DOC KIRK's PREDICTIONS (Was supposed to be in last issue but the boys did a swell job of swamping your editor, so it was left out) Since others are trying a bit of prediction on DX conditions here attempt me. This will hold true for my own section, but would be glad to have comments from others on how it checks out for them. For week of Jan 27th-Feb 2nd Continued falling off of TA sigs accompanied by a slight falling off of TP sigs. CA & SA sig will continue to increase in strength during this week. Reception of stations to the north will be especially good; WEEK FEB 3-9; TA & TP signals will continue weak. Some falling off of CA & SA signals will be noted. Toward end of week northern signals will drop considerably. Considerable local interference will be noted during this week, rendering unusable many signals which ordinarily will be fairly good. WEEK FEB 10-16 TA signals will improve considerably. TPs will remain at about the same level as in previous week. Signals from CA & SA will fall off considerably. Noise level will increase causing interference on weak signals.——Would appreciate how accurate this prediction turns out to be. It was based on the same general sort of considerations that the Armed services used in predicting their long range radio circuits.
