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CMHB-SANCTI SPIRITUS.CUBA This is the DX that most all of us will want to hear and it should be on a clear channel of 1410 kcs. This station is anxious to receive DX reports and they promise to verify all the correct ones too. We suggest sending any one of these three for your answer, Cuban postage-An International Reply Coupon or an American Dime. Send your reports to Alberto Ruiz Sanches, Administrator. This program will consist of Christmas themes and according to Senor Sanches, saying that Cuban Christmas is quite different than ours. The program will start at 3:00 AM EST on Dec 20th and it is not known how long it will last. This station earlier dedicated a DX to our good member Al Maley but it met with plenty of QRM from election returns in the states, so they'll try again for all of us. Thanks to Senor Sanches for this DX and also to "Long Hair" Maley its arranger.

Now just a few words about your bulletin received via 3rd class mail. It is mailed as usual every Saturday morning. However delays are being experienced and these delays are no fault of the Buffalo Post Office. It must be remembered that mail service has not yet reached the efficiency of the Pre-War days and from the looks of things it will be quite some time before it does. So if your bulletins do not arrive as soon as you think it should have a little patience and if after a reasonable mength of time it - hasnt arrived thenddrop us a line. Now that the Christmas holidays are upon us you can be sure that you will experience more delay on 3rd class mail. So it is suggested that if you can afford it, 1st class is your only solution. The cost is approximately 75¢ a year more. You see your club pays the first $1-1/2\phi$ and you have to pay the rest. A bulletin of 4 sheets or less can go for 3¢ 1st class as it does not weigh over an ounce, but if it runs 5 sheets or more the cost of 1st class is 6¢ as it takes the 2 ounce rate, thus costing you 1-1/2; for firts ounce and 4-1/2; if it goes over 1 ounce. The average throughout a year has been just about 75%. So if you can afford it, I suggest that you avail yourself to 1st class. We have not been printing any extra issues of the bulletin account of our stock of 20# paper is getting low, with none available at present, so we are trying to make it last as long as possible before buying 16#.

WVUT in Suva Fiji on 665 at 9:26PM. The latter 2 are AFRS in the Pacific. All these stations were logged Nov 2nd.
