All tests unless specified. 3/22 WTON at 1:45-1340 a mess at 1:46; KALL hrd till 2; 05, sent another rpt, no reply to Jan rpt yet. 1400 at 2:06, 3 stations, WMAN off at 3:18, some station on 1240 kcs 2:40-3 giving location as Harrison, ARK unable to get call (see new list enclosed) KGVN ok thru mess 4-4:30 and still better afterc5; WGIL at 4:35; 2/23 WMVG with repeated calls only 2:50-3; WCAO on test; WMVG still going at 3:15, strong carrier on 600, listened till 4:25, likely CJOR testing 5kw job, no calls given; WFIN ok on DX 24th, very well HNL (Northern Lights) only CKEY coming thru steadily, back to bed, forgot abt WWRL; 2/25 HNL again, WMVG s/on for test 2:30, r-5 7-9 no go on KGIW; WEED at 3; back to bed. Up at 5:20 for WLBZ, not even a sign of a carrier. 2/26 HNL still here, nothing hrd, back to bed, someone on 1240 but could not get him thru HNL. Owing to moving, DX limited. 2/29 1:45 WMSA WRHI at 2:35; WMVG at 2:40; WATN putting in best sig yet, solid k-9 plus. CJOB easily copied from 2:59-3:09 s/off putting Q4-5 R 5-8 sig in here getting a little distortion from WMSA, not a thing hrd on WEXL/WHAT. After CJOB s/off WMSA ruled the channel. Believe it or not this was hrd using an 8 ft length of wire for antenna, only put on for local reception; 3/20 strong carrier on 610 with WIP, no ann. WATN s/off 3:15-30 after swell program, boy did he really pan Maley, was you listening Staff; 2/30 No DX, put in antenna 2/31 Using a verticle telescope 9 ft long, starting at 35 ft above ground, really gets out. Tnx to McNamara for WHEB sked, can any of you lads in the east hear CHOK on reg sked-1070 kcs.

The spots are very near the center of the sun and it will take about two weeks for them to pass from the view of the eye, after they become too weak to see with naked eye they givec little trouble i have observed. Veries in from KABC-WEED-WBIG-WMCA-CHML-CFAB-WPAT-WAIM. Rpts out to too many, all tests too. Come in awfully slow dont they? Sent tnx cards to a lot of the stations that I dont get, my eyes bother me like the old nick so it limits my activities. (OK Jim and take care of those eyes, and if you can find a little time those verie signers from WBIG-would be welcome.-Pop)

STAN MORSS-BRADFORD MASS Rpt to WPOR a local here alday, must s/on 5:30, hrd em at 5:40 as I was going out to work. Verie from Hilversum on 995 kc, very nice letter by R.H.F.J. Wubbe, sec, says to send reports to Radio Netherlan Bureau Technisch Directeur, Postbox 150, Hilversum. Also verie from CHEF for my 3/19 rpt, said mine was first rpt from USA. Operates on 1200 with 250 watts 6AM-12MDT except SAT then 6-1AM. Are by far the strongest Canadian here next to CBA. Verie by ce, G Laliberte. CHLT still on 1240 here, heard around 7AM some AMs. Still no verie from CJAD.

BOB DUGGAN-MACON GA Veries from KPAB-WPRA-KTUC-WMVG-KDTH. Rpts to CMCU-CMW-CMCM-CMBS-HJCZ-CMBY-CMKH-CMCD-KGVL-KFGQ-WFIN-WBAB-XEBZ-WWRL-KUJ-KTMC-XEN-XEMC-WPOR-CMCX-CMOA-CMCB-CMGW-HHGM-CMKZ-CMJQ-CMCW-CMJC-CMHA-CMBD-CMJH. Excellent DX on 3/25 between 6:30-8 PM netted a bunca of Cubans along with HHGM who has news in French at 7PM. CMOA is not yet deleted as it identifies as CMCX-CMOA. Likewise CMCB is not yet deleted. That PM was very curious as the stations to the north and east were either barely audible or inaudible. WBT was very weak. XEBZ tested till 3:30 on 3/24 asking for reports; WWRL was weak on its DX. Is WARD testing yet??
