Have spent very little time at the dials the past week and found it noisy the several times I did try. KCOK logged numerous times with a very powerful signal, no excuse for any eastern DXer not having heard KCOK if they were at the dials. Suggest you fellows watch for WJNC, Jacksonville, N C who are due to hit the air soon. And I'd like to repeat that request for a flock of reports on the WISR program. November 17 1945__ TIPS and LPO REPORTS CHARLES BOEHNKE-SAN FRANCISCO CAL DX conditions are fair here. Sigs are gradually improving in strength and TPs are coming thru. LYA-3YA-KGU-KGMB-KSAI-JOAK etc all are putting in fair sigs. As winter wears on they will of course get better. Japs are all over the place here. Last night and it was cloudy, I hrd Japs on 690-730-830-870. The 870 station is believed to be JOAK-2 with 150 kw. Dont know if previous listings as to Japs are correct or not. The one trouble in getting TPs here are our own domestic stations. Around 2AM PST and righty upto 6AM PST TP reception is the best, but Americans are either still on lousing up TP signals or else they are signing on doing the same thing, such as WWL at 6AM EST and does a swell job of wrecking JOAK-2, can still hear the Jap strong but QRM from WWL is too much. Incidentaly several of the Japs carry the same program. After 6 AM EST they play some English or American music however with Jap announcers. KXOK also messes up the vicinity around 630 kcs and of course KFI dominates 640. KMJ is a bother on 580 and so on, more QRM than one can cope with. I do want to log a couple SAs, it ought to be possible if I can get a Xtal, where or how is beyond me but I am determined. Radio equipt-ment should be available soon. Have seen the new MECK radio, it is a five tuber midget with super-het circuit. Dont care for it at all. S/SGT AL MALEY-HIGHLAND FALLS N Y Latest veries. KTBS letter by C H Maddox ce.-WSVA letter by W L Braun, tech advisor-XESM letter by Fco Gutierrez, not a 100% verie tho, CMBQ airmail letter by Miguel Diaz. Total veries now 956 with reports out to WLAT-KFBB-WLEE-WDAD-WHNC-KMO-KERN-WMAJ-WKWF-HJAN-TIPG-CMW-CMCD-CMJK-CMCH-CMCK-XEJP-CJEM-CJKL. Looks like I best you guys out on the WKVM verie-Hi. (You can say that again) The CMHB program on 11/7 was a beaut and came in swell here even tho WING who was on till 3:20; Sorry the experts at East Hartford couldn't hear them, but I am trying to arrange a DX show with them for all to hear; 11/8 hrd CJCS testing on 1240 from 2-2:30 asking for long distant reports. Have them verified with 50 watts but sent another card anyway. Have a pretty good f/c list worked out, but wonder if I should submit it for publication, as the Govt will probably set up a new sked before long. Almost overslept the CJKL-DX and only got up in time to hear 2 numbers before %FIL came on at 5:45 and took them out. What do you have to do to get a verie from KFBB??? 3 rpts to them since March, all complete and with customary postage. They have been addressed to the c.e. so maybe I'll try one to the station manager for a change. (How abt sending a correct report, maybe then they will verify-Hi. Ralphie and "Short Hair" didnt have any trouble, no signer on Ralphie and other 1944) TED SALING-ESTACADA ORE I dont know what happened to KINY, I didnt hear them on the 22nd or since. I dropped Burnett a card to find out more about it. Landed my first Bill Stone Delux special in CKFI, missed all the others including CFPR. KOTA again well heard. The latter 3 verified at once. My log now stands at 1124 heard. Thanks and congratulations for the many excellent arranged DXes. (OK Bernard and very glad that you were able to add more stations, hope a good many others could do the same.)

LT FRANK J SUSURNEY-MARRAK PT. GREENLAND As you boys will notice my location is changed again, however the same address as before is the same. I had the pleasure of decommissioning Cape Dan up on the east coast after 9 weeks there. After returning from Ikateq by plane to Narsarssauk, I was transferred to Marrak Point, This is definitely a good break, as we have a field here-Teague Field-the only natural air strip in Greenland and thats really amazing if you've ever seen this land. Now I'll be able to get my mail out during the winter and be able to leave should I have a chance for discharge late this winter which would have been impossible at Cape Dan which is iced in for 9 months of the year. As for DX, my prospects for the next few months seem exceptionally bright. Marrak is located in a perfect spot for DX. It is right on the ocean shore, more specifically Davis Strait. Have purchased a Howard 436 and it works beautifully. Hate heard all over the states and also hear a slew of TAs. TAs all over the dial here in the early evening till about 8PM local time (6 PM EST) Then the states come in and are heard all night. The European's also start coming in at about MDT EST but fade out about 3 hours later. About Godthaab I mentioned before. Operate on 632 kcs but power still unknown. Are on from 4:38-5:30 PM EST. Come in here like a ton of bricks, also heard them down at Narsarssuak with R-9 signals at a distance of about 250 miles. But their hours of operation do not offer much promise of reception in the states. Have a report out to them. Announce as "Gronlands Radio, Godthaab. Off the air on Sun-day. Broadcast in Greenlandic (Eskimo) till 5PM, Danish till 5:15 and music till 5:30 when they s/off with Danish Anthem. WXLS not heard here too well, but was heard at Ikateq, 450 miles northeast of Narsarssuak with R-8 sigs. KOA wrecks them here, Another AFRS station in Greenland is WHEN at Ikateq, but you'll never hear her. Operates on 1375 kcs with 10 watts. Pretty powerful eh? I got a verie and they announce as "The Atric Broadcasting Co with studios in Peter Carroll's Ice Palace atop Allen Hill, Ikateq". With WHEN and WXLS both verified I've got my fingers crossed for a verie from Godthaab. Following overdue veries trickled in during the last couple months; KFRU-KFXM-WJBW-KGLU. Reports from reception at Marrak are out to Godthaab-Praha on 638-Bratislava on 1004-Melnik on 1113-Hilversum 977-XERB-KOTA-KTYW-KSLM-KIEM-WWDC-KONP hrd H-8 here-KFBB-KGIR-CFRN. So you can see this is a DXers paradise despite its isolation. For BILL BARRETT of DENVER Think your station on 1320 using late time was WNEL, NOT CJCH as WNEL comes on at 5AM EST but still uses late time, think EWT. CJCH on the other hand has never been hrd until s/on at 5:58 AM EST daily so think what you had was WNEL. I hope every one will report the WXLQ special on Dec 2nd as Werthiem is a swell fellow and deserving of all the support we can give him. Might add that a card from Sid Steele advises me I am in front (First) place temporarily in the BCB contest, but it wont be for long I guess, how about it?? (Ha Ha Phil, he didnt get my entries till after yours, but good luck Phil, no matter what the out come I am still enjoying it a lot-Pop, as Maley says "Short Hair") LEN KRUSE-DUBUQUE IA Since last report my DX activities were "slim" relatively speaking.
