My thanks to the boys who are doing so nicely with the C.P.C. work, also to our Editor, Secretary, & Vince Stasen. Keep up the good work? KETA surely put in a swell signal. That was the first time I have heard CJVI. WAYN is still out in the cold, as well as KWCO. 10/31 was certainly a noisy morning for DX, but I did manage to snag WVIN, Olney, Ill., a 250 watter. Heard several others, but could not get calls on them. Stranger on 870 or 880 from 2:16 to 2:24. Also a cycle tone on 560 Kc/s at 3:56 a.m., no music - only tone, and still there at 4:23 a.m. This one drowned out WIND. Also one on 1450 from 3:27 to 3:36, and a strong station on 950 Kc/s., at 3:53.
