Those are regular 4th MON F/C; Also WHKY on 1290 5:05-5:20 but latter does not verify for my last 3 rpts; 12/25 WNEL hrd till 4:18 s/off, another No Verie; 12/26 WEXL stopped its alrite nuisance for a 15 min test unmodulated at 4-4:15; WOWO s/off test 4:10; WHEC s/on thru WIP at 6:30; Veries rec, cards from CFNB-CKWS for DXes; WJNC for 11/23; WMBO the Convict in front of mike and letters from WKAQ, with parchment verie also, for a test 12/14, fast reply; KCMO by Tech Dir; WDAK by CE; CFCY by K S Rogers, Pres & Dir (VELHI) for 12/14 DX special and a Very Happy New Year to all. From Sat 12/15 to 12/18 the Spanishers were all over the dial in eves. CMW-550 kc; CMCY-590 both were practically in clear and TIGPH and TIPG were good as were Puerto Ricans WIAC-WKAQ. ZNS & TGW were battling on 640; The Azul station on 670 was h-9, ditto CMQ and h-7 for the AZUL on 730; CMBF was h-9 and almost free of CBL on 740 and CMCH was easy on 790 kc TIEP coming in fairly well on 825 and OAX4A on 854 was coming thru and CMCM was boss on 860; Cubans on 920-960 unidentified. 980 was what I think is CMCK in clear and HJCB was breaking thru on 1105; Spick on 1150 also. HJAN and HJCR were both loggable and the Spick on 1220 probably XEB was good. WIP-WAAT-WWDC and others could hardly be copied. Mexicans all good and strong.
