on able to pull thru yet. At 4AM WGNC on and mentioned Ralph Johanns calling him up last month. FOR LEFTY-WHGB has been s/on 6AM weekdays and at 7 AM SUN, should be easy there. CKLW was silent this AM 10/22 (OK Phil and you really got a few, how about WDAD on test TUES AM; Ha Ha-Pop)

BOB DUGGAN-MACON GA Well its 10/21 and 9PM and am hearing WLAT in Conway S.C. on aprox 1470 kcs instead of 1490. Very bad modulation, barely meddable at times. Sig strength is pretty good; WBIG QRMs. Can hear it on 3 differen sets, so nothing wrong with sets. Have rpt out now. Have my Howard 435-A back from shop and can detect no 685 Cuban Net Amtr as reported on DX NEWS. Also think the 660 Cuban is CMCL, not CMBC, as CMBC is till on 790. Hrd WLAY 1450 kc in Muscle Shoals and ce anknowledged rpts from Johanns-Lippin-cott and Johnson among others, still wont verify for me. (OK Bob the FCC lists the Cubans as you have them and date it as Oct 1st 1945-Pop)

BILL STONE-1938 SPARTON-8TUBES 10/21 WNHC testing on 1340 from 2-3; WMAJ on 1st test on 1425-1430 kcs, no phone of I'd have helped Phil out on his calibration, 1428 was what I figured it, sure banged up here, covered WWDC when they did get on 1450 at 3:30 but from 2-3:20 were on freq mentioned. WSFA s/off at 12:30 AM has news for last 10 min-come on SUN AM at 6:30 AM time for you lads who n eed him to get him. Have wrote CJEM-Airmail to announce CKCH's change at least once every ½ hr, hope all you get it. Thanks to Dick for swell photo and DO tell us when VRTQ is audible. DO. Suggest fellows list their sets after name as above.

DICK COOPER-KITTANNING, PA Latest veries include letters from KOTA-WMSA-KOAL-CKCK-WKLA-WLPM with a card from WGKV. Last 3 are dups. Rpts out to KSAI-WXLQ-KGW-KGB-KALL-WLAT-WMAJ-WDAD-XECD-WGBS-WLEE-WENT and several oters for contest. Pleased to have hrd WMAJ's first effort and tnx to Ralph I also hrd WDAD on the first one altho they were very weak in back of WWDC. Both these should be testing again. Cant seem to talk WLAT into answering. KOAL said they have requested 1230 and expect only routine delay. Will arrange for special verie cards after the change is effected. Hope a flock of you NRCers will be on hand for the WISR DX Special on Thanksgiving AM. We are planning on a very super program with plenty of personal dedications etc. Thanks for the many suggestions regarding a log book. I shall soom know whether or not it can be produced.
