DR JOHN W KIRK-PT PLEASANT W VA Just rec the following letter; Around the last of Apr, Gerald Coleman, W8FRC of Butler, Pa and myself put the first KZFM Xmtr on the air, a 50 watt type which remained on the air till Sept 10th when the present KZFM went into reg sked. Xmtr site is at Poho, Bulacan, Province abt 7 miles north of Manila and the temp bldgs are built on the blasted foundations of a former Manila bc station KZRM. Equipt here is the latest type of broadcast Xmtr which uses 2 air cooled 5KW tubes in final in a high efficiency Doherty circuit. My personal consists of 3 Phlipino ops and 2 diesel men. Power derived from a 50KW diesel plant with a 25KW gasoline plant as standby. Am using the same 192 ft vertical radiator is AFRS station WVTM. Operate on 710 and WVTM on 1300. Incidentally the first KZFM xmtr which we operated in Mainla was the 1st American broadcasting station in area since Jap occupation and present KZFM is the only non-army broadcasting station to be heard in the islands at present. This was si-Next to the noisy (Loran) station which all of us have heard in the range 1700-2000 kc and which we made considerable comment on shmewhat over a year ago. According to info rec.here "The maximum peak output power of any Xmtr under normal single pulsed operating conditions is aprox 150KW, when double pulsed its 85KW but is usually somewhat less. The average power might be of the order of 150 Watts. However as these stations normally operate in a pulsed condition we can assume that for and practical purposes they are using powers from 50 to 150KW rather than an average power of 150w.
