The purpose of these programs is 3-fold, to give DXersa regular and upto-date program of DX news, to publicize abroad the Australiam DX Radio Club, and to maintain a steady flow of listeners reports on Radio Australia's signals. They receive over 1200 letters a month from these broadcasts. Any DX information you have for broadcast over this program may be sent to "DX Editor," Radio Australia, Melbourne, Victoria, Australia." They will be acknowledged on the program, and you will also receive a really attractive QSL card.
