The latter was on top here from 10:30-11PM on 10/26 only severe QRM from CMHI in Cuba. Wgere my 3 little DX obsticles WMCA-WSYR-WKBN were I dont know. Back with veries are KOTA-WSM has swell letter head-WSBC letter also, quick service,4 days, 10-21 to 25th. Hrd or rather at 6:30 PM trying for VONF, all ZNS so far. Did you know Springfield is only city with stations in 4 states? Mass has 3 stations; Missouri also hasx3; Illinois has 2 and Ohio 1; But there are seven cities with same name which have stations in 3 states. Moral-Be careful when tacking call letters to towns you hear.

BILL STONE-TORONTO ONT The DX programs of CJEM & CKCH both well had here and both good. CJEM was best in first half hour & last 15 min. CKCH was good all thru, enjoyed their bilingual program. Newest ones are KBTM-WFTC-WSAY-KOTA-WPAG-WENT-WBAC-WFEB-WRHI-WMAJ-WKWF-WLAT-CJEM on NRC DX and this AM hrd KDTH in Dubuque on 1370 kcs from 2:03-2:35 AM EST with a test. Have often tried for this one on various f/c dates but this is 1st time they were hrd, and followed by CHUM with a test program as hrd by me by the merest chance from 3-3:30 EST, they were offering a set of 6 glasses to 10 who rpted from greatest distance. CJEM came over fine and clear with some deep fading at times and CKCH were fairly good on same AM. KOTA special was hrd in fine shape, but WKLA weak. WJOL latest new station hrd here. Am also hearing an Armed Forces Radio station on · 1.205 kcs from 4-7 AM EST. Would appreciate help on this one. (Only one on list is 1204 kcs AFN APO 562 France. / No power given-Pop)

Reception has been poor here so far because the QRN is too heavy. Reports out to WLAT-WAAP-KTNM-KFBB-KTBS-WLEE-WDAD-WHNC-HJAN-TIPG-CMW-CMJK-CMCH-CMCK-CMBQ-XESM-REJP-CMCD-CJEM. (Is that all? Just locals around here)
